

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 234 Scriptures

This is Section Z of a multi-part instruction. You are a chosen ambassador of the kingdom of God to reproduce heaven-born possibilities on earth. You have been appointed as a king-priest [non-gender specific]. Authority and power have been conferred to you to release miraculous provision into every sphere of influence. Your acknowledgement of the Kingdom of God within activates heaven on earth.

You have the crown. You wear the signet ring and hold the scepter. People even call you king. Your seat in heavenly places awaits your arrival. In fact, it is next to Jesus Christ who is already sitting at the right hand of our Heavenly Father, Abba. Will you grant permission to God to transform you into a ruling king and a representing priest unto Him?

Your invocation: "Abba Father, who art in Heaven, Hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Thank you giving us the days of heaven upon the earth. I believe to receive the kingdoms of this world have become [generated into] the kingdoms of our Lord and His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever. For Thine alone is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever. In Jesus' name, Amen!"

There is not one heaven-born possibility that can ever be accomplished without the presence and the power of Holy Spirit aka as the Spirit of God and the Holy Ghost. Holy Spirit is the Spirit of Jesus Christ. Holy Spirit's divine capabilities will be unpacked so that you will grant Him all the capacity He requires to receive all of Him.

You were created and recreated to stay Connected to Elohim

Genesis 1:26-28 (AMPC)

²⁶ God said, Let Us [Father, Son, and Holy Spirit] make mankind in Our image, after Our likeness, and let them have complete authority over the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, the [tame] beasts, and over all of the earth, and over everything that creeps upon the earth.

²⁷ So God created man in His own image, in the image *and* likeness of God He created him; male and female He created them.

²⁸ And God blessed them and said to them, Be fruitful, multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it [using all its vast resources in the service of God and man]; and have dominion over the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, and over every living creature that moves upon the earth.

Given additional details, man's form was fashioned as 'Ēlōhîm inflated the dust model of man with His own breath as recorded in Genesis 2:7. In Hebrew, the term "breath" is defined as "wind, angry or vital breath, divine inspiration, intellect, soul, spirit." The dust model of mankind came to life because of the life of God in the spirit, soul, and body.

Genesis 2:7 (KJV)

⁷ And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground [body], and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life [spirit]; and man became a living soul [soul].

After the resurrection of Jesus, He appeared to His disciples. After Jesus validated He was alive indeed, He breathed on them in order to re-create them through Holy Spirit. Now Holy Spirit was inside of them. It is the initiation of the New Birth experience. John 20:22 confirms the term "breathed" in Greek is identical to the Hebrew word "breathed" in Genesis 2:7. The Passion Translation research shows the word "breathed" only appears once in the New Testament in Greek.

John 20:22 The Passion Translation

²² Then, taking a deep breath, he blew^[a] on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit."^[b]

Footnotes

- a. 20:22 The Greek word used here does not appear elsewhere in the New Testament; however, it is the same word found in the Septuagint for when God "breathed" into Adam's nostrils the breath of life (Gen. 2:7). The beginning of new creation life came from the breath of Jesus. The mighty wind of Acts 2 was for power, the breath Jesus breathed into his disciples in this verse was for life.
- b. 20:22 Or "accept the Sacred Breath."

Incorruptible in Greek means immortal; not liable to corruption or decay; imperishable; indestructible

Seed in in Greek means parentage i.e., identity of one's parents

God's seal is upon Jesus and you have been sealed with Holy Spirit

HELPS Word-studies

4972 *sphragízō* (from **4973** /*sphragís*, "a seal") – properly, to seal (affix) with a signet ring or other instrument to stamp (a roller or seal), i.e. to *attest ownership, authorizing (validating)* what is sealed.

4972 /*sphragízō* ("to seal") signifies *ownership* and the full *security* carried by the backing (full authority) of the owner. "Sealing" in the ancient world served as a "legal signature" which guaranteed the promise (contents) of what was sealed.

[Sealing was sometimes done in antiquity by the use of religious tattoos – again signifying "*belonging to.*"]

John 6:27, (KJV)

²⁷ Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father **sealed**.

2 Corinthians 1:21-22, (KJV)

²¹ Now he which stablisheth us with you in Christ, and hath anointed us, is
God;

²² Who hath also **sealed** us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our
hearts.

Ephesians 1:11-13, (KJV)

¹¹ In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will:

¹² That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ.

¹³ In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were **sealed** with that Holy Spirit of promise,

Jesus taught His disciples about God's succession plan after His death, burial, resurrection and ascension. In doing so, He introduced Holy Spirit to them as the promise of the Father. In Luke 24:49, Jesus gave them a word picture of what to expect to receive from the baptism of the Holy Spirit. They were tasked not to physically leave the place Jesus commanded them to be until they received Holy Spirit who was assigned to complete and cram them.

Abba Father destined Holy Spirit to clothe each one of them with the *dunamis* power of God. But when He arrived, they would have to put Him on to invest in Him. In Greek, the word for "endued" is *enduo*, which is defined as "to put on, invest in clothing." It shows there is something we must do to be outfitted with Holy Spirit. Preserve an open heart unto God so you can adorn His heaven-born apparel that He designed for you to wear.

Luke 24:49 (KJV)

⁴⁹And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

Acts 2:32-33 is the manifestation the disciples received because of their obeisance and obedience to Jesus' command. The tangible evidence of the divine presence and divine power of God was seen through the baptism of Holy Spirit, whereby they spoke in other tongues, as Holy Spirit gave them utterance. Again, they had to preserve their voice to serve as the mouthpiece of God to speak in unknown tongues.

Acts 2:32-33 (KJV)

³²This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses.

³³Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.

Holy Spirit clothes the human spirit, i.e., the inner man. That is similar to a hand in a glove so you can move syncopated and synchronized with Him. First, Holy Spirit is present in you as a well of water springing up into everlasting life. However, toxicity stops well water from flowing clean. The presence of any poison makes it literally dead. Jesus taught the woman at the well in John 4:13-14 that Holy Spirit clears the path of anything toxic that could prevent the water from springing up as her pure source and supply of everlasting water.

Jesus Christ is the Way, God's channel for all mankind. Holy Spirit ushers you into the born again experience. Jesus desires you to experience His life to the full until it overflows with the fullness of the blessing. That is without anything missing, lacking, or broken. To accomplish that, God is the only one who can really be your Source and Supply.

John 4:13-14 (KJV)

¹³Jesus answered and said unto her, Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again:

¹⁴But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.

Secondly, Holy Spirit is present to flow out of you like rivers of living waters as Jesus spoke of the promise of the Father in John 7:38-39. Your acceptance of Jesus as your personal Savior and Lord repositions you to live heaven drenched.

That takes your born again experience to succeeding levels of the divine presence and divine power of God. Abide and anticipate more out of your intimacy with Jesus. In that place, you will incessantly and increasingly stream with the very life of God. Jesus desires you to experience His life to the full until it overflows into the lives of others. To accomplish that, God is your Surplus.

John 7:38-39 (KJV)

³⁸He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

³⁹(But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

The first indwelling experience Holy Spirit engages is during the birthing of a new convert, the New Birth. The second experience is when a Christian receives the baptism of the Holy Ghost. Someone asked me that since she was saved didn't she already have the Spirit of God in her. I replied yes. Prior to that time, I had been encouraging her to receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost by better understanding God's presence and power.

Never to make Holy Spirit seem insignificant at all, I gave her the following analogy: Holy Spirit during the New Birth is like drinking water; however, Holy Spirit during the baptism is more like drinking Boost[®], the nutritional drink that optimizes your diet. Holy Spirit is the divine upgrade you cannot afford to give any space restrictions or altogether pass up on receiving God's portion.

God desires to take you pass just being clothed by Holy Spirit. Acts 2:4 represents the initial baptism of Holy Spirit. In the Greek, the word "filled" is defined as "to complete." On the other hand the word "filled" in Ephesians 5:18 means "to cram." Therefore, subsequent infillings keeps you replenished.

Whenever there is a leak, lack, or you are lessened in anyway, learn how to posture yourself as a ready container that needs constant refueling. Your thirst will keep you there to drink into the Spirit.

The infilling of Holy Spirit is to supply you and the overflow is the surplus for everyone else. I recall my grandmother, Big-Ma would say to me to fill back up after I have been out ministering to others.

Acts 2:4 (KJV)

⁴And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Ephesians 5:18 (KJV)

¹⁸And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;

Acts 2:1-3, King James Version

¹ And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

² And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.

³ And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.

Matthew 3:9-17, The Voice

⁸⁻⁹ *If you think that simply hopping in the Jordan will cleanse you, then you are sorely mistaken. Your life must bear the fruits of turning toward righteousness. Nor are you correct if you think that being descended from Abraham is enough to make you holy and right with God. Yes, the children*

of Abraham are God's chosen children, but God can adopt as daughters and sons anyone He likes—He can turn these stones into sons if He likes.

To be made right with God, one must truly repent. It means to turn completely away from sin and completely toward God.

¹⁰ Even now there is an ax poised at the root of every tree, and every tree that does not bear good fruit will be cut down and tossed into the fire. ¹¹ I ritually cleanse you through baptism^[a] as a mark of turning your life around. But someone is coming after me, someone whose sandals I am not fit to carry, someone who is more powerful than I. He will wash^[b] you *not in water* but in fire and with the Holy Spirit. ¹² He carries a winnowing fork in His hand, and He will clear His threshing floor; He will gather up the good wheat in His barn, and He will burn the chaff with a fire that cannot be put out.

¹³ And then, *the One of whom John spoke—the all-powerful Jesus*—came to the Jordan from Galilee to be washed^[c] by John. ¹⁴ At first, John demurred. **John:** I need to be cleansed^[d] by You. Why do You come to me?

Jesus: ¹⁵ It will be right, true, and faithful to God's chosen path for you to cleanse Me *with your hands in the Jordan River*.

John agreed, and he ritually cleansed Jesus, *dousing Him in the waters of the Jordan*. ¹⁶ Jesus emerged from His baptism;^[e] and at that moment heaven was opened, and Jesus saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming upon Him, *alighting on His very body*.

Voice from Heaven: ¹⁷ This is My Son, whom I love; *this is the Apple of My eye*; with Him I am well pleased.

Because of that spiritual and supernatural transformation, we become a habitation of God through Holy Spirit where Jesus Christ lives in our hearts by faith. The outcome is also that the anointing within is empowered teach you, as noted in 1 John 2:27.

²⁷ But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.

HELPS Word-studies

1321 *didáskō* (from *daō*, "learn") – to teach (literally, "cause to *learn*"); instruct, impart knowledge (disseminate information).

In the NT, **1321** /*didáskō* ("teach") nearly always refers to teaching the Scriptures (the written Word of God). The key role of *teaching* Scripture is shown by its *great frequency* in the NT, and the variety of word-forms (cognates).

[This includes three noun-forms, two adjectival forms, and one verb, totaling about 220 occurrences in the NT].

Your divine certification verifies that the same resurrection power that raised Jesus Christ from the dead dwells in you even now. Romans 8:11 validates that you are not the same now as you were before being saved. That is the transformative influence of the New Birth. Now, designated as a habitation of God through Holy Spirit, Jesus lives in your heart by faith as your Savior and your Lord. You are naturally, supernatural!

Romans 8:11 The Voice (VOICE)

¹¹If the Spirit of the One who resurrected Jesus from the dead lives inside of you, then *you can be sure that* He who raised Him will cast *the light of life* into your mortal bodies through the life-giving power of the Spirit residing in you.

Another way to discern your divine certification from God is by your supernatural disposition in Christ. In Ephesians 1:3, the phrase "spiritual blessings" is translated in Greek by Strong's as being blessed with a "supernatural disposition."

That verifies that along with the indwelling resurrection power of Holy Spirit, God also anointed you to do the works Jesus did during His earthly ministry. That also qualifies you as a member of the Body of Christ to even do the greater works Jesus promised along with the presence and power of Holy Spirit. His super on your natural endorses and enforces the kingdom of God to rule over every realm on earth, even if it first appears to be unyielding. You are naturally, supernatural!

Ephesians 1:3 (KJV)

³Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:

Psalm 68:18-20 (KJV)

¹⁸Thou hast ascended on high, thou hast led captivity captive: thou hast received gifts for men; yea, for the rebellious also, that the LORD God might dwell among them.

¹⁹Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah.

²⁰He that is our God is the God of salvation; and unto GOD the Lord belong the issues from death.

Ephesians 3:14-21, (KJV)

¹⁴For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,

¹⁵Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named,

¹⁶That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man;

THE MIND OF CHRIST IN YOU

God's design includes all of us hosting His indwelling Holy Spirit within. As we remove all boundaries, He can become fully functional. When the borders are opened up to Holy Spirit, you will recognize and realize the mind of Christ 24/7/365 and in leap years 366 days. Now that you know He always remains accessible to you, be determined to become more adaptable and adoptable to all of His moves, cues, and clues at all times.

I Corinthians 2nd chapter outline the recipients of God's Spirit. The process of the New Birth cannot be complete without the presence and power of Holy Spirit. When someone isn't saved, he only has the wisdom of the world to draw from. When someone is saved, he learns to make an uncommon practice to listen to and listen for the voice of Holy Spirit's prompting. If he does not, he will remain subject to the wisdom of the world until he makes a conscious choice.

Refuse to be or stay in any limiting category when you can completely operate in the God Class with His IQ. God's seamless connection is always sanctioned by the Spirit of God and the Word of God. The divine presence of God imparts His confidence within you while the divine power of God imparts His competency within you.

His indwelling presence and power do not just take up space. The IQ of the Almighty God is deposited within you is "the mind of Christ," the very intellect of Jesus. Then His IQ can be widely distributed through you to serve your divine assignment with appointed solutions.

That's living heaven on earth when you download revelation knowledge from God and bring it full circle to revolutionize the world system. Your New Birth grants you a supernatural deposition even on earth. Refuse to leave your God-given influence untapped.

Your born-again experience brings you into the kingdom of God. The kingdom of God is within you even now. Because of your divine upgrade, the new life you live is beyond the world system. You house the capacity to re-present God within you, the mind of Christ for every divine assignment. When the world around you begins to look at the supernatural works of God that are dispensed through you, they will visually see His good, acceptable and perfect will before their very eyes.

Holding the capacity of the mind of Christ, you have the capability to lead, think, feel, choose, believe and receive in the exact way as Jesus Christ moved about throughout the earth. That showcased the works of God that Jesus performed during His earthly ministry. We also have the competence to do the greater works Jesus promised we would do with Holy Spirit's abiding presence and power. You have already been equipped to reproduce heaven on earth.

1 Corinthians 2 (KJV)

¹ And I, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring unto you the testimony of God. ² For I determined not to know anything among you, save Jesus Christ, and Him crucified. ³ And I was with you in weakness, and in fear, and in much trembling. ⁴ And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power: ⁵ That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God. ⁶ Howbeit we speak wisdom among them that are perfect: yet not the wisdom of this world, nor of the princes of this world, that come to nought: ⁷ But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory: ⁸ Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory. ⁹ But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love Him. ¹⁰ But God hath revealed them unto us by His Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God. ¹¹ For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God. ¹² Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. ¹³ Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual. ¹⁴ But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. ¹⁵ But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is

judged of no man. ¹⁶ For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? but we have the mind of Christ.

Holy Spirit saturates you with at least twenty-seven capabilities that are compartmentalized within the following three main categories: Wisdom; Love; and Power. 2 Timothy 1:6-7 names the three diverse groups for the purpose of you activating them completely through Holy Spirit alone. With each one fully operational, you are flooded with God Himself. That gives God every opportunity to fully express Himself without any limitations.

2 Timothy 1:6-7 King James Version (KJV)

⁶ Wherefore I put thee in remembrance that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands. ⁷ For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind [wisdom].

In the Wisdom class, the first nine are from Isaiah 11:2-5, 10. They are 1) wisdom, 2) understanding, 3) counsel, 4) might, 5) knowledge, 6) fear of the Lord [reverence], 7) righteousness, 8) faithfulness, and 9) glorious [glory].

Resting in the Lord allows them to have full habitation in you, not just visitation. Holy Spirit rested on Jesus and never departed from Him; Jesus never vexed Him at all.

Isaiah 63:10 an example of what happens when Holy Spirit is vexed. It indicates someone keeps pulling until he completely disconnects from Him. "But they rebelled, and vexed His Holy Spirit: therefore He was turned to be their enemy, and He fought against them."

Isaiah 11:2, 5, 10 King James Version (KJV)

² And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD; ⁵ And righteousness shall be the girdle of His loins, and faithfulness the girdle of His reins. ¹⁰ And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and His rest shall be glorious.

In the Love class, the next nine are from Galatians 5:22-23. They include 1) love, 2) joy, 3) peace, 4) longsuffering, 5) gentleness, 6) goodness, 7) faith, 8) meekness, and 9) temperance.

Yielding to Holy Spirit, there is both protection and preservation. God's seal of endorsement rests upon both Jesus Christ and Holy

Spirit. Therefore, the fruit of the Spirit that is in as well as operates through you are sealed making you supernaturally impenetrable as well. That is similar to coating fruit with natural wax to protect it from rotting. Then His fruitfulness can be clearly tasted and seen that the Lord is indeed good.

Ephesians 4:30 counsels us to not grieve Holy Spirit, so He won't lose any opportunity to express Himself through us. "And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption."

Galatians 5:22-23 (KJV)

²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, ²³ Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

In the Power class, the remaining nine are from I Corinthians 12:8-11. They encompass 1) the word of wisdom [different from wisdom], 2) the word of knowledge, 3) the gift of faith [different from the fruit of faith], 4) the gifts of healing, 5) the working of miracles, 6) prophecy, 7) discerning of spirits, 8) divers kinds of tongues, and 9) interpretation of tongues.

Walking softly before the Lord helps you to discern the move of Holy Spirit to ensure what God has designed can never be extinguished. Live so you never think His divine intervention is an unscheduled interruption you take the option to reject. 1 Thessalonians 5:19 instructs us with these words, "Quench not the Spirit."

1 Corinthians 12:4-11 (KJV)

⁴ Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. ⁵ And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. ⁶ And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all. ⁷ But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. ⁸ For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; ⁹ To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; ¹⁰ To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: ¹¹ But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as He will.

Holy Spirit is the One who ushers you into your formal introduction to your Heavenly Father, Abba as shown in Galatians 4:1-7. He even teaches you how to address and acknowledge Abba as your Heavenly Father. In Greek, "Abbá is defined as Father, also used as

the term of *tender endearment* by a beloved child – i.e. in an *affectionate, dependent* relationship with their father; *daddy, papa.*" Then God is no longer just Mr. God to you. Holy Spirit helps you to live comfortably as Abba's adopted son or adopted daughter, not just a servant and never a slave.

Holy Spirit also brings you into the realization of your preferred status of not just being an heir of God but also a joint heir with Jesus Christ. You see, the word "joint" grants you with mutual access to your heavenly inheritance. That begins on earth with your New Birth. In other words, you now receive the rights of the first-born as well as the double portion of the blessing. Your equal share is discovered in Christ alone.

Galatians 4:1-7 (KJV)

- ¹ Now I say, That the heir, as long as he is a child, differeth nothing from a servant, though he be lord of all;
- ² But is under tutors and governors until the time appointed of the father.
- ³ Even so we, when we were children, were in bondage under the elements of the world:
- ⁴ But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law,
- ⁵ To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.
- ⁶ And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.
- ⁷ Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

Furthermore, Holy Spirit ushers you into real intimacy with Abba as seen in Romans 8:14-17. His undisputable leadership begins at our New Birth. He confirms our divine status as children, heirs, and joint-heirs. He resides within us and with us at all times to teach us all things.

Holy Spirit is a very present and active force in our lives as we yearn for and to yield to Him all the time, whether the situation may look advantageous or not. He reminds us what Jesus said, shows us things to come, and guides us into all truth. Holy Spirit as your permanent Professor ensures you can pass every proficiency test or trial as well as help you to avoid yielding to any temptation. In the end, you will still have the winning position.

Jesus introduced Holy Spirit as a Comforter to His disciples. Either Holy Spirit consoles, coaches, counsels, consults, or choreographs your pathway to bring you into the good, acceptable, and perfect will of God. When He orders your steps, victory is preserved. You never have to succumb to premature defeat because God recreated you to be more than a conqueror through Christ who loved you so much that He couldn't leave you in that fallen state.

Romans 8:14-17 (KJV)

- ¹⁴ For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.
¹⁵ For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.
¹⁶ The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:
¹⁷ And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.

In Jesus' own words, He promised with great assurance that you can always count on Him at any time. Through His Spirit, i.e., Holy Spirit, He will personally come to you. In Greek, the word "comfortless" from John 14:18, the scripture indicates someone without a father, mother, teacher or guide.

That classifies being an orphan, i.e., someone who is left on his/her own to fend for himself/herself. God prearranged you to opt-out on living fatherless. In that way, you can opt-in on inheriting and inhabiting your adoption rights that are already available through Jesus Christ alone.

John 14:18 (KJV)

- ¹⁸ I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.

SURRENDER ALL

This is what occurs at the point of our born again experience in which the Spirit of God and the Word of God always lead the spiritual transformation process supernaturally. When we accept the Invitation to Christ after hearing the message of the Gospel of Christ, our spirit and body become the habitation of God through the indwelling Holy Spirit. I Corinthians 6:19-20 reveals our divine purpose as the temple of Holy Spirit.

In other words, set apart for heaven's expression on earth is God's plan for our spirit and body as a habitation of God through Holy Spirit where Jesus Christ lives in your heart by faith. Only in yearning and yielding both, your spirit and body to the Lord continuously, He is glorified. That is your spirit and body living surrendered!

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁹ What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? ²⁰ For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

²¹ We also have a great *cohen* [High Priest] over God's household. ²² Therefore, let us approach the Holiest Place with a sincere heart, in the full assurance that comes from trusting — with our hearts **sprinkled clean** from a bad conscience and our bodies washed with **pure water**.^[a] ²³ Let us continue holding fast to the hope we acknowledge, without wavering; for the One who made the promise is trustworthy.

However, our soul must be renewed habitually and uninterruptedly to maintain our union with Christ as Romans 12:1-2 records. Now

the soul is comprised of: 1) your thoughts, how you think; 2) your emotions, how you feel; and 3) your will, what you choose.

This is what your soul resembles when it yearns to yield to the lordship of Jesus Christ. Your thoughts, emotions, and will collectively surrender to serve God alone. It lovingly and loyally lives as a living sacrifice to Him. That is what ignites serving the Lord both honorably and humbly. That fuels, floods, and fulfills your worship to God in spirit and in truth. That is your soul living surrendered!

Romans 12:1-2 King James Version (KJV)

¹ I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. ² And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Holy Spirit is your most accurate and approachable Master Teacher. He is God's Global Positioning System (GPS) that you have total access to on earth. Holy Spirit gently draws you into experiencing the New Birth and then graciously lives within you the moment you are saved which is confirmed in 1 Corinthians 3:16.

1 Corinthians 3:16 (AMPC)

¹⁶Do you not discern *and* understand that you [the whole church at Corinth] are God's temple (His sanctuary), and that God's Spirit has His permanent dwelling in you [to be at home in you, ^[a]collectively as a church and also individually]?

Holy Spirit is eternal. Holy Spirit's time frame is "seasonless" and He covers now throughout all eternity, moment by moment. Holy Spirit is the Spirit of Jesus. He is your source, supply, and surpass of all comfort.

Holy Spirit supernaturally removes any estrangement from your relationship with Abba Father. He embraces so you always feel so at ease to call God by His most endearing name, Daddy! Daddy! And that is even at the time you give your heart to Jesus Christ as your Savior and Lord.

Because Holy Spirit's dwelling place resides in eternity, He always holds all the capacity and capability of God. He is not only omniscient, but also omnipresent as well as omnipotent.

Therefore, Holy Spirit can and will successfully usher you throughout your entire life to each place the Lord designed and desires for you to embrace, expect, experience, and enjoy on earth. Holy Spirit's permanence gives you the confidence in knowing He always flawlessly draws from heaven-born possibilities to make deposits into your heart at the perfect time. As you yield to yearn for Him and lean to learn from Him, He eagerly accepts your invitation and will never reject it.

Jesus confirmed that Holy Spirit absolutely knows the mind of God simply because He is the mind of God. In John 14:26, John 14:16-17, and John 16:13, Jesus illustrates Holy Spirit's express capability to bridge the past, the present and the prospective in order to blend them into eternity without any potential error. In doing so, your perception of time without end will be forever revolutionized as you create space to have and host the mind of Christ, the very intellect of Jesus.

5241/hyperentygxánō ("intercede") refers to the Holy Spirit interceding in every scene of our lives so we can "come in line with" the Lord's *eternal purpose*. The content of these intercessions goes beyond human language, and includes bringing *sacred mysteries* into our daily walk with Christ.

1793 *entygxánō* (from **1722** /*en*, "in," which intensifies **5177** /*tygxánō*, "to obtain by hitting the mark") – properly, "light upon (meet with), obtain" (*LS*); "to go and meet a person to converse, consult," i.e. to *intervene* ("intersect with").

[J. Thayer documents how this meaning is consistently the same in ancient Greek writers.

The root of **5177** (*tygxánō*) means "to strike, hit the bulls-eye" ("spot on"). Accordingly, it is used in classical Greek as the *antonym* of *harmartia* ("to miss the mark, sin"), so Lucian, Xenophon, Homer, etc. (see Thayer, **5177** /*tygxánō*.)]

Phonetic Spelling: (pros-yoo'-khom-ahee)

Definition: to pray

Usage: I pray, pray for, offer prayer.

HELPS Word-studies

4336 *proseúxomai* (from 4314 /*prós*, "towards, exchange" and 2172/*euxomai*, "to wish, pray") – properly, to exchange wishes; *pray* – literally, to *interact with* the Lord by switching human *wishes* (ideas) for *His wishes* as He imparts faith ("divine *persuasion*"). Accordingly, praying (4336/*proseuchomai*) is closely inter-connected with 4102 /*pístis* ("faith") in the NT. See: Ac 6:5,6,14:22,23; Eph 6:16-18; Col 1:3,4; 2 Thes 3:1,2; Js 5:13-15; Jude 20.
