

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 232 Scriptures

This is Section X of a multi-part instruction. You are a chosen ambassador of the kingdom of God to reproduce heaven-born possibilities on earth. You have been appointed as a king-priest [non-gender specific]. Authority and power have been conferred to you to release miraculous provision into every sphere of influence. Your acknowledgement of the Kingdom of God within activates heaven on earth.

You have the crown. You wear the signet ring and hold the scepter. People even call you king. Your seat in heavenly places awaits your arrival. In fact, it is next to Jesus Christ who is already sitting at the right hand of our Heavenly Father, Abba. Will you grant permission to God to transform you into a ruling king and a representing priest unto Him?

Your invocation: "Abba Father, who art in Heaven, Hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Thank you giving us the days of heaven upon the earth. I believe to receive the kingdoms of this world have become [generated into] the kingdoms of our Lord and His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever. For Thine alone is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever. In Jesus' name, Amen!"

Authenticity of God is that He is the absolute truth you can absolutely trust at all times that your faith rests on

[**3670** /*homologéō* ("confess") means to *speak the same thing*, i.e. "assent, agree with, confess, declare, admit" (Vine, Unger, White, *NT*, 120).]

Only the context indicates whether **4100** /*pisteúō* ("believe") is self-serving (without sacred meaning), or the believing that leads to/proceeds from God's inbirthing of faith.

[*Heart* (**2588** /*kardía*) is mentioned over 800 times in Scripture, but *never* referring to the literal physical pump that drives the blood. That is, "heart" is *only used figuratively* (both in the OT and NT.)

4982 *sózō* (from *sōs*, "safe, rescued") – properly, *deliver* out of danger and *into safety*; used principally of God *rescuing* believers *from* the penalty and power of sin – *and into His provisions (safety)*.

[[4982](#) (*sózō*) is the root of: [4990](#) /*sōtēr* ("Savior"), [4991](#) /*sōtēria* ("salvation") and the adjectival form, [4992](#) /*sōtērion* (what is "saved/rescued from destruction and brought into divine safety").]

Faith advances and arrives at its destination, not at the origination when it hears the *rhéma* Word of God, the voice of Jesus Christ. Then that *rhéma* Word is received into the heart that resonates as the revelation. Then the *rhéma* Word that is released from your mouth resounds as the reality of Christ. In the end, the voice of Jesus reproduces heaven-born possibilities that silence every adversary. The enemy hears the voice of God as you speak and cannot distinguish between the voice of Jesus and yours.

Appropriate every salvation benefit by faith that brings heaven-born possibilities to you on earth

1 Peter 1:3-9, (KJV)

³ Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

⁴ To an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you,

⁵ Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

⁶ Wherein ye greatly rejoice, though now for a season, if need be, ye are in heaviness through manifold temptations:

⁷ That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ:

⁸ Whom having not seen, ye love; in whom, though now ye see him not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory:

⁹ Receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls.

Salvation benefits are complete in every way, embracing everything all the time. Psalm 67:1-2 (KJV) proves God's finishing touch when He employs the phrase, "saving health." The New Birth ignites our eternal covenant with the Lord. He covers your every weakness with His strength.

"Saving" and "health" carry identical meanings. Strong's Concordance highlights God's all-inclusive provision for you. You can access six diverse advantages in the earth now: 1) aid; 2) prosperity; 3) welfare; 4) help; 5) victory; and 6) deliverance.

Not only that, the Hebrew translation for saving health is *Yeshuah*. It shows Jesus and our Heavenly Father joined together. Therefore, *Yeshuah* is not misspelled when you see the "h" at the end of His name. In this context, it carries the greatest influence.

This is how I received revelation knowledge about Psalm 67:2. While I believed "Yeshuah" was not a misprint, I desired clarity. Holy Spirit helped me to stay ready to receive the answer many years later. I was listening to a Kenneth Copeland broadcast but had fallen asleep. Holy Spirit awakened me at the exact time Kenneth was discussing the letter "H" and then turned to the Academy's professor to confirm it as Abba's Hebrew name indeed.

While it authentically brands Jesus' identity in this case, it also designates God's seal of endorsement upon Jesus. It indicates God's own name rests upon Jesus. The last "h" in *Yeshuah* is the fifth letter of the Hebrew alphabet *Heh* (Hei). It is often used to represent the name of God; it sounds like the English letter "h" and pronounced as "hey."

By the time Psalm 67 was written by King David, God had already placed His name upon Israel in His blessing pronounced in Numbers 6:24-27 (KJV). Now God's name that's upon Jesus is also upon the

Body of Christ, the Church. Therefore, the blessing has also been conferred upon us to inherit and inhabit God's promises. "The LORD bless thee, and keep thee: The LORD make His face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee: The LORD lift up His countenance upon thee, and give thee peace. And they shall put My name upon the children of Israel, and I will bless them."

Dissolving all doubts, the entire Psalm 67 is an integral part of God's covert operations even in the Old Testament. Unbeknownst to enemy forces, King David's faith ushered Jesus Christ's identity as God's Son into the earth well before His arrival date. That served God's purpose as one of His ingenious ways to introduce the name of Jesus' along with publishing our salvation's benefits.

God's divine plan of sending His own Son from heaven to earth was never once detected or expected by satan. That shows just how far God will go to bring your divine inheritance to you without any interruption. God is an expert in hiding His treasure in His vault. The same protection and preservation plan He exhibited through Jesus Christ, He has for you, the treasure of His heart. That's breakthrough!

Heaven-born possibilities are ready to be downloaded to you. All these finished works have your name on them. Now by faith you can

receive total life makeover: spiritually, physically, emotionally, psychologically, relationally, vocationally, reproductively, financially, environmentally, mentally, economically, generationally, socially and genetically.

Accessibility into the kingdom of God gives you an audience with your heavenly Father and Jesus Christ through the Word of God and the Spirit of God that grants you the assurance that your faith will always be rewarded

Honorable and humbly, I share this eyewitness account of Cleveland, Ohio being divinely covered by the Lord of hosts in 2001. Having been divinely assigned as God's watchman over the City has increasingly more significance to my own life and ministry. After the following events, I better understand the priority of standing guard over my own heart, home, workplace, family, partners, city, and nation. Yes, standing guard to assure that nothing gets in that should be kept out and nothing gets out that should be kept in to secure God's intentions.

In the midst of some personal challenges a friend simply said, "Remember Psalm 91." That is a legacy psalm my grandmother Big-Ma instilled in us growing up as well as other neighborhood families verbatim. I pondered on this insightful truth that created an imagery of being fully covered by the One who is our incomparable Defender and a Mighty Warrior.

By the end of the week, my Refuge birthed an indelible song in my heart, entitled "Hiding Place." He perfectly fit that song in my spirit that inspired confidence in Him alone. I did not understand all that it was creating in heaven or earth, but I continued to sing it every day for over two weeks. Only after the events behind "9-11" surfaced could I see this psalm was one of the acceptable sacrifices God received that spared our City from potential ruin. Without a doubt, I believe there still may be other unknown or untold accounts other than my own.

Several years prior to 9-11, another prayer warrior enlightened me about the ruling spirits over Cleveland, so I began binding the spirits of murder and suicide, having a view of the Tower City as I journeyed to work. The Lord brought to mind a prophecy delivered in the 1980's by a renowned ministry declaring: "Cleveland will no longer be known as the mistake on the lake." In 2000, the Lord quickened in my spirit that Cleveland, Ohio will be known as the New International Bible Belt, paralleling the effects to the light of New Jerusalem in the book of Revelation.

Therefore, the morning of September 10, 2001 I didn't think it unusual to ask the Lord for Cleveland, Ohio as our inheritance as Psalm 2:8 endorses. After retiring that evening, the Lord gave me a clear vision of mounted horses with a host of angels in white apparel holding lit torches and I heard these *rhéma* words, "The City is safe." Puzzled and not knowing what was to befall our nation the following morning, I innocently received His message in my heart and drifted off to a restless sleep. The truth of the matter is I did not recall that vision until my older sister urged us to pray early afternoon the next day.

When I found out what transpired on 9-11, all fours planes had fallen. Documented accounts indicated that the fourth plane carrying sixteen passengers and crew succumbed in Pennsylvania was actually in Cleveland's airspace. It flew over Cleveland Hopkins International Airport but turned around. In response to knowing it was headed to Cleveland, there were moves to evacuate the downtown area and people were called not to report to scheduled meetings in that area.

I know our City was hedged by wall-to-wall divine protection that could not be penetrated by destruction's forces. While divine protection averted danger for Cleveland, it was in no way automatic at all. God's faithfulness to be the alert and active watchman over His Word caused what He said not to come back as an empty promise. Just like there were not any breaches between those angels in the vision, God's faithfulness is also without breach. Engage God's help as you employ Psalm 91 in your daily prayer and meditation time. His sweet presence will surround you with His angelic forces to keep you in tact no matter what fear, oppression, or terror you may face. You are empowered to defeat the enemy.

Life cannot be extinguished when God is enthroned in the hearts of receiving believers.
