

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 225 Scriptures

This is Section Q of a multi-part instruction. You are a chosen ambassador of the kingdom of God to reproduce heaven-born possibilities on earth. You have been appointed as a king-priest [non-gender specific]. Authority and power have been conferred to you to release miraculous provision into every sphere of influence. Your acknowledgement of the Kingdom of God within activates heaven on earth.

You have the crown. You wear the signet ring and hold the scepter. People even call you king. Your seat in heavenly places awaits your arrival. In fact, it is next to Jesus Christ who is already sitting at the right hand of our Heavenly Father, Abba. Will you grant permission to God to transform you into a ruling king and a representing priest unto Him?

Your invocation: "Abba Father, who art in Heaven, Hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Thank you giving us the days of heaven upon the earth. I believe to receive the kingdoms of this world have become [generated into] the kingdoms of our Lord and His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever. For Thine alone is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever. In Jesus' name, Amen!"

Develop your approach in releasing heaven on earth: If the party needs victory over blindness: 1) healing from physical blindness or degeneration; 2) deliverance from spiritual blindness to see Jesus as the Savior of the world; or 3) help in developing the gifts of the Holy Ghost to see supernaturally into the spirit world.

**Physical sight; spiritual sight; and/or supernatural sight:
An Old Testament example of the prophet Elisha who had x-ray vision and used his gift to preserve Israel**

2 Kings 6:8-22, The Voice

⁸ Aram's king had waged war against Israel. He gave instructions to those who served him: "I want my *war* camp at this particular place." ⁹ The man of God sent a message to Israel's king.

Elisha's Message: Be sure not to travel through this place. The Arameans are on their way.

¹⁰ Israel's king passed this warning on to *those in* the place the man of God had told him about. Elisha's warning saved Israel's king more than a few times. ¹¹ Aram's king became greatly angered by this. He gathered his servants together.

King of Aram: Which one of you has *betrayed me and* sided with Israel's king?

Servant: ¹² It is none of us, my lord and king. The prophet Elisha, who lives in Israel, is the one who informs Israel's king of these things. *Elisha somehow knows everything you say—even the secret things you whisper in your private chambers.*

King of Aram: ¹³ Find Elisha right away so that I may capture him!

The servants *found Elisha and* informed Aram's king, "Elisha is in Dothan." ¹⁴ So Aram's king dispatched a great army *of warriors*, along with many horses and chariots, and they encircled the city *of Dothan* at night.

¹⁵ The servant of the man of God woke up early and went outside. There he saw a *great* army, along with *many* horses and chariots, encircling Dothan.

Elisha's Servant: Ah! Master, what are we going to do now?

Elisha: ¹⁶ Have no fear. We have more on our side than they do.

¹⁷ (praying) O Eternal One, I ask You to allow my servant to see *heavenly realities*.

The Eternal awakened Elisha's servant so that he could see. This is what he saw: the mountain was covered with horses and chariots of fire surrounding Elisha. ¹⁸ When the enemy approached Elisha, he prayed.

Elisha: Eternal One, I ask you to blind these people.

The Eternal blinded them, just as Elisha had requested.

Elisha (to the blind army): ¹⁹ *You are wrong.* This is the wrong path and the wrong city. I will lead you to the person you are really after.

Elisha then led them to Samaria.

Elisha (*arriving in Samaria*): ²⁰ O Eternal One, I ask you to allow these men to see.

The Eternal awakened the men so they could see. This is what they saw: they were in Samaria. ²¹ The king of Israel saw them.

King of Israel (*to Elisha*): Do you want me to slaughter these men, my father? Shall I slaughter them?

Elisha: ²² *No*, do not slaughter them. Would you really slaughter men whom you have captured with your sword and with your bow? *Set the table and fill it with bread and water*. Let them eat and drink and return to their own master.

New Testament example of the people of God asking the Lord to intervene on their behalf and how Jesus our Savior, Redeemer, and Deliverer came to their rescue

Acts 9:1-22, The Voice

¹ Back to Saul—this fuming, raging, hateful man who wanted to kill every last one of the Lord’s disciples: he went to the high priest *in Jerusalem* ² for authorization to purge all the synagogues in Damascus of followers of the way of Jesus. ^[a] His plan was to arrest and chain any of Jesus’ followers—women as well as men—and transport them back to Jerusalem. ³ He traveled north toward Damascus *with a group of companions*.

Imagine this: Suddenly a light flashes from the sky around Saul, ⁴ and he falls to the ground at the sound of a voice.

The Lord: Saul, Saul, why are you attacking Me?

Saul: ⁵ Lord, who are You?

Then he hears these words:

The Lord: I am Jesus. I am the One you are attacking. ⁶ Get up. Enter the city. You will learn there what you are to do.

These are shocking, unexpected words that will change his life forever.

⁷ His other traveling companions just stand there, *paralyzed*, speechless because they, too, heard the voice; but there is nobody in sight. ⁸ Saul rises to his feet, his eyes wide open, but he can't see a thing. So his companions lead their blind friend by the hand and take him into Damascus. ⁹ He waits for three days—completely blind—and does not eat a bite or drink a drop of anything.

¹⁰ Meanwhile, in Damascus a disciple named Ananias had a vision in which the Lord Jesus spoke to him.

The Lord: Ananias.

Ananias: Here I am, Lord.

The Lord: ¹¹ Get up and go to Straight Boulevard. Go to the house of Judas, and inquire about a man from Tarsus, Saul by name. He is praying *to Me at this very instant*. ¹² He has had a vision—a vision of a man by your name who will come, lay hands on him, and heal his eyesight.

Ananias: ¹³ Lord, *I know whom You're talking about*. I've heard rumors about this fellow. He's *an evil man and* has caused great harm for Your special people in Jerusalem. ¹⁴ I've heard that he has been authorized by the religious authorities to come here and chain everyone who associates with Your name.

The Lord: ¹⁵ *Yes, but* you must go! I have chosen him to be My instrument to bring My name far and wide—to outsiders, to kings, and to the people of Israel as well. ¹⁶ I have much to show him, including how much he must suffer for My name.

¹⁷ So Ananias went and entered the house *where Saul was staying*. He laid his hands on Saul and called to him.

Ananias: Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on your way here, sent me so you can regain your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit.

¹⁸ At that instant, something like scales fell from Saul's eyes, and he could see. So he got up, received the ceremonial washing of baptism^[b] *identifying him as a disciple*, ¹⁹ ate some food (*remember, he had not eaten for three days*), and regained his strength. He spent a lot of time with the disciples in Damascus over the next several days. ²⁰ Then he went into the very synagogues he had intended to purge, proclaiming,

Saul: Jesus is God's Son!

²¹ Obviously this amazed everybody, and the buzz spread.

The People: Isn't he the man who caused so much trouble in Jerusalem for everyone identified with Jesus? Didn't he come here to arrest followers of Jesus and bring them in chains to the religious authorities? *Now he's switched sides and is preaching Jesus?*

²² As time passed, Saul's confidence grew stronger and stronger, so much so that he debated with the Jews of Damascus and made an irrefutable case that Jesus is, in fact, God's Anointed, *the Liberating King*.

An example of those who were spiritually blind was distracted from receiving their x-ray vision. Promises on exercising your faith to see the glory of God

Isaiah 28:6-8 takes notice when distraction is allowed to govern. It completely shatters communications between heaven and earth. The aforementioned scripture illustrates how they observed undivided focus but in the wrong area, i.e., self-indulgence. Because they

despised being a servant to God, they ultimately discontinued worshipping Him alone as well.

That tainted state reduced their ability to see, hear, touch, taste, and smell spiritually as well as naturally. They placed themselves in a position whereby they weren't able to accurately respond to God's bidding them because He no longer was the object of their affection.

Instead, they replaced the living God with a lifeless idol. It was a god, i.e., with a little "g" that could not see, hear, touch, taste, or smell. Even if the people were remotely attuned to Holy Spirit's promptings, their captivation with other things disabled His leading them into all truth. That posture as a lifestyle caused God to lose His voice on earth through them.

Personal testimonies of how Holy Spirit transitioned me into seeing in the spirit, i.e., x-ray vision

The Scene of Heaven Observed

Countless times as I am reading my Bible, a scripture will seem to pop off the page. In that one moment in time, it has shown just what Holy Spirit desired for me to receive.

I recall one of my first memories of seeing into the spirit realm. I was riding on the rapid transit to work and had a vision that our office door had been locked. Habitually, that door was always closed, but never locked. After arriving to work, I confirmed the locked door.

Now, I believe Holy Spirit was ushering me into having x-ray vision. He transitioned me from what I already knew to be true in the natural realm so that I could preview the change in the spiritual realm beforehand. In this case, He engaged my imagination with His picture.

This next story Holy Spirit answered my appeal through skywriting. Having returned to work with mobility restrictions from my doctor, the employer desired to assign the staff to make visitations throughout the program's neighborhood. Although they were fully aware of my authentically documented limitations, they persisted with their plans to move ahead without any regard.

I appealed to the Lord and He granted me a literal sign and wonder. I do not recall the reason but later on that day I just happened to go and look out of the front office window from the second floor. In the midst of the blue sky, an oversized letter "X" had already been formed out of white clouds. This was so real, not surreal! The God whom I serve has the final say-so and He said NO! After His divinely inspired visual verdict, the employer called off that detail and never even attempted to try it ever again. God's NO really means NO!

My personal testimonies of how communion with Holy Spirit gave me His step-by-step instructions so I would have good success in the assignment given because I had x-ray vision

God remains quite creative in getting and keeping your attention, interest, desire, and action to meet with you routinely and uninterruptedly. It may be through the written Word, *logos* and/or spoken Word, *rhema*. It may be through dreams and/or visions. It may be through signs and/or wonders. Whichever method He chooses, His voice is so unmistakable.

I will never forget the communications between my loving Heavenly Father regarding retirement. Before that time, I do not recall asking the Lord when to retire. However, if co-workers would inquire about the set time, I would simply say I was looking for the right opportunity instead. Now, I see that one reply kept my options open without sealing any potential plans the Lord had for me. Unbeknownst to me, Holy Spirit led me to retire before completing thirty years in that system successfully.

Originally, God's command to retire was verbal. As I awakened, Holy Spirit whispered His *rhema* word to me, "Stand down." Although I never served in the armed forces, I knew it was military jargon. Still, I did not know the meaning of that phrase. After coming across an internet resource, I had added clarity. The exact definition I discovered was, "retire from the current position." When I received orders from Heaven's Headquarters, I did not have enough service years credited nor was I age-eligible.

About a month later, the Spirit of God sealed His directive with a written confirmation from the *logos* Word of God. He drew my attention to a bible verse I don't recall ever seeing before then. In fact, I heard several people say, retire is not in the Bible. Citing the King James Version, Jeremiah 4:6 published the word "retire" in it, followed by the phrase "stay not." His amplified endorsement settled the matter that retirement was God's idea indeed, not something I concocted on my own.

God opened the door for me to acquire a .99% loan to purchase the remaining service credit, but I still had to wait for my 55th birthday which was approximately three months away. I kept moving forward and submitted all my paperwork. The retirement system usually notifies the establishment within a few days after submission.

With the odds stacked against me, I inquired of the Lord about keeping the date of retirement concealed until I was ready to disclose it. I whispered a prayer to God from my heart. I asked Him to show me a sign that the date would remain undisclosed. The same morning traveling on I-90W to my worksite, the Lord gave me a spectacular sign and wonder.

As I was driving, I just happen to look up to the place on the windshield where just one raindrop had landed. It was not raining nor was it in the forecast. Actually, the sky was blue and there were not any clouds in sight. All of a sudden a full-color rainbow appeared right before my eyes resting on the freeway, not in the sky. It was so brilliant and bodacious. It stood from ceiling to floor and from wall to wall. Without a shadow of a doubt, I knew that I knew that I knew God had covenanted with me to keep our secret safe. Just for me, God showcased His glorious works. God ensured me that the notification of retirement was totally preserved in my hands. That gave me the assurance that God alone is my Defender.

God's design for you to receive x-ray vision

Published in the *Hebrew Honey* the word "appear" is as one observing a vision. It means "Visibility must remain limitless so God will not be missed when He chooses to appear." From that definition, you can better understand that God always has something He desires you to receive from Him. With that in mind, our closeness to Him should remain where we perceive Him and never miss Him at any time.

Spiritual perception coexists through Holy Spirit alone. Although it is superior to any of the physical senses, it patterns one or all five when the download is received. Therefore, the message intended can be seen, heard, touched, tasted and smelled.

Each heavenly endowment is not just for the five-fold ministry. It is for anyone who God desires to confirm His will, i.e., those saved or unsaved. That being said, you can anticipate receiving God's messages to your heart as a believer. In the Holy Bible are numerous accounts where God supernaturally intervened so the adversary would know without a shadow of doubt that the message was ignited by the Lord.
