EVERY WORD COUNTS TOWARD VICTORY OR DEFEAT

After Goliath terrorized Israel twice daily for 40 days, David accepted his challenge because he found something worth fighting for, the reward. He carried this testimony: the same God who delivered him from the lion and bear would deliver him from the giant. Only surrendering to God, he resisted the enemy with overcoming faith. Therefore, he never once forfeited, conceded, retreated, or even became an obstruction against his own breakthrough. Not even a giant could dominate the situation; this teen was

supernaturally and naturally ready with faith-filled words. David was so conscious of his words that he called his tongue, "my glory". Refusing to compromise victory with wrong words, David's praise enthroned God. The last words Goliath heard was how his end was going to play out. Faith-filled words invite the Lord to remove the giant that is bigger than you. "And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith [of] God. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith", Mark 11:22-23. Faith is voice-activated. You outtalk your enemy as you magnify God. The power of right words pre-plays the outcome in advance. What makes it "a good fight of faith" [I Tim. 6:12] is the victory is actually an instant replay.

FOLLOW OUR HERITAGE OF FAITH TO RECEIVE THE IMPOSSIBLE

Faith revolutionizes your living. "Against all odds, Abraham's hope grew into full-fledged faith that he would be the father of many nations, just as God had promised when He said, "That's how many your descendants will be." His faith did not fail, although he was well aware of his impotence, after nearly 100 years, was as good as dead and that Sarah's womb, too, was dead [always barren, now 90 years old]. In spite of all this, his faith in God's promise did not falter. In fact, his faith grew as he gave glory to God because he was supremely confident that God could deliver on His promise," Romans 4:18-21 (Voice). Recognize God's eagerness to do the impossible. Realize your limitations. Remain committed to do what's possible as directed by Holy Spirit. Release God to deliver the finished work.

A FIXED HEART WORKS ALL THINGS TOGETHER FOR YOUR GOOD

Psalm 112:7, "[The righteous] shall not be afraid of evil tidings: his heart is

fixed, trusting in the Lord". To believe right, our hearts must be altered to trust God's Word alone. That keeps faith predetermined to be the overcomer. Maintaining our loyalty causes us to live non-negotiable in the presence of any contradiction. However, the children of Israel could not initially enter into the promised land because of their unbelief. God's Word did not profit them because it was never mixed with faith. Keep this in mind: the Word and faith must be tempered together. Fusing causes one part to qualify the other, dissolving all doubt.

PRACTICE THE ART OF RECEIVING BY FAITH: CATCH, DON'T BAT AWAY

Jesus said, "And all things, whatsoever you ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive," Matthew 21:22. If you won't receive what you can see in the natural world, how can you receive the unseen that's in the supernatural world? Develop and keep a receiving heart. As you do, you will always maintain an outlook that always remains on the lookout. It's an art!

GOD CUTS THE FLAMES OUT OF THE FIRE IF YOU ARE IN THE HOT SEAT

Although King Nebuchadnezzar's law made the death sentence seem final, Shadrach, Meshach, Abednego's faith never wavered about God delivering them. Daniel 3:17 "If it be so", i.e., if they were thrown in the fiery furnace, God would save them. Then Daniel 3:18, "But if not" i.e., if the king chose not to throw them in the fire, they would still not bow to another god. Yes, they were thrown in, but they never burned because they never bowed.

"If your faith were only the size of a mustard seed," Jesus answered, "it would be large enough to uproot that mulberry tree over there and send it hurtling into the sea! Your command would bring immediate results! Luke 17:6, TLB. "Now faith" never has to wait; however, there is a perfect time of delivery.

Your Faith in Action

Faith is activated when your heart believes the word God speaks is the absolute truth, knowing He cannot lie or deceive you. Romans 10:17 confirms "... faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." Webster's 1828 edition defines faith as "belief: the assent of the mind to the truth of what is declared by another, resting on his authority and veracity, without other evidence; the judgement that what another states or testifies is the truth". As we cherish our relationship with God, the quality of our faith improves. Because He is so real to us, we long to be with Him more. "...the people who know their God shall be strong and do great things." Daniel 11:32, TLB. Intimacy with God postures our heart to receive miracles from Him effortlessly. Everything He has for you is with Him.

Faith to Exit, Faith to Enter. Faith used to close doors may need to be adjusted to open doors. God was not only known for bringing Israel out of Egypt but also for taking them into the Promised Land. The reality of faith requires distinction.

Exodus 14:13-31, GOD'S WORD Translation

The LORD Divides the Red Sea

¹³ Moses answered the people, "Don't be afraid! Stand still, and see what the LORD will do to save you today. You will never see these Egyptians again. ¹⁴ The LORD is fighting for you! So be still!"

¹⁵ Then the LORD said to Moses, "Why are you crying out to me? Tell the Israelites to start moving. ¹⁶ Raise your staff, stretch out your hand over the sea, and divide the water. Then the Israelites will go through the sea on dry ground. ¹⁷ I am making the Egyptians so stubborn that they will follow the Israelites. I will receive honor because of what I will do to Pharaoh, his entire army, his chariots, and cavalry. ¹⁸ The Egyptians will know that I am

the LORD when I am honored for what I did to Pharaoh, his chariots, and his cavalry.”

¹⁹ The Messenger of God, who had been in front of the Israelites, moved behind them. So the column of smoke moved from in front of the Israelites and stood behind them ²⁰ between the Egyptian camp and the Israelite camp. The column of smoke was there when darkness came, and it lit up the night. Neither side came near the other all night long.

²¹ Then Moses stretched out his hand over the sea. All that night the LORD pushed back the sea with a strong east wind and turned the sea into dry ground. The water divided, ²² and the Israelites went through the middle of the sea on dry ground. The water stood like a wall on their right and on their left.

²³ The Egyptians pursued them, and all Pharaoh’s horses, chariots, and cavalry followed them into the sea. ²⁴ Just before dawn, the LORD looked down from the column of fire and smoke and threw the Egyptian camp into a panic. ²⁵ He made the wheels of their chariots come off so that they could hardly move. Then the Egyptians shouted, “Let’s get out of here! The LORD is fighting for Israel! He’s against us!”

²⁶ Then the LORD said to Moses, “Stretch out your hand over the sea so that the water will flow back over the Egyptians, their chariots, and their cavalry.”

²⁷ Moses stretched his hand over the sea, and at daybreak the water returned to its usual place. The Egyptians tried to escape, but the LORD swept them into the sea. ²⁸ The water flowed back and covered Pharaoh’s entire army, as well as the chariots and the cavalry that had followed Israel into the sea. Not one of them survived.

²⁹ Meanwhile, the Israelites had gone through the sea on dry ground while the water stood like a wall on their right and on their left. ³⁰ That day the LORD saved Israel from the Egyptians, and Israel saw the Egyptians lying

dead on the seashore. ³¹ When the Israelites saw the great power the LORD had used against the Egyptians, they feared the LORD and believed in him and in his servant Moses.

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THE AUTHORITY OF FAITH'S COMMAND IS AT YOUR BECKONING CALL

See real-time faith in Esther 7:8, (KJV): "Then the king returned out of the palace garden into the place of the banquet of wine; and Haman [commotion] was fallen upon the bed whereon Esther was. Then said the king, 'Will he force the queen also before me in the house?' As the word went out of king's mouth, they covered Haman's face." The king's servants never hesitated in following his command. Soon as the king voiced the very first word, they shadowed each succeeding word. They completed his assignment immediately following his last word. It is also in Matthew 8:5-10, 13, (KJV). "And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto Him a centurion, beseeching Him, And saying, 'Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented.' And Jesus saith unto him, 'I will come and heal him.' The centurion answered and said, 'Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed. For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this man, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it,' When Jesus heard it, He marvelled, and said to them that followed, 'Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel. And Jesus said unto the centurion, 'Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee.' And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour." With one hundred soldiers at his command, the centurion clearly realized his earthly authority as well as Jesus' heavenly influence. He knew the word sent out

was sure. Orders conveyed convinced him the transaction was also complete: nothing missing, nothing lacking, or nothing broken.

THE FAITH RECEIVED TO BIRTH THE LIVING AND TO RAISE THE DEAD

“(as it is written, “*I have made you the father of many nations*”). He is our father in the presence of God whom he believed—the God who makes the dead alive and summons the things that do not yet exist as though they already do,” Romans 4:17, (NET). “By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had received *anaděchōmai* the promises offered up his only begotten son, of whom it was said, ‘That in Isaac shall thy seed be called’: Accounting that God was able to raise him up, even from the dead; from whence also he received *kōmizō* him in a figure,” Heb. 11:17-19. Two degrees of receiving: the first, birthed Isaac through God’s omnipotence, not Abraham’s and Sarah’s impotence. In verse 17, received means to “undertake, assume the responsibility of,” i.e., relieved him from lack of having an heir. The second, raised Isaac from the dead. Abraham knew when God commanded him to sacrifice Isaac that He also considered him deceased. Abraham’s faith raised Isaac from the dead. In verse 19, received means “receive back, receive what has belonged to myself but has been,” i.e., retrieved him from loss thus birthing Jesus.

BREACHPROOF GOD’S WORD IN YOUR HEART AND IN YOUR MOUTH

“But without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him,” Heb. 11:6, (KJV). The measure of faith residing in you is established on the majesty of God and His Word alone, never by majority rule. The children of Israel were in unbelief. They refused to receive God’s promise as the absolute truth they could absolutely trust at all times which left them to experience their own concocted lie they believed about God, i.e., to know the breach of promise. Therefore, God’s judgment for them

turned into His judgment against them. "After the number of the days in which ye searched the land, even forty days, each day for a year, shall ye bear your iniquities, even forty years, and ye shall know My breach of promise," Numbers 14: 34, (KJV). Always take Him at His Word. Breachproof God's vowed promises.

MAKE ROOM FOR GREATER WORKS TO BE BORN THROUGH HOLY SPIRIT

Song of Solomon 4:2, declares even the barren has twins. "Thy teeth are like a flock of sheep that are even shorn, which came up from the washing; whereof every one bear twins, and none is barren among them." Mass miracles were demonstrated during Jesus' ministry. "And the whole multitude sought to touch Him: for there went virtue out of Him, and healed them all," Luke 6:19. In Greek, the word "virtue" is defined as *dunamis*, i.e., "miraculous power of God." You have power with God because His supernatural ability rests upon your natural ability. In Eph. 1:3, spiritual blessings means "supernatural disposition" in Greek or 'benefit' as in the J.B. Phillips. "Praise be to God for giving us through Christ every possible spiritual benefit as citizens of Heaven!" You are naturally supernatural. Internally procreative power is in your loins. God's Word stretches your faith to reproduce heaven's magnitude.

A chainsaw is cutting-edge technology. "It cuts with a set of teeth attached to a rotating chain driven along a guide bar." Powered on, any binding tie is severed. Just hold it to the object until the work is complete. You don't have to exert any pressure. It works for you as long as it is held to the goal. The powered Word of God works the God-kind of faith in you: "Let us continue holding fast to the hope we acknowledge, without wavering; for the One who made the promise is trustworthy," Heb. 10:23, (CJB). "For we have become sharers in the Messiah, provided, however, that we hold firmly to the conviction we began with, right through until the goal is reached," Heb.

3:14, (CJB). *God's Logos Power Tool: "For whatever God says to us is full of living power: it is sharper than the sharpest dagger, cutting swift and deep into our innermost thoughts and desires with all their parts, exposing us for what we really are," Heb. 4:12, (TLB). God's Rhema Power Tool: "Embrace the power of salvation's full deliverance, like a helmet to protect your thoughts from lies. And take the mighty razor-sharp Spirit-sword of the spoken Word of God," Eph. 6: 17-18 (TPT).*

Faith with Love Never Fails!

Inevitability is based on intimacy. Jesus revealed God's faith works by His love. "To have faith is to be sure of the things we hope for, to be certain of the things we cannot see," Heb. 11: 1, (GNT). In Him, live, move, have your being in His love.

"These accounts are recorded so that you, too, might believe that Jesus is the Anointed, the Liberating King, the Son of God, because believing grants you the life He came to share." John 20:13, (VOICE)

The Spirit of Faith

Speak the Word of God with the voice of Jesus. Confessing faith uses your conversational voice but commanding faith, your conquering voice. Faith advances and arrives at its destination—not origination—when it hears the voice of God, rhema i.e., His "poured forth" Word. The rhema resident in your heart resounds out of your mouth as rhema creating heaven on earth. Once you release rhema, the voice of God is heard, not yours. Don't lose God's voice in the earth. Silence all adversaries.

Professional Believer

Hebrews 10:23 says, "Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering (for he is faithful that promised)." We are called professional believers within the kingdom of God.

Faith is more than just a function; it becomes the occupation and lifestyle of the believer. Romans 1:17 confirms this when it says, "The just shall live by faith." We then can experience everything in life with God. Moreover, from each life experience to the next, we can go from one level of faith to the next.

At one time or another, your heart has displayed one of the four following traits. The state of the heart reflects your degree of faith. If you clearly understand your posture of belief in every area of life, your heart will never be the mountain that hinders you from receiving from God.

State of the Heart Trait of the Heart

Unbelieving-Unbelievers Must always see it to believe it

Unbelieving-Believers Skeptical about seeing what they believe

Believing-Believers Only sees the future brighter, never having any proof of the finished work

Receiving-Believers

Confidently receives the end of its faith now,
so patiently endures until manifestation comes

Press toward becoming a Receiving-Believer! To encourage you to receive by faith, Hebrews 11:13 provides four principles to help you believe to see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living:

Although invisible, your heart sees the promise from afar and has a clear image of it.

Although inconceivable, your heart is persuaded that the promise is already in your possession.

Although intangible, your heart embraces the promise as if you could touch it.

Although indefinable, your mouth calls the promise by its name.

Let's take a closer look at Hebrews 11:13-16 to see why some never received the promises of God. "These all died in faith, not having received the promises but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth. "For they that say such things declare plainly that they seek a country. And truly, if they had been mindful of that country from which they came out, they might have had opportunity to return. But now they desire a better country, that is, an heavenly: wherefore God is not ashamed to be called their God; for he hath prepared for them a city."

First, their heart had a clear image of the promises they were to receive in the earth, but it had a clearer vision of the prepared city in heaven.

Secondly, their heart was persuaded of the promises, they were to receive on earth; but it was even more convinced of the prepared city in heaven.

Thirdly, their heart embraced the promises they were to receive on earth; but it held the title deed to the prepared city in heaven.

So their mouth reproduced what impacted their heart the most, This world is not my home. Heaven is my home. So they died having not received the promises.

Yes, heaven is a much better place; but they never received their earthly promises because of what they continually practiced with their own mouth. Consequently, their own confession overrode the adopted vision and conviction.

They allowed a mountain to impair their vision. They allowed a mountain to hinder their quality of life in the earth. They allowed a mountain to stop what they could own in the earth because they never made room for it. At this time, God needs us to complete His work in the earth. He doesn't need us in heaven.
