

## **The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 248 Scriptures**

**This is Section M of a multi-part instruction. Similar to a nation sending an ambassador into a territory, Jesus commanded the body of Christ to go into all the world. Although your kingdom of God assignment is in the world system, it is not in you. Jesus Christ is! You are His anointed carrier of the presence of God as well as the power of God. Your appointment is to bring the world into the kingdom of God until it is proof positive that, "those who have turned the world upside down are come here too!" Really, upside down is right side up!**

**Jesus' succession plan names you as His change agent to serve His divine purpose, plan, and path in one or even all the Seven Mountains: 1) government; 2) business; 3) media; 4) education; 5) arts & entertainment; 6) religion; and 7) family. Every Kingdom of God assignment is established on the Word of God as well as executed by the Spirit of God. If it is not, the mission will be an obstruction against your own breakthrough. Your minimum contribution is by prayer and petition, i.e., to intercede. Your maximum contribution is by practice and participation in the sphere(s) of influence God has chosen for you, i.e., to intervene.**

**Never give your seat of authority to an already failed world system. Let Holy Spirit reposition you to always "see" Jesus as He really is, the King of kings. Then grant the Lord of lords all the living room He requires, without issuing any eviction clauses. As your space restrictions are demolished, you can "be" as Jesus is in the world, a world overcomer. In other words, you are living on top of the world; it is not living on top of you.**

**This is the house God built: Jesus Christ is the Chief Cornerstone. The apostles and prophets laid the foundation. You are one of the many living stones**

Isaiah 28:15-18, Amplified Bible, Classic Edition

<sup>15</sup> Because you have said, We have made a covenant with death, and with Sheol (the place of the dead) we have an agreement—when the overflowing scourge passes through, it will not come to us, for we have made lies our refuge, and in falsehood we have taken shelter.

**16** Therefore thus says the Lord God, Behold, I am laying in Zion for a foundation a Stone, a tested Stone, a precious Cornerstone of sure foundation; he who believes (trusts in, relies on, and adheres to that Stone) will not <sup>[a]</sup>*be ashamed or give way or* hasten away [in sudden panic].

**17** I will make justice the measuring line and righteousness the plummet; and hail will sweep away the refuge of lies, and waters will overwhelm the hiding place (the shelter).

**18** And your covenant with death shall be annulled, and your agreement with Sheol (the place of the dead) shall not stand; when the overwhelming scourge passes through, then you will be trodden down by it.

**4** Come to Him [then, to that] Living Stone which men <sup>[a]</sup>tried *and* threw away, but which is chosen [and] precious in God's sight.

**5** [Come] and, like living stones, be yourselves built [into] a spiritual house, for a holy (dedicated, consecrated) priesthood, to offer up [those] spiritual sacrifices [that are] acceptable *and* pleasing to God through Jesus Christ.

**6** For thus it stands in Scripture: Behold, I am laying in Zion a chosen (<sup>[b]</sup>honored), precious chief Cornerstone, and he who believes in Him [who adheres to, trusts in, and relies on Him] shall never be <sup>[c]</sup>disappointed *or* put to shame.

**7** To you then who believe (who adhere to, trust in, and rely on Him) is the preciousness; but for those who disbelieve [it is true], The [very] Stone which the builders rejected has become the main Cornerstone,

**8** And, A Stone that will cause stumbling and a Rock that will give [men] offense; they stumble because they disobey *and* disbelieve [God's] Word, as those [who reject Him] were destined (appointed) to do.

**You serve as a member as the Body of Christ that is fitly framed together as a habitation of God through Holy Spirit where Jesus Christ, who is the Head of the Body dwells in your heart by faith**

Ephesians 2:15-22, Amplified Bible, Classic Edition

<sup>15</sup> By abolishing in His [own crucified] flesh the enmity [caused by] the Law with its decrees and ordinances [which He annulled]; that He from the two might create in Himself one new man [one new quality of humanity out of the two], so making peace.

<sup>16</sup> And [He designed] to reconcile to God both [Jew and Gentile, united] in a single body by means of His cross, thereby killing the mutual enmity *and* bringing the feud to an end.

<sup>17</sup> And He came and preached the glad tidings of peace to you who were afar off and [peace] to those who were near.

<sup>18</sup> For it is through Him that we both [whether far off or near] now have an introduction (access) by one [Holy] Spirit to the Father [so that we are able to approach Him].

<sup>19</sup> Therefore you are no longer outsiders (exiles, migrants, and aliens, excluded from the rights of citizens), but you now share citizenship with the saints (God's own people, consecrated and set apart for Himself); and you belong to God's [own] household.

<sup>20</sup> You are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets with Christ Jesus Himself the chief Cornerstone.

<sup>21</sup> In Him the whole structure is joined (bound, welded) together harmoniously, and it continues to rise (grow, increase) into a holy temple in the Lord [a sanctuary dedicated, consecrated, and sacred to the presence of the Lord].

<sup>22</sup> In Him [and in fellowship with one another] you yourselves also are being built up [into this structure] with the rest, to form a fixed abode (dwelling place) of God in (by, through) the Spirit.

Psalm 118:19-29, Living Bible

<sup>19</sup> Open the gates of the Temple<sup>[a]</sup>—I will go in and give him my thanks. <sup>20</sup> Those gates are the way into the presence of the Lord, and the godly enter there. <sup>21</sup> O Lord, thank you so much for answering my prayer and saving me.

<sup>22</sup> The stone rejected by the builders has now become the capstone of the arch!<sup>[b]</sup> <sup>23</sup> This is the Lord's doing, and it is marvelous to see! <sup>24</sup> This is the day the Lord has made. We will rejoice and be glad in it. <sup>25</sup> O Lord, please help us. Save us. Give us success. <sup>26</sup> Blessed is the one who is coming, the one sent by the Lord.<sup>[c]</sup> We bless you from the Temple.

<sup>27-28</sup> Jehovah God is our light. I present to him my sacrifice upon the altar, for you are my God, and I shall give you this thanks and this praise. <sup>29</sup> Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for he is so good! For his loving-kindness is forever.

### HELPS Word-studies

**4972** *sphragízō* (from **4973** /*sphragís*, "a seal") – properly, to seal (affix) with a signet ring or other instrument to stamp (a roller or seal), i.e.

to *attest ownership, authorizing (validating)* what is sealed.

**4972** /*sphragízō* ("to seal") signifies *ownership* and the full *security* carried by the backing (full authority) of the owner. "Sealing" in the ancient world

served as a "legal signature" which guaranteed the promise (contents) of what was sealed.

[Sealing was sometimes done in antiquity by the use of religious tattoos – again signifying "*belonging to.*"]

1 Chronicles 22:7-19, King James Version

<sup>7</sup> And David said to Solomon, My son, as for me, it was in my mind to build an house unto the name of the LORD my God:

<sup>8</sup> But the word of the LORD came to me, saying, Thou hast shed blood abundantly, and hast made great wars: thou shalt not build an house unto my name, because thou hast shed much blood upon the earth in my sight.

<sup>9</sup> Behold, a son shall be born to thee, who shall be a man of rest; and I will give him rest from all his enemies round about: for his name shall be Solomon, and I will give peace and quietness unto Israel in his days.

<sup>10</sup> He shall build an house for my name; and he shall be my son, and I will be his father; and I will establish the throne of his kingdom over Israel for ever.

**11** Now, my son, the LORD be with thee; and prosper thou, and build the house of the LORD thy God, as he hath said of thee.

**12** Only the LORD give thee wisdom and understanding, and give thee charge concerning Israel, that thou mayest keep the law of the LORD thy God.

**14** Now, behold, in my trouble I have prepared for the house of the LORD an hundred thousand talents of gold, and a thousand thousand talents of silver; and of brass and iron without weight; for it is in abundance: timber also and stone have I prepared; and thou mayest add thereto.

**15** Moreover there are workmen with thee in abundance, hewers and workers of stone and timber, and all manner of cunning men for every manner of work.

**16** Of the gold, the silver, and the brass, and the iron, there is no number. Arise therefore, and be doing, and the LORD be with thee.

**17** David also commanded all the princes of Israel to help Solomon his son, saying,

**18** Is not the LORD your God with you? and hath he not given you rest on every side? for he hath given the inhabitants of the land into mine hand; and the land is subdued before the LORD, and before his people.

**19** Now set your heart and your soul to seek the LORD your God; arise therefore, and build ye the sanctuary of the LORD God, to bring the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and the holy vessels of God, into the house that is to be built to the name of the LORD.

**Jesus gives you His instructions on building a house on an indestructible foundation, the Rock on the outside. He also gives instructions on having an impenetrable defense to preserve what you have built from demonic opposition and oppression on the inside.**

I asked someone who was in construction management this question, "If someone was going to demolish a property, where would they begin?" He replied, "At the weakest point!"

Matthew 7:24-27, The Message

**24-25** "These words I speak to you are not incidental additions to your life, homeowner improvements to your standard of living. They are foundational words, words to build a life on. If you work these words into your life, you are like a smart carpenter who built his house on solid rock. Rain poured down, the river flooded, a tornado hit—but nothing moved that house. It was fixed to the rock.

**26-27** "But if you just use my words in Bible studies and don't work them into your life, you are like a stupid carpenter who built his house on the sandy beach. When a storm rolled in and the waves came up, it collapsed like a house of cards."

Matthew 12:27-30, The Message

**25-27** Jesus confronted their slander. "A judge who gives opposite verdicts on the same person cancels himself out; a family that's in a constant squabble

disintegrates; if satan banishes satan, is there any satan left? If you're slinging devil mud at me, calling me a devil kicking out devils, doesn't the same mud stick to your own exorcists?

<sup>28-29</sup> "But if it's by *God's* power that I am sending the evil spirits packing, then God's kingdom is here for sure. How in the world do you think it's possible in broad daylight to enter the house of an awake, able-bodied man and walk off with his possessions unless you tie him up first? Tie him up, though, and you can clean him out.

<sup>30</sup> "This is war, and there is no neutral ground. If you're not on my side, you're the enemy; if you're not helping, you're making things worse.

**Isaiah 1:5-7 was part of the vision the Prophet Isaiah saw for Judah and Jerusalem. Because the Lord desired to be their only way of escape, He first uncovered what they could not see for themselves. Afterwards, they saw their disparity that was polar opposite of God's perspective and prospective.**

**God's motive is always pure and perfect at all times. He never badgered them with hindsight, where they would be lodged in regret. The Lord gave them insight so they could move forward to obtain foresight for their future good success that rested in Him alone.**

**Therefore, He tenderly unveiled their sin, transgression, and iniquity so they could receive maximum recovery from Him. They required all of their breaches to be healed, hedged, and hushed. Our God was the only one qualified to make them whole and well. That remains the absolute truth that you can absolutely trust for yourself too.**

**The Lord desired them as well as you to embrace, expect, experience and enjoy bounce-back breakthrough, breachproof breakthrough and back-to-back breakthrough. However, to fulfill His desire for them required their permission to grant undeniable access to God alone. That holds true for you too.**

**As their accountability partner, God unveiled the real image of their underlying condition. They did not have any soundness in them at all. Their breaches were not only unhealed, but were incurable. Their**

**breaches were not only unhedged, but had gaping wounds. Their breaches were not only un-hushed, but caused excruciating pain. Unfortunately, they experienced one breach after another breach. Maybe your story is similar to theirs. If that is so, that was not the end of their story or yours.**

Isaiah 1:5-7 Expanded Bible (EXB)

5 Why should you continue to be [or do you insist on being] punished [battered; struck down]?

Why do you continue to turn against him [rebel]?

Your whole head is hurt [bruised; wounded], and your whole heart is sick [faint; weak].

6 There is no healthy spot [soundness]

from the bottom [sole] of your foot to the top of your head;

you are covered with wounds [bruises], hurts [sores; welts], and open sores [raw/infected wounds]

that are not cleaned [L pressed out] and covered [bandaged],

and no medicine takes away the pain [L not soothed/softened with oil].

7 Your land is ruined [desolate];

your cities have been burned with fire.

While you watch [Right in front of you],

your enemies [L foreigners; strangers] are stealing everything

from [destroy; devour] your land [fields; crops];

it is ruined like a country destroyed [overthrown] by

6 From the sole of the foot even unto the head there is no soundness in it; but wounds, and bruises, and putrifying sores [not healed]: they have not been closed, neither bound up [not hedged], neither mollified with ointment [not hushed].

**Isaiah 32:18 highlights the vowed promise of God to be whole and well from the inside, out. 1) The Lord has already provided a healed habitation that carries His perfect peace, *shalom* which has its roots in *shalam*. 2) He has provided a hedged dwelling that is absolutely sure. 3) He also provided a hushed resting place that is extremely quiet.**

**Your invitation to Christ permanently moves your residence from just being a site for having a visitation from God to being a perpetual habitation of God. As a habitation of God through Holy Spirit, Jesus dwells in your heart as Savior by faith. From that posture, continue to live yielded to Christ as Lord of all the rest of your life.**
