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Voice of Triumph

“Protect me as you would the pupil of Your eye; hide me in the shadow of Your wings as You hover over me.”

Psalms 17:8, (TLB)

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LET JESUS THE SOVEREIGN OF SHALOM REIGN IN YOUR HEART AND MIND

God is your Unrivaled Defender to keep you from unraveling. Psalm 3:3 (KJV) offers an example of what it really means to have—Yahweh, “the One who continuously and increasingly reveals Himself as the Self-existent One”—to be your impenetrable Shield. “But Thou, O Lord, art a shield for me; my glory, and the lifter up of mine head.” *Hebrew Honey* defines “shield” as “our Prince has a limitless arsenal that guarantees perfect protection personally.” See Jesus as your Bodyguard! The One who took the hit for you, as you. Now you never have to take the fall. Live reminded that Jesus is the Prince of the kings of the earth. “And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the Prince of the kings of the earth. Unto Him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and hath made us kings and priests unto God and His Father; to Him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen,” Rev. 1:5-6 (KJV). You can also view Jesus making special appearances as Prince of the Lord’s host as seen in Joshua 5:14-15 (AMPC) when Joshua unknowingly challenged Him. “And He said, ‘No [neither], but as Prince of the Lord’s host have I now come.’ And Joshua fell on his face to the earth and worshiped, and said to Him, ‘What says my Lord to His servant?’ And the Prince of the Lord’s host said to Joshua, ‘Loose your shoes from off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy.’ And Joshua did so.” The footnote cites many others believe the Prince was the Son of God Himself. Among the titles Jesus has is the Prince of Peace: “For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given: and the government shall be upon His shoulder: and His name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The Mighty God, The Everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace,” Isaiah 9:6. In Hebrew, peace is *Shalom*. That’s where your “completeness, soundness, welfare, peace” dwells. Nothing missing! Nothing lacking! Nothing broken! God’s peace governs. With the voice of Jesus, command a garrison, i.e., military troop around your heart and mind, detonating all confusion, conflict, and chaos inside and out.

JESUS’ BREACHPROOF BREAKTHROUGH LIFE IS THE ONLY WAY TO LIVE

John 5:30 and John 14:30-31 validate Jesus’ optimum level of loyal love for Abba, our Heavenly Father. Both references are Jesus’ personal testimony of His undying devotion. To qualify as Savior of the world without fail, Jesus was totally committed to living the breachproof breakthrough life. Jesus is completely sanctified unto Abba as well as completely separated from satan at all times. You can forever live sanctified unto God too: “I am able to do nothing from Myself [independently, of My own accord—but only as I am taught by God and as I get His orders]. Even as I hear, I judge [I decide as I am bidden to decide. As the voice comes to Me, so I give a decision], and My judgment is right (just, righteous), because I do not seek *or* consult My own will [I have no desire to do what is pleasing to Myself, My own aim, My own purpose] but only the will *and* pleasure of the Father Who sent Me,” John 5:30 (AMPC). You can also forever live separated from the world, the flesh, and the devil: “I will not talk with you much more, for the prince (evil genius, ruler) of the world is coming. And he has no claim on Me. [he has nothing in common with Me; there is nothing in Me that belongs to him, and he has no power over Me.] But [satan is coming and] I do as the Father has commanded Me, so that the world may know (be convinced) that I love the Father and that I do only what the Father has instructed Me to do. [I act in full agreement with His orders.] Rise, let us go away from here,” John 14:30-31 (AMPC). Purified by the blood of the Lamb, purge all pollution.

THERE IS NO COMPLAINING IN YOUR STREETS WHERE JESUS IS LORD

Worship, praise, and thanksgiving acknowledge the Lord as your source, supply, and surplus to live full until you overflow. “Thou visitest the earth, and waterest it: Thou greatly enrichest it with the river of God, which is full of water: Thou preparest them corn, when Thou hast so provided for it. Thou waterest the ridges thereof abundantly: Thou settlest the furrows thereof: Thou makest it soft with showers: Thou blessest the springing thereof. Thou crownest the year with Thy goodness; and Thy paths [rampart] drop fatness. They drop upon the pastures of the wilderness: and the little hills rejoice on every side. The pastures are clothed with flocks; the valleys also are covered over with corn; they shout for joy, they also sing,” Psalm 65:9-13, (KJV). The Hebrew word for “paths” is “rampart.” Webster’s 1828 dictionary defines rampart as “that which fortifies and defends from assault; that which secures safety.” Make that scripture reference personal. Daily voice-activate God’s promises, then shout, “In the name of Jesus, there is no complaining in my streets—no room for famine just feast. I am living in overflow! Thank you Jesus for being my Rampart!”

Thought for Transformation

Once Job repented to God for his sin of pride, satan never again gained access. Job lived old and the full of days, 140 yrs. I adapted Job 1:10 (CJB) so you live breachproof too: “Lord, You made a protective hedge around me, my house, and everything I have. You’ve prospered my work and my wealth. I am spread out all over the land.” Repent if needed. Voice-activate daily the same in the name of Jesus. Jesus, your Hedger will completely cover you too, inside and out.

Sound in God’s Safe House

“The Lord is good, a stronghold in the day of trouble; and He knoweth them that trust in Him. But with an overrunning flood He will make an utter end of the place thereof, and darkness shall pursue His enemies,” Nahum 1:7-8, (KJ21). Stronghold in Hebrew means “a place or means of safety, protection.” That’s like a safe house, “a hiding place or secure refuge.” Praise God as your Habitation, Hiding Place, Rock of your Refuge. God still answers to all His Names today.

Impervious to Penetration

“For see, today I have made you impervious to their attacks. They cannot harm you. You are strong like a fortified city that cannot be captured, like an iron pillar and heavy gates of brass. All the kings of Judah, its officers, priests, and people will not be able to prevail against you. They will try, but they will fail. For I am with you, says the Lord. I will deliver you,” Jeremiah 1:18-19, (TLB). You were recreated in God’s image and likeness. Breachproof!

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
