## The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 208 Scriptures

This is Section Z of a multi-part instruction. The heavens are the Lord's, but the earth He has conferred to all mankind. The one who rules is the same one who owns and occupies. The larger your territory, the greater your options are. Open your heart to God and allow Him to enlarge it with His dreams. Open your mouth to Jesus and allow Him to fill it with the *logos* Word and the *rhema* Word that are enlarged over any enemy. Open your womb i.e., non-gender specific, to Holy Spirit so He can enlarge your territory. Then Elohim, the Triune God will enlarge your steps so that you will never be overthrown.

All the creation that God made alongside Jesus Christ and Holy Spirit was for the purpose of land re-development. Their original creations, Adam and Eve were to work it and guard it as they enlarged their territory through their expansion efforts. Although they were evicted from the land that was their God-given inheritance, the Garden of Eden, the abundant life, the eternal life, and the resurrection life are still made available to you through your redemption rights that are only in Jesus Christ.

In Genesis, the earth was without form, void, and darkness was upon the face of the deep. God never created it that way, but after satan lost his citizenship in heaven and was thrown out along with of the one-third angels, now demons, the earth became a landfill. That corrupted the earth. Now recreated in the image and likeness of Elohim, you still have both authority and power to transact business to own and to occupy. After Jesus' resurrection and before the rapture of the Church, God assigned you to reign as heaven's ambassador on earth, even right now. God exposed, imposed, and deposed satan's lie that was fabricated evidence appearing real that he and his cohorts thought could be accomplished although it was impossible all the time. Never permit any weapon formed against you to prosper. God, the Father, God, the Son, and God, the Holy Spirit always cause you to triumph by already giving you the victory. Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Jesus acquaints you with who you are to our Heavenly Father

Holy Spirit is the One who ushers you into your formal introduction to your Heavenly Father, Abba as shown in Galatians 4:1-7. He even teaches you how to address and acknowledge Abba as your Heavenly Father. In Greek, "Abbá is defined as Father, also used as the term of tender endearment by a beloved child – i.e. in an affectionate, dependent relationship with their father; daddy, papa." Then God is no longer just Mr. God to you. Holy Spirit helps you to live comfortably as Abba's adopted son or adopted daughter, not just a servant and never a slave.

Holy Spirit also brings you into the realization of your preferred status of not just being an heir of God but also a joint heir with Jesus Christ. You see, the word "joint" grants you with mutual access to your heavenly inheritance. That begins on earth with your New Birth. In other words, you now receive the rights of the first-born as well as the double portion of the blessing. Your equal share is discovered in Christ alone.

Furthermore, Holy Spirit ushers you into real intimacy with Abba as seen in Romans 8:14-17. His undisputable leadership begins at our New Birth. He confirms our divine status as children, heirs, and joint-heirs. He resides within us and with us at all times to teach us all things.

Holy Spirit is a very present and active force in our lives as we yearn for and to yield to Him all the time, whether the situation may look

Now I say, That the heir, as long as he is a child, differeth nothing from a servant, though he be lord of all;

advantageous or not. He reminds us what Jesus said, shows us things to come, and guides us into all truth. Holy Spirit as your permanent Professor ensures you can pass every proficiency test or trial as well as help you to avoid yielding to any temptation. In the end, you will still have the winning position.

Jesus introduced Holy Spirit as a Comforter to His disciples. Either Holy Spirit consoles, coaches, counsels, consults, or choreographs your pathway to bring you into the good, acceptable, and perfect will of God. When He orders your steps, victory is preserved. You never have to succumb to premature defeat because God recreated you to be more than a conqueror through Christ who loved you so much that He couldn't leave you in that fallen state.

Romans 8:14-17 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>14</sup> For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

<sup>15</sup> For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

<sup>16</sup> The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:

<sup>17</sup> And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.

Holy Spirit helps you with being comfortable in asking Abba, your Heavenly Father for your inheritance

The role of the Holy Ghost doesn't stop there. Holy Spirit leads you into making your invocation before Abba Father. Therefore, Jesus tells us to ask Abba to give you Holy Spirit first in Luke 11:13.

Luke 11:13, King James Version

<sup>13</sup> If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?

Jesus' instructions in Matthew 7:7-12 ensure you that when you pray to receive something good from Abba that He never responds to you with anything evil. God knows the distinction between good and evil and He is ever disposed to be good to you all the time.

- <sup>7</sup> Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:
- <sup>8</sup> For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.
- <sup>9</sup> Or what man is there of you, whom if his son ask bread, will he give him a stone?
  - <sup>10</sup> Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent?
- <sup>11</sup> If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?
  - <sup>12</sup> Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets.

God desires to take you pass just being clothed by Holy Spirit. Acts 2:4 represents the initial baptism of Holy Spirit. In the Greek, the word "filled" is defined as "to complete." On the other hand the word "filled" in Ephesians 5:18 means "to cram." Therefore, subsequent infillings keeps you replenished.

Whenever there is a leak, lack, or you are lessened in anyway, learn how to posture yourself as a ready container that needs constant refueling. Your thirst will keep you there to drink into the Spirit.

The infilling of Holy Spirit is to supply you and the overflow is the surplus for everyone else. I recall my grandmother, Big-Ma would say to me to fill back up after I have been out ministering to others.

<sup>4</sup>And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

<sup>18</sup> And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;

The first indwelling experience Holy Spirit engages is during the birthing of a new convert, the New Birth. The second experience is when a Christian receives the baptism of the Holy Ghost. Someone asked me that since she was saved didn't she already have the Spirit of God in her. I replied yes. Prior to that time, I had been encouraging her to receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost by better understanding God's presence and power.

Never to make Holy Spirit seem insignificant at all, I gave her the following analogy: Holy Spirit during the New Birth is like drinking water; however, Holy Spirit during the baptism is more like drinking Boost<sup>®</sup>, the nutritional drink that optimizes your diet. Holy Spirit is the divine upgrade you cannot afford to give any space restrictions or altogether pass up on receiving God's portion.

Holy Spirit's point of discovery is during your New Birth and then throughout your entire life as a Christ

This is what occurs at the point of our born again experience in which the Spirit of God and the Word of God always lead the spiritual transformation process supernaturally. When we accept the Invitation to Christ after hearing the message of the Gospel of Christ, our spirit and body become the habitation of God through the indwelling Holy Spirit. I Corinthians 6:19-20 reveals our divine purpose as the temple of Holy Spirit.

In other words, set apart for heaven's expression on earth is God's plan for our spirit and body as a habitation of God through Holy Spirit where Jesus Christ lives in your heart by faith. Only in yearning and yielding both, your spirit and body to the Lord continuously, He is glorified. That is your spirit and body living surrendered!

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 King James Version (KJV)

19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

However, our soul must be renewed habitually and uninterruptedly to maintain our union with Christ as Romans 12:1-2 records. Now the soul is comprised of: 1) your thoughts, how you think; 2) your emotions, how you feel; and 3) your will, what you choose.

This is what your soul resembles when it yearns to yield to the lordship of Jesus Christ. Your thoughts, emotions, and will collectively surrender to serve God alone. It lovingly and loyally lives as a living sacrifice to Him. That is what ignites serving the Lord both honorably and humbly. That fuels, floods, and fulfills your

## worship to God in spirit and in truth. That is your soul living surrendered!

Romans 12:1-2 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>1</sup> I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. <sup>2</sup> And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Let's compartmentalize just how influential the soul is so you can better understand where potential breaches often originate or replicate.

Holy Spirit is the mind of God who is present you can host the mind of Christ for your thoughts

The mind—the first part of the soul—can be bombarded with varying thoughts. Those ideas can stem from a distorted knowledge base through deception, lies, and/or errors. Proven truth and even facts can be unintentionally or intentionally disallowed. An imagination or an exaggeration can be mixed with flawed opinions or warped judgments. A vow of silence or even a gag order can leave you totally in the dark.

You can see the entire scenario with your eyes and never even blink. Still, you may not know if what you saw is the absolute truth or not. A rumor can be passed around to make unsuspecting people think it is authentic because they were the first to announce the story. Then later retract and re-release the story at a time when no one knows that it was an error in the first place. Many may be proven credible witnesses while others just wing it, hiding behind a mere facade.

Then on the other side, the listener must be in a state of readiness to receive the truth in his/her heart. Without active listening skills, facts and figures that were furnished can leave the audience unfinished. Although the answer was released, the message behind it may be uncaptured, whereby the listener is left untaught. Because the information was untaught, it will also be unpracticed, leaving the party unskilled, therefore undisciplined. There can also be too much noise or interference at the time the message is relayed, thus diluting what was intended to be heard. Effective two-way

communications can be aborted when only fragments of the intended message are received.

That is why God has granted you to have and to host the mind of Christ, even at the onset of accepting Jesus as your Savior and Lord. Then the Spirit of God and the Word of God anoint your ears to hear as the learned so you will not rebel against the absolute truth of God that you can absolutely trust. To alleviate any mixture and create your pathway for undivided focus, forcibly voice-activate Philippians 4:8-9.

<sup>8</sup> Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. <sup>9</sup> Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you.

Holy Spirit is the mind of God who is present you can host the mind of Christ for your emotions

The emotions—the second part of the soul—craft good feelings or corrupt messages when a person is left with wounds in the soul. You can receive treatment from the medical field if you choose, but only God can totally heal you when there has been a breach, whether it is a cut or a tear.

Holy Spirit restores perfect soundness in your life in every area. Therefore, He does not just release God's remedy for your emotions alone. Holistically, He also revivifies your spirit and body as well. When emotions are left frayed or fragmented, that opens the door to poor health as well as breakdowns in other areas of your life. God's miraculous power releases supernatural emotional health which is the catalyst that helps you to recover all and stay whole and well. You can live in divine health.

Proverbs 14:30 casts the vision of remaining whole and well. The word "sound" means curative in the Hebrew language. That illustrates the capacity and capability to stay open in response to Holy Spirit's leading to make and keep you whole and well. No matter the level of care required for restoration, Jesus Christ, our

Great Physician and Healer is only one who has the breachproof resolution that mends, repairs, replaces parts, and cures you from the inside, out. That is the reason you can always come to Holy Spirit instead of running and hiding your broken heart from the Lord. In this, your freedom to go to any doctor should always be honored. Moreover, never forget to invite and involve the Lord in every decision and destination.

Your soul is whole when you are transported with the love of God. When your soul is left unsound, it triggers being stultified. Without experiencing healing for every soul wound, every choice you make is subject to conquer you instead. It can cause you to appear useless, ineffective, crippled, stupid, inconsistent, ridiculous, weary, and/or indifferent.

30 A sound heart is the life of the flesh: but envy the rottenness of the bones.

Holy Spirit is the mind of God who is present you can host the mind of Christ for your choices

The will is—the third part of your soul—makes choices: every decision contributes to your total quality of life. You must determine if the choices you make represent what you really desire. On the other hand, you must also know what you don't want to exist in your life as well.

Be open to God's choices which always represent the highest form of living heaven on earth. It is always embedded in the fear of the Lord, i.e., being honorable and humble before Him. Psalm 25:12-14 pave the pathway for thriving. That is the paradigm for successfully living within the kingdom of God.

If you think life is just a playground, you may act like it is a joke. If you think life is a laboratory, you may be quite experimental. If you think you can exchange your life with satan, then he will lust after you until he controls you totally, inside and out. That is very similar to a ventriloquist pulling puppet strings, all of them.

However, if you know you are the chosen king-priest for Jesus Christ, the King of kings, and the Lord of lords and the Great High Priest, and then only live co-seated in heavenly places. Assume your place next to Jesus Christ. Become so comfortable in automatically submitting every decision before Jesus that you know you will receive answers from Him alone.

Psalm 25:12-14 Living Bible (TLB)

<sup>12</sup> Where is the man who fears the Lord? God will teach him how to choose the best. <sup>13</sup> He shall live within God's circle of blessing, and his children shall inherit the earth. <sup>14</sup> Friendship with God is reserved for those who reverence Him. With them alone He shares the secrets of His promises.

That kind of experience can be clearly seen in Judges 6<sup>th</sup> chapter when Gideon was hand-picked by God. Gideon was chosen to represent the Lord to lead the military troops, although from the onset he was only a fearful farmer.

In verse 6, by faith Gideon was called courageous in the midst of his own cowardice. In verse 14, the Lord assures Gideon that he can do all things through Christ who strengthens him. In verse 16, the Lord gives Gideon the confidence that conquering the enemy is going to be a sweet victory. The outcome of the battle would seem like he was only combatting one soldier instead of a whole troop as Gideon farther developed his seamless connection with God. In verse 34, Holy Spirit is fully engaged so Gideon could move forward endowed with God's wisdom, love, and power. Now Gideon was empowered to be out-front to do something that he never had done before. God publicized him as more than a conqueror even before the fight begun. After that impartation, Gideon never backed down.

<sup>12</sup> And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him, and said unto him,

The LORD is with thee, thou mighty man of valour.

<sup>14</sup> And the LORD looked upon him, and said, Go in this thy might, and thou shalt save Israel from the hand of the Midianites: have not I sent thee?

<sup>16</sup> And the LORD said unto him, Surely I will be with thee, and thou shalt smite the Midianites as one man.
