

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 283 Scriptures

This is Section AV of a multi-part instruction. Similar to a nation sending an ambassador into a territory, Jesus commanded the body of Christ to go into all the world. Although your kingdom of God assignment is in the world system, it is not in you. Jesus Christ is! You are His anointed carrier of the presence of God as well as the power of God. Your appointment is to bring the world into the kingdom of God until it is proof positive that, "those who have turned the world upside down are come here too!" Really, upside down is right side up!

Jesus' succession plan names you as His change agent to serve His divine purpose, plan, and path in one or even all the Seven Mountains: 1) government; 2) business; 3) media; 4) education; 5) arts & entertainment; 6) religion; and 7) family. Every Kingdom of God assignment is established on the Word of God as well as executed by the Spirit of God. If it is not, the mission will be an obstruction against your own breakthrough. Your minimum contribution is by prayer and petition, i.e., to intercede. Your maximum contribution is by practice and participation in the sphere(s) of influence God has chosen for you, i.e., to intervene.

Never give your seat of authority to an already failed world system. Let Holy Spirit reposition you to always "see" Jesus as He really is, the King of kings. Then grant the Lord of lords all the living room He requires, without issuing any eviction clauses. As your space restrictions are demolished, you can "be" as Jesus is in the world, a world overcomer. In other words, you are living on top of the world; it is not living on top of you.

The Kingdom of God rules supreme over the kingdoms of this world within you

Jesus Christ has already given you kingdom of God authority and power as a king-priest

exousia: power to act, authority

Original Word: ἐξουσία, ας, ἡ

Part of Speech: Noun, Feminine

Transliteration: exousia

Phonetic Spelling: (ex-oo-see'-ah)

Definition: power to act, authority

Usage: (a) power, authority, weight, especially: moral authority, influence, (b) in a quasi-personal sense, derived from later Judaism, of a spiritual power, and hence of an earthly power.

HELPS Word-studies

1849 *eksousía* (from **1537** /ek, "out from," which intensifies **1510** /eimí, "to be, being as a right or privilege") – authority, *conferred power; delegated empowerment* ("authorization"), operating in a *designated jurisdiction*.

In the NT, **1849** /*eksousía* ("delegated power") refers to the *authority* God gives to His saints – *authorizing them to act to the extent they are guided by faith* (His revealed word).

HELPS Word-studies

1411 *dýnamis* (from **1410** /*dýnamai*, "able, having ability") – properly, "ability to perform" (L-M); for the believer, *power* to achieve by applying the Lord's *inherent abilities*. "Power through God's ability" (**1411** /*dýnamis*) is needed in every scene of life to really grow in sanctification and prepare for heaven (glorification). **1411** (*dýnamis*) is a very important term, used 120 times in the NT.

From *dunamai*; force (literally or figuratively); specially, miraculous power (usually by implication, a miracle itself) -- ability, abundance, meaning, might(-ily, -y, -y deed), (worker of) miracle(-s), power, strength, violence, mighty (wonderful) work.

Jesus Christ has made you more than a conqueror within the kingdom of God

CONQUEROR, *noun* One who conquers; one who gains a victory; one who subdues and brings into subjection or possession, by force or by influence. The man who defeats his antagonist in combat is a *conqueror* as is the general or admiral who defeats his enemy.

5245 *hypernikáō* (from **5228** /*hypér*, "beyond" and **3528** /*nikáō*, "conquer") – properly, *exceedingly* conquer, being "*more than a conqueror*," i.e. "*super-conqueror*" who is "completely and overwhelmingly victorious" (*L & N*, 1, 39.58). **5245** (*hypernikáō*) is used only in Ro 8:37.

[The intensive prefix (*hyper*) adds the idea, "*surpassing* victory" (i.e. of a *pre-eminent* conqueror).]

3794 *oxýrōma* (from the root *oxyroō*, "fortify") – a fortified, military stronghold; a strong-walled fortress (A-S), used only in 2 Cor 10:4. Here 3794/*oxýrōma* ("a heavily-fortified containment") is used figuratively of a *false argument* in which a person seeks "shelter" ("a safe place") to *escape reality*.

David illustrates how the whole armor of God works effectively during every battle

¹³ So use every piece of God's armor to resist the enemy whenever he attacks, and when it is all over, you will still be standing up.

¹⁴ But to do this, you will need the strong belt of truth and the breastplate of God's approval. ¹⁵ Wear shoes that are able to speed you on as you preach the Good News of peace with God. ¹⁶ In every battle you will need faith as your shield to stop the fiery arrows aimed at you by satan. ¹⁷ And you will need the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit—which is the Word of God. ¹⁸ Pray all the time. Ask God for anything in line with the Holy Spirit's wishes. Plead with him, reminding him of your needs, and keep praying earnestly for all Christians everywhere.

Recognize and realize how to bring the kingdoms of this world under authority and power of the kingdom of God

JESUS' PRESCRIBED OPTIMUM BREAKTHROUGH

Jesus advocates you living in the search mode in Matthew 6:32-34. His point of reference is paramount to your lifelong quest. Seeking is the kingdom of God's paradigm. God's two priorities for living heaven on earth are seeking: 1) the kingdom of God and 2) His righteousness.

Your fervent and fertile focus progressively moves you from just looking around for earthly provision to setting your gaze on Holy Spirit to supernaturally usher heaven onto earth through you. In Greek, the word "seek" in the aforementioned scripture is endlessly active, never erratically passive. Greek 1934 *ἔπιζῆτέω* is defined in Strong's as: "to search (inquire for); intens. To demand, to crave: desire, enquire, seek (after, for)."

The Greek language shows the word "seek" in three levels, like an organizational chart. First, the top level is to worship God, i.e., *ζέτεώ* G2212 which is defined as "to desire, endeavor, and seek after."

The second level down brings its entire rule under the influence of the kingdom of God. *Ἐπί* G1909 is "the superimposition of time, place, and order. In compounds, it retains essentially the same import of, upon, etc."

And third, the bottom level is to seek. I believe *ēpizētēō* as previously defined is after everything else so that you will always choose to worship God first and foremost. That places the Most High above any familiar god you may have known as well as any foreign god that you have never known before.

Seeking the Lord is your posture of worshipping God alone in spirit and in truth. That is the place where you learn to believe right about everyone, everything, and everywhere. Within the kingdom of God is the King, Jesus Christ works with you to bring heaven-born realities to earth through you. He confirms His Word with miraculous signs.

Seek in Greek 1934 *ēpizētēō* to search (inquire for); intens. To demand, to crave: desire, enquire, seek (after, for)

From G1909 superimposition of time, place, order. In compounds, it retains essentially the same import of, upon, etc.

From G2212 to worship

Matthew 6:32-33 Amplified Bible (AMP)

³² For the [pagan] Gentiles eagerly seek all these things; [but do not worry,] for your heavenly Father knows that you need them. ³³ But first *and* most importantly seek (aim at, strive after) His kingdom and His righteousness [His way of doing and being right—the attitude and character of God], and all these things will be given to you also.

Within this divine domain resides God's perspective and prospective for you. Therefore, as you abide in His presence you will become more familiar with the optimal lifestyle that was once foreign to you outside of the kingdom of God.

Where is the kingdom of God? Jesus identifies the ideal setting of the kingdom of God. It is within you at the onset of your New Birth. Therefore, you become an anointed carrier of Abba Father, Jesus Christ, and Holy Spirit immediately. Your decision to give your life to Jesus recreated you to be a habitation of God through Holy Spirit where Jesus Christ lives in your heart by faith.

²¹ Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, the kingdom of God is within you.

This is worth repeating, the second layer of the word seek in Greek is *epi*, i.e., "superimposition of time, place, order. In compounds, it

retains essentially the same import of, upon, etc.” Here is an example as how I voice-activate *epi*. “In the name of Jesus, I bring 601 Lakeside Avenue under the kingdom of God, where Jesus resides as King of Glory, High Priest, King of kings, Lord of lords, and Lord of all. I plead the blood of Jesus and take the ruling authority of 601 Lakeside Avenue East, West, North, South, Above, Beneath, inside and out in the name of Jesus. Thank you Jesus!”

Literally, when you proclaim the kingdom of God culture over everyone, everything, and everywhere, you as the king-priest, i.e., non-gender specific are addressing Jesus directly. In all actuality, you are extending the kingdom of God's authority and power over every other sphere of influence. Then Jesus can reign and rule as the King-High Priest through you.
