JESUS “MUST NEEDS GO” THROUGH SAMARIA

What’s supernatural about *Kairos* is that it is your divine connection to a person, place and/or thing. Merriam-Webster defines *Kairos* as “a time when conditions are right for the accomplishment of a crucial action: the opportune and decisive moment.” You can’t miss *Kairos* leading the way to meet up and collide with *Chronos* time in the story of the Woman at the Well. *Kairos* is Jesus already staged at Jacob’s Well awaiting the arrival of the woman who probably scheduled her daily routine at that particular moment in time to avoid all ridicule and rejection, *Chronos*. John 4:8-10, (TLB) records this heaven-born exchange. “He was alone at the time as His disciples had gone into the village to buy some food. The woman was surprised that a Jew would ask a ‘despised Samaritan’ for anything—usually they wouldn’t even speak to them!—and she remarked about this to Jesus. He replied, ‘If you only knew what a wonderful gift God has for you, and who I am, you would ask Me for some *living water*!’” On the other hand, *Chronos* is a sequence that remains in an irreversible succession. Your only option is counting time in forward motion. *Chronos* moves you to a destination and *Kairos* advances you into your destiny. Webster’s 1828 dictionary defines destiny as your “invincible necessary.” Therefore, you must be in at the right place, at the right time. Like Jesus, this eventuality you must needs go. *Kairos* grants you a qualifying moment in time where a living memorial is birthed that revolutionizes *Chronos*.

Their water source will be cleansed and healed until they are radically changed, from the inside, out. Now those waters will bubble up and be converted into new wine. Psalm 107:27-30 pictures their transition until transformation. “They reel to and fro, and stagger like a drunken man, and are at their wit’s end [their wisdom is swallowed up]. Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and He bringeth them out of their distresses. He maketh the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof are still. Then are they glad because they be quiet; so He bringeth them unto their desired haven.” Be ready for your Thirst-Quencher, Jesus!!!
