

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 207 Scriptures

This is Section Y of a multi-part instruction. The heavens are the Lord's, but the earth He has conferred to all mankind. The one who rules is the same one who owns and occupies. The larger your territory, the greater your options are. Open your heart to God and allow Him to enlarge it with His dreams. Open your mouth to Jesus and allow Him to fill it with the *logos* Word and the *rhema* Word that are enlarged over any enemy. Open your womb i.e., non-gender specific, to Holy Spirit so He can enlarge your territory. Then Elohim, the Triune God will enlarge your steps so that you will never be overthrown.

All the creation that God made alongside Jesus Christ and Holy Spirit was for the purpose of land re-development. Their original creations, Adam and Eve were to work it and guard it as they enlarged their territory through their expansion efforts. Although they were evicted from the land that was their God-given inheritance, the Garden of Eden, the abundant life, the eternal life, and the resurrection life are still made available to you through your redemption rights that are only in Jesus Christ.

In Genesis, the earth was without form, void, and darkness was upon the face of the deep. God never created it that way, but after satan lost his citizenship in heaven and was thrown out along with of the one-third angels, now demons, the earth became a landfill. That corrupted the earth. Now recreated in the image and likeness of Elohim, you still have both authority and power to transact business to own and to occupy. After Jesus' resurrection and before the rapture of the Church, God assigned you to reign as heaven's ambassador on earth, even right now. God exposed, imposed, and deposed satan's lie that was fabricated evidence appearing real that he and his cohorts thought could be accomplished although it was impossible all the time. Never permit any weapon formed against you to prosper. God, the Father, God, the Son, and God, the Holy Spirit always cause you to triumph by already giving you the victory. Anything you will not rule, will eventually rule you. Now better understand what you already have the title deed to possess. If you do not know what you have, then you will not know if you lost it either. God has blessed you to be fruitful, multiply, replenish, subdue, and have dominion. So own and occupy!

The same Holy Spirit who was present and active during Creation and who rested upon Jesus during His earthly ministry is still present and empowered to be in your life. He is the Breath of Life.

Holy Spirit is the promise of the Father who Jesus sent for us to inherit after His Ascension

Galatians 3:1-14, King James Version

²This only would I learn of you, Received ye the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?

Jesus gave an accurate description of how Holy Spirit's presence and power represents the Christ

As your heart remains open to God, you will recognize that Holy Spirit actually lives in you forever as Jesus confirmed in John 14:16-17. Before the indwelling experience of the Spirit of God, He only accompanied the disciples, externally. Afterward, their lives were fully loaded and totally equipped by His presence and power and that can happen for you too.

Having the advantage, Holy Spirit served as the disciples' Comforter. The Spirit of God proves every Word Jesus declared as John 15:26 promises. Holy Spirit can do that for you too.

John 14:26 records that Holy Spirit will teach you all things as well as also remind you of what Jesus has already said. Holy Spirit also will guide you into all truth and show God's hope and future for you as seen in John 16:13. Because the Spirit of God taught the disciples all things, Holy Spirit can do that for you too.

¹⁶ And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;

Jesus gave a Word picture of how Holy Spirit functions during the New Birth and Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Holy Spirit clothes the human spirit, i.e., the inner man. That is similar to a hand in a glove so you can move syncopated and synchronized with Him. First, Holy Spirit is present in you as a well of water springing up into everlasting life. However, toxicity stops well water from flowing clean. The presence of any poison makes it dead. Jesus teaches the woman at the well in John 4:13-14 that Holy Spirit clears the path of anything toxic that could prevent the water from springing up as her pure source and supply of everlasting water.

Jesus Christ is the Way, God's channel all mankind. Holy Spirit ushers you into the born again experience. Jesus desires you to experience His life to the full until it overflows with the fullness of the blessing. That is without anything missing, lacking, or broken. To accomplish that, God is the only one who can really be your Source and Supply.

John 4:13-14 King James Version (KJV)

¹³Jesus answered and said unto her, Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again:

¹⁴But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.

Secondly, Holy Spirit is present to flow out of you like rivers of living waters as Jesus spoke of the promise of the Father in John 7:38-39. Your acceptance of Jesus as your personal Savior and Lord repositions you to live heaven drenched.

That takes your born again experience to succeeding levels of the divine presence and divine power of God. Abiding in that place, you are constantly streaming with the very life of God. Jesus desires you to experience His life to the full until it overflows into the lives of others. To accomplish that, God is your Surplus.

John 7:38-39 King James Version (KJV)

³⁸He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

³⁹(But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

Jesus taught His disciples about God's succession plan after His death, burial, resurrection and ascension. In doing so, He introduced Holy Spirit to them as the promise of the Father. In Luke 24:49, Jesus gave them a word picture of what to expect to receive from the baptism of the Holy Spirit. They were tasked not to physically leave the place Jesus commanded them to be until they received Holy Spirit who was assigned to complete and cram them.

Abba Father destined Holy Spirit to clothe each one of them with the *dunamis* power of God. But when He arrived, they would have to put Him on to invest in Him. In Greek, the word for "endued" is *enduo*, which is defined as "to put on, invest in clothing." It shows there is something we must do to be outfitted with Holy Spirit. Preserve an open heart unto God so you can adorn His heaven-born apparel that He designed for you to wear.

⁴⁹And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

Acts 2:32-33 is the manifestation the disciples received because of their obeisance and obedience to Jesus' command. The tangible evidence of the divine presence and divine power of God was seen through the baptism of Holy Spirit, whereby they spoke in other tongues, as Holy Spirit gave them utterance. Again, they had to preserve their voice to serve as the mouthpiece of God to speak in unknown tongues.

Acts 2:32-33 King James Version (KJV)

³²This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses.

³³Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.

After the resurrection of Jesus, He appeared to His disciples. After Jesus validated He was alive indeed, He breathed on them in order to re-create them through Holy Spirit. Now Holy Spirit was inside of them. It is the initiation of the New Birth experience. John 20:22 confirms the term "breathed" in Greek is identical to the Hebrew word "breathed" in Genesis 2:7. The Passion Translation research shows the word "breathed" only appears once in the New Testament in Greek.

John 20:22 The Passion Translation

²² Then, taking a deep breath, he blew^[a] on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit."^[b]

Footnotes

- a. 20:22 The Greek word used here does not appear elsewhere in the New Testament; however, it is the same word found in the Septuagint for when God “breathed” into Adam’s nostrils the breath of life (Gen. 2:7). The beginning of new creation life came from the breath of Jesus. The mighty wind of Acts 2 was for power, the breath Jesus breathed into his disciples in this verse was for life.
- b. 20:22 Or “accept the Sacred Breath.”

The Scriptures demonstrate the change Holy Spirit’s power and presence makes in your life during the New Birth and Baptism of the Holy Ghost

1 Corinthians 12:3 King James Version

³ Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost.

In Romans 8:11, the Apostle Paul gives a word picture of the indwelling Holy Spirit after the New Birth experience.

¹¹ But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

¹¹ I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance. but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:

⁶ When they therefore were come together, they asked of him, saying, Lord, wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel?

⁷ And he said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in his own power.

⁸ But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

The Old and New Testaments give the character and customs of Holy Spirit when He is present and empowered in our lives

Holy Spirit saturates you with at least twenty-seven capabilities that are compartmentalized within the following three main categories: Wisdom; Love; and Power. 2 Timothy 1:6-7 names the three diverse groups for the purpose of you activating them completely through Holy Spirit alone. When each one is fully operational, you are flooded with God Himself. That gives God every opportunity to fully express Himself without any limitations.

2 Timothy 1:6-7 King James Version (KJV)

⁶ Wherefore I put thee in remembrance that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands. ⁷ For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind [wisdom].

In the Wisdom class, the first nine are from Isaiah 11:2-5, 10. They are 1) wisdom, 2) understanding, 3) counsel, 4) might, 5) knowledge, 6) fear of the Lord [reverence], 7) righteousness, 8) faithfulness, and 9) glorious [glory].

Resting in the Lord allows them to have habitation in you, not just visitation. Holy Spirit rested on Jesus and never departed from Him; Jesus never vexed Him at all.

Isaiah 63:10 an example of what happens when Holy Spirit is vexed. It indicates someone keeps pulling until he completely pulls away from Him. "But they rebelled, and vexed His Holy Spirit: therefore He was turned to be their enemy, and He fought against them."

Isaiah 11:2, 5, 10 King James Version (KJV)

² And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD; ⁵ And righteousness shall be the girdle of His loins, and faithfulness the girdle of His reins. ¹⁰ And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and His rest shall be glorious.

In the Love class, the next nine are from Galatians 5:22-23. They include 1) love, 2) joy, 3) peace, 4) longsuffering, 5) gentleness, 6) goodness, 7) faith, 8) meekness, and 9) temperance.

Yielding to Holy Spirit, there is both protection and preservation. God's seal of endorsement rests upon both Jesus Christ and Holy Spirit. Therefore, the fruit of the Spirit that is in as well as operates through you are sealed making you supernaturally impenetrable as well. That is similar to coating fruit with natural wax to protect it from rotting. Then His fruitfulness can be clearly tasted and seen that the Lord is indeed good.

Ephesians 4:30 counsels us to not grieve Holy Spirit, so He won't lose any opportunity to express Himself through us. "And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption."

Galatians 5:22-23 King James Version (KJV)

²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, ²³ Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

In the Power class, the remaining nine are from I Corinthians 12:8-11. They encompass 1) the word of wisdom, 2) the word of knowledge, 3) the gift of faith [different from the fruit of faith], 4) the gifts of healing, 5) the working of miracles, 6) prophecy, 7) discerning of spirits, 8) divers kinds of tongues, and 9) interpretation of tongues.

Walking softly before the Lord helps you to discern the move of Holy Spirit to ensure what God has designed can never be extinguished. Live so you never think His divine intervention is an unscheduled interruption you take the option to reject. 1 Thessalonians 5:19 instructs us with these words, "Quench not the Spirit."

⁴ Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. ⁵ And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. ⁶ And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all. ⁷ But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. ⁸ For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; ⁹ To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; ¹⁰ To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: ¹¹ But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as He will.
