

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 254 Scriptures

This is Section S of a multi-part instruction. Similar to a nation sending an ambassador into a territory, Jesus commanded the body of Christ to go into all the world. Although your kingdom of God assignment is in the world system, it is not in you. Jesus Christ is! You are His anointed carrier of the presence of God as well as the power of God. Your appointment is to bring the world into the kingdom of God until it is proof positive that, "those who have turned the world upside down are come here too!" Really, upside down is right side up!

Jesus' succession plan names you as His change agent to serve His divine purpose, plan, and path in one or even all the Seven Mountains: 1) government; 2) business; 3) media; 4) education; 5) arts & entertainment; 6) religion; and 7) family. Every Kingdom of God assignment is established on the Word of God as well as executed by the Spirit of God. If it is not, the mission will be an obstruction against your own breakthrough. Your minimum contribution is by prayer and petition, i.e., to intercede. Your maximum contribution is by practice and participation in the sphere(s) of influence God has chosen for you, i.e., to intervene.

Never give your seat of authority to an already failed world system. Let Holy Spirit reposition you to always "see" Jesus as He really is, the King of kings. Then grant the Lord of lords all the living room He requires, without issuing any eviction clauses. As your space restrictions are demolished, you can "be" as Jesus is in the world, a world overcomer. In other words, you are living on top of the world; it is not living on top of you.

Your peace with God comes from Jesus who is your peace who gave you the peace of God to inherit and to inhabit

¹⁷ And came and preached peace to you which were afar off, and to them that were nigh.

¹⁸ For through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father.

¹⁹ Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellowcitizens with the saints, and of the household of God;

Inherit – means to acquire; to distribute; to occupy; to possess; signify an heir

To really experience the peace of God, get intimately acquainted with God's promises of peace that stream throughout the Holy Bible

Jesus bequeathed His peace to you so you have every opportunity to live with perfect soundness in Him. Again, the word "peace" is *shalom*. *Shalom's* roots are in *shalam*. Again, *shalom* is defined as "completeness (in number); safety, soundness (in body); welfare, health, prosperity; quiet, tranquility, contentment; and friendship" which is founded on *shalam*, "to be in a covenant of peace; to be complete; sound.

In John 14:1, John 14:27 and John 16:33 Jesus ensures you of how the peace of God is already empowered to prevail over every test, trial, or temptation. Therefore, it awaits you to engage it throughout your daily life. Jesus bestowed *shalom* upon you to own as well as to occupy.

In Hebrew, *shalom* means peace which is comparable to the Greek word peace, *eiréné*. Extracted from Strong's Concordance, *shalom* means safe, i.e. "well, happy, friendly, welfare, health, prosperity, peace, favor, perfect such as to be at peace, rest, safety, salute, well, x wholly." The root of *shalom* is *shalam* meaning to be complete or sound

First, receive an indelible picture of heaven's atmosphere: the order; the balance; the wholeness; the fullness; and the overflow. The unending atmosphere in heaven is completely saturated with the peace of God. That is the same environment God already purposed to coexist in the earth.

Jesus already has given you His peace, i.e., *shalom* to inherit and to inhabit in your life and territory. The peace of God is so miraculously tranquil. It is empowered to bring the atmosphere of heaven to earth once you employ it.

Therefore, exercise Jesus' command on how you are to pray to Abba Father, "Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven," Matthew 6:10, KJV. Then expect our Heavenly Father to manifest Romans 16:20, "And the God of peace shall bruise satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen."

Always see Jesus as the Prince of peace and you get intimately acquainted with God's covenant of peace He has made with you

Here are living examples of the peace of God ushering in the presence of God and power of God for Jesus Christ, the Prince of Peace to rule and reign in your environment

The Touch of Heaven Felt

Here is the first example; After singing my original song, *Shalom*, which is interpreted as peace in Hebrew, a member of the audience told me she felt the peace of God rest upon her.

The Scent of Heaven Sensed

I received another testimony during the aforementioned time I sang *Shalom*. Another attendee told me she could smell the scent of lilac. Discovering an online source, it indicated two reasons you cannot smell lilac. The presence of: 1) non aromatic species; and 2) air temperature. I believe the atmosphere hosted Holy Spirit's presence perfectly. He had the liberty to abide in the atmosphere because it was like Heaven to Him. There was nothing present that could cause His presence and power to fade away. There was nothing that grieved, vexed, or quenched Him.

The Stench of Hell Revealed Preventing Premature Death

About three months before the following testimony in September, 2016 Holy Spirit led me to anoint my Mother's house, including all windows and doors on all four floors. This was in response to my dream where Mom was standing on the roof of her house. After which I had the phrase, "Mom is top of the house; it is not on top of her." As I anointed her home, the *Shalom* performance track repeatedly played in her dining room. To me, that is one of most anointed songs Holy Spirit inspired to write that ignites the miraculous.

At the close of 2016, Holy Spirit began to prompt me that my Mom would be living with me. In mid-January as I was reading my bible, I had a vision of someone's big hand covering my Mom's face. It happened twice in a row. At first, it took my breath away. I called

Mom. She was fine, but she mentioned that someone was there working on her furnace. However, he was not able to get it running again. I went and picked her up and she stayed with me overnight. The furnace man came out and I accompanied him the entire time he was present. In the end, he said that he could not legally turn back on the furnace. He stated she needed a new one. We gathered Mom's belongings and we returned to my home. By the following Sunday, she told me that she did not want to go back home. Because Holy Spirit had already told me Mom would be living with me, I immediately told her she could stay with me. I never confirmed that is what I downloaded.

While there was much resistance for Mom to return to her home, I knew what the Lord had shown me. Even, the furnace was turned on again. Over the course of the next several months, Mom would seem to be very present at times. Other times, she would display an undefinable presence. I had mentioned it this to someone several times. But, the last time I said it, she immediately said the Holy Spirit said it is carbon monoxide.

The following morning I called an independent blood testing facility which just happened to be in the same building we had to go to receive the requisition for the test. The attending doctor said that it was every inconceivable that any carbon monoxide would still be in Mom's bloodstream. After Mom had her blood drawn, the official report concluded that she had over three times the allowable amount of carbon monoxide still in her system.
