

## **The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 204 Scriptures**

**Letter to Laodicea**

<sup>14</sup> Write *down My words, and send them* to the messenger of the church in Laodicea. "These are the words of the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of God's creation:

<sup>15</sup> "I know your works. You are neither cold *with apathy* nor hot *with passion*. It would be better if you were one or the other, *but you are neither*. <sup>16</sup> So because you are lukewarm, neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of My mouth. <sup>17</sup> You claim, 'I am rich, I have accumulated riches, and I need nothing'; but you do not realize that you are miserable, pathetic, poor, blind, and naked. <sup>18</sup> So here is what I suggest you do: buy *true gold* from Me (gold refined by fire so that you can be *truly* rich), white garments (to cover you so that you can keep the shame of your nakedness from showing), and eye ointment (to treat your eyes so that you may see clearly).

<sup>19</sup> "Those I love I also correct and discipline. Therefore, be shamelessly committed *to Me*, and turn back.<sup>[a]</sup> <sup>20</sup> Now pay attention; I am standing at

the door and knocking. If any of you hear My voice and open the door, then I will come in to *visit with* you and to share a meal at your table, and you will be with Me.

<sup>17</sup> The *synagogue attendant* gave Him the scroll of the prophet Isaiah, and Jesus unrolled it to the place where Isaiah had written these words:

<sup>18</sup> The Spirit of the Lord the Eternal One is on Me.

*Why?* Because the Eternal designated Me

to be His representative to the poor, to preach good news to them.

Luke's audience doesn't divide the world into sacred vs. secular or religious vs. political. For them, life is integrated. And for them, these "religious" words from

Isaiah have a powerful and “political” meaning: because they see themselves as oppressed by the Roman occupation, Jesus’ words suggest that His “good news” describes a powerful change about to come—a change that will rescue the people from their oppression. His fellow Jews have long been waiting for a savior to free them from Roman oppression. Jesus tells them their hopes are about to be fulfilled. But then, just as people speak well of Jesus, He lets them know their expectations aren’t in line with God’s plans. He tells them not to expect God to fit into their boxes and suggests the unthinkable: that God cares for the Gentiles, the very people who are oppressing them! They aren’t too pleased by this.

He sent Me to tell those who are held captive that they can now be set free,  
and to tell the blind that they can now see.

He sent Me to liberate those held down by oppression.

**19** *In short, the Spirit is upon Me to proclaim that now is the time;*  
this is the jubilee season of the Eternal One’s grace.<sup>[a]</sup>

**20** Jesus rolled up the scroll and returned it to the synagogue attendant.  
Then He sat down, *as a teacher would do*, and all in the synagogue focused  
their attention on Jesus, *waiting for Him to speak*. **21** He told them that these  
words from the Hebrew Scriptures were being fulfilled then and there, in  
their hearing.

**MATU'RE**, *verb intransitive* To advance toward ripeness; to become ripe or perfect. Wine matures by age, or by agitation in a long voyage. The judgment matures by age and experience.

**AMATEU'R**, *noun* [Latin amator, a lover, from amo, to love.]

A person attached to a particular pursuit, study or science, as to music or painting; one who has a taste for the arts.

one who engages in a pursuit, study, science, or sport as a pastime rather than as a profession

one lacking in experience and competence in an art or science

**IMMATU'RE**, *adjective* [Latin immaturus; in and maturus.]

1. Not mature or ripe; unripe; that has not arrived to a perfect state; applied to fruit.
2. Not perfect; not brought to a complete state; as *immature* plans or counsels.
3. Hasty; too early; that comes before the natural time.

**PREMATU'RE**, *adjective* [Latin proematurus; proe, before, and maturus, ripe.]

1. Ripe before the natural or proper time; as the *premature* fruits of a hot bed.
2. Happening, arriving, performed or adopted before the proper time; as a *premature* fall of snow in autumn; a *premature* birth; a *premature* opinion; a *premature* measure.
3. Arriving or received without due authentication or evidence; as *premature* report, news or intelligence.

And no one gave him anything.

<sup>17</sup> "When he finally came to his senses, he said to himself, 'At home even the hired men have food enough and to spare, and here I am, dying of hunger! <sup>18</sup> I will go home to my father and say, "Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you, <sup>19</sup> and am no longer worthy of being called your son. Please take me on as a hired man.'"

<sup>20</sup> "So he returned home to his father. And while he was still a long distance away, his father saw him coming, and was filled with loving pity and ran and embraced him and kissed him.

<sup>21</sup> "His son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and you, and am not worthy of being called your son—'

<sup>22</sup> “But his father said to the slaves, ‘Quick! Bring the finest robe in the house and put it on him. And a jeweled ring for his finger; and shoes! <sup>23</sup> And kill the calf we have in the fattening pen. We must celebrate with a feast, <sup>24</sup> for this son of mine was dead and has returned to life. He was lost and is found.’ So the party began.

<sup>25</sup> “Meanwhile, the older son was in the fields working; when he returned home, he heard dance music coming from the house, <sup>26</sup> and he asked one of the servants what was going on.

<sup>27</sup> “‘Your brother is back,’ he was told, ‘and your father has killed the calf we were fattening and has prepared a great feast to celebrate his coming home again unharmed.’

<sup>28</sup> “The older brother was angry and wouldn’t go in. His father came out and begged him, <sup>29</sup> but he replied, ‘All these years I’ve worked hard for you and never once refused to do a single thing you told me to; and in all that time you never gave me even one young goat for a feast with my friends. <sup>30</sup> Yet when this son of yours comes back after spending your money on prostitutes, you celebrate by killing the finest calf we have on the place.’

<sup>31</sup> “‘Look, dear son,’ his father said to him, ‘you and I are very close, and everything I have is yours. <sup>32</sup> But it is right to celebrate. For he is your brother; and he was dead and has come back to life! He was lost and is found!’”
