

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 205 Scriptures

Prior to the following testimony, Holy Spirit led me to anoint with Mother's home, windows and doors. I had a dream that my Mom was standing on the roof, and I had this phrase, "Mom is top of the house; it is not on top of her." While I was anointing the house, the performance track of Shalom, one of the songs Holy Spirit inspired to write was playing.

At the close of 2016, Holy Spirit began to prompt me that my Mom would be living with me. In mid-January as I was reading my bible, I had a vision of someone's big hand covering my Mom's face. It happened twice in a row. It took my breath away. I called Mom. She was fine, but she mentioned that my nephew was there working on her furnace. However, he was not able to get it running again. I went and picked her up and she stayed with me overnight. The furnace man came out and I accompanied him the whole time he was present. In the end, he said that he could not legally turn back on the furnace. He stated she needed a new one. We gathered Mom's belongings and we returned to my home. By the following Sunday,

she told me that she did not want to go back home. Because Holy Spirit had already told me Mom would be living with me, I immediately told her she could stay with me.

While there was much resistance for Mom to return to her home, I knew what the Lord had shown me. Even, the furnace was turned on again. Over the course of the next several months, Mom would seem to be very present at times. Other times, she would have an undefinable presence. I mentioned it to my baby sister several times. Then the last time I said it, she immediately said the Holy Spirit said it is carbon monoxide.

The next morning I called an independent blood testing facility which just happened to be in the same building we had to go to receive the requisition for the test. The attending doctor said that it was inconceivable that any carbon monoxide would still be in Mom's bloodstream. After Mom made her blood drawn, the official report concluded that she had over three times the allowable amount of carbon monoxide still in her system.

You may ask yourself or others, "What is really known?" God desires you to know where the enemy "sets." That is the position satan lusted after in an attempt to rule over you, whether it is seen or unseen, known or unknown.

The following is just one example of moving forward in fighting the good fight of faith. Heeding to Holy Spirit's prompts, I felt led to send additional time in prayer. In my pursuit to hear the word of the Lord, He whispered just one word, "Rumpelstiltskin." Being quite puzzled, I read an online version of the fairy tale and several

commentaries. Bringing closure to this mystery, I believe the Spirit of God was saying in that moment in time, "you can always defeat the enemy if you just know the right word."

Several years later, Holy Spirit gave me the Hebrew word, *tâmam* as the word of the Lord for the prevailing issue. The Strong's Concordance defines the word "clean" from Joshua 3:17 as "complete; accomplish; cease; be clean." The short definition for this expression is simply "finished." Breaking that down farther: something has exited, like a chronic condition and something else entered to take dominion in that place, like the divine cure.

The following account is the breachproof breakthrough my Mom received when the word *tâmam* was voice activated. She received complete freedom from chronic bleeding that first appeared to be never-ending. But Jesus Christ healed Mom and she never bled from the bladder area again.

When Mom began to bleed, one hospital system irrigated her while the other one gave her blood transfusions. I mentioned to my youngest sister that the doctors kept trying to show me an image of Mom's bladder and that I did not have any desire to see it in a dysfunctional state.

Out of courtesy, I would always act as if I was looking at the image, but I never captured it in my mind. Having been a former army medic, she told me to look on the internet for a picture of a healthy bladder so I would know what one looked like.

After that, I was impressed to look up healing bladder cancer on the internet. I came across a YouTube video that showed a bladder cancer healing within three minutes. Although an ultrasound showed a scalable difference visibly, not having any working knowledge of medicine or medical equipment, I was unable to understand what was really occurred. They were also chanting one phrase in a foreign language, which sounded much like a Chinese dialect.

Afterward, I entreated the Lord to give me the right word that would ignite healing for my Mom. It was *tâmam*. As my Mom sat at the

dining room table quietly praying, I sang one of my originals *Shalom*. I would also intermittently decree *tâmam* instead of the song lyrics. We remained in that posture for approximately an hour offering worship and praise to the Lord.

That glorious time culminated with a vision of Jesus in white apparel walking toward me carrying a new red bladder in both hands. I believe the bladder was red to image what I had previously seen on the internet. Initially, it appeared as an entourage of angels that followed Him since I saw a collection of moving white wings that formed an upside down triangle around His feet.

Although we did not check the bleeding until a couple hours later, I believe Mom was healed instantly. The blood stopped flowing. From that day forward until Mom departed for heaven, she never bled again. Thank you Jesus! Because of my role in her personal care, my testimony is absolutely unquestionable. I solemnly confirm that from the afternoon of August 24, 2017 to the morning of December 5, 2017 my Mom never bled anymore from the bladder area.

I now believe the white wings in the vision represent Malachi 4:1-3 which indicates that even the fringe of Jesus' *tallit* had healing in them. Not just the Old Testament reference for divine healing, but also Luke 8:43-48, Matthew 9:20-22, and Mark 5:25-34 in the New Testament. Those three scriptures recount the woman who had an issue of blood for twelve years was immediately healed after she touched the hem of Jesus' garments. The flow of blood from her wound stopped when she drew the *dunamis* power out of Jesus. In the end, she was supernaturally cured because of her faith in Jesus, the Great Physician, our Healer.

The Shunammite woman was quiet yet not still in 2 Kings 4th chapter. When her son died suddenly, she remained extremely careful to watch every word she voice activated. That ensured neither she nor anyone else would bury what was just planted for only a season.

What she believed in her heart leaped from just expectantly hoping to receive to deliberate faith in action. She received the promise of delivering her son from premature death. Her confession transitioned from "It shall be well" to "It is well" in anticipation of receiving her son back to life again that very same day. The word "well" is translated as *shalom*, commonly referred to as "peace." That proved her quietness.

However, the Shunammite woman did not just sit still. She transported her son to the room she and her husband constructed for Prophet Elisha. You see, she placed his lifeless body in the same room she received the prophecy that impregnated her womb. In that place, she expected the prophet to exhume her little one whole and well from the tomb.

Although her husband had known the child had fallen ill, he did not have any knowledge that he had died. She only told her husband she desired to visit the prophet and not the reason even though he questioned her. She never mentioned to her husband that their son had died.

She saddled her donkey and told her servant to drive high-speed until she reached the prophet. A donkey is most comfortable traveling at 8-9 mph, but she raced him at an inconceivable speed of 40 mph. Because time was of the essence, she made the donkey into a race-horse.

Seeing the Shunammite woman from afar, Prophet Elisha sent his servant, Gehazi to greet her. But she never told Gehazi about her son's death, even though he inquired as well. Even after reaching the prophet, she verbalized her concern without using any word that could portray the child's demise.

Initially, the prophet sent Gehazi with his staff to lay it on the boy. However, he remained deceased. After the Shunammite woman vowed she would not leave Prophet Elisha's side, he accompanied her to raise her son from the portal of the grave.

Through the assistance from Prophet Elisha, her son was resuscitated to live again. The Shunammite woman's decision not to be still processed her real-time faith to receive her miracle just-in-time. Her resolute faith was set in motion to recover what she had lost.

In John 14:1, John 14:27 and John 16:33 Jesus ensures you of how the peace of God is already empowered to prevail over every test, trial, or temptation. Therefore, it awaits you to engage it throughout your daily life. Jesus bestowed *shalom* upon you to own as well as to occupy.

In Hebrew, *shalom* means peace which is comparable to the Greek word, *eiréné*. Extracted from Strong's Concordance, *shalom* means safe, i.e. "well, happy, friendly, welfare, health, prosperity, peace, favor, perfect such as to be at peace, rest, safety, salute, well, x wholly."

Shalom 1) completeness; soundness; welfare; peace 2) safety; soundness (in body); 3) peace; quiet; tranquility; contentment; 4) with God especially in covenant relationship
