## **IN HEAVEN'S TIMELESSNESS, GOD CREATED EARTH'S TIME AND TEMPO**

Timelessness: "Lord, thou hast been our dwelling place in all generations. Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, thou art God," Ps. 90:1-2, KJV. Transition into Time: "In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness. And God called the light Day, and the darkness He called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day," Gen. 1:1-5, KJV. Tempo to Tempo: "Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them. And on the seventh day God ended His work which He had done; and He rested on the seventh day from all His work which He had done. And God blessed (spoke good of) the seventh day, set it apart as His own, and hallowed it, because on it God rested from all His work which He had created and done. This is the history of the heavens and of the earth when they were created. In the day that the Lord God made the earth and the heavens—When no plant of the field was yet in the earth and no herb of the field had yet sprung up, for the Lord God had not [yet] caused it to rain upon the earth and there was no man to till the ground, But there went up a mist (fog, vapor) from the land and watered the whole surface of the ground," Gen. 2:1-6, AMPC.

## **JESUS OUSTED CROP FAILURES TO RESTORE YOUR NEW LIFE IN EDEN**

Restored to Eden! "Then the Lord God formed man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath *or* spirit of life, and man became a living being. And the Lord God planted a garden toward the east, in Eden [delight]; and there He put the man whom He had formed (framed, constituted). Recovered from the Fall: "...for the creation was made subject to frustration—not willingly, but because of the one who subjected it. But it was given a reliable hope that it too would be set free from its bondage to decay and would enjoy the freedom accompanying the glory that God's children will have," Rom. 8:20-21, CJB. God reigns in our praise: "But You are holy, O You who are enthroned in [the holy place where] the praises of Israel [are offered]," Ps. 22:3, AMP. Celebrate God in every season: "Although the fig tree shall not blossom, neither shall fruit be in the vines; the labour of the olive shall fail, and the fields shall yield no meat; the flock shall be cut off from the fold, and there shall be no herd in the stalls: Yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will joy in the God of my salvation," Hab. 3:17-18, KJV. Shout for joy: "Thou crownest the year with Thy goodness; and Thy paths drop fatness. They drop upon the pastures of the wilderness: and the little hills rejoice on every side. The pastures are clothed with flocks; the valleys also are covered over with corn; they shout for joy, they also sing," Ps. 65:9-13, KJV. No more drought!

**SYNCOATED TIME IMPROVISES TO EMPHASIZE WHAT'S IMPORTANT**

Jesus' command was a supernatural weed eater that removed fruitlessness from the atmosphere. The fig tree's futility denied Jesus access to nourishment who was present to recreate the Garden of Eden. "And seeing in the distance a fig tree [covered] with leaves, He went to see if He could find any [fruit] on it [for in the fig tree the fruit appears at the same time as the leaves]. But when He came up to it, He found nothing but leaves, for the fig season had not yet come. And He said to it, No one ever again shall eat fruit from you. And His disciples were listening [to what He said]," Mk. 11:13-14, AMPC. Jesus shows us how turnarounds occur when your voice is recognized as His command. "In the morning, when they were passing along, they noticed that the fig tree was withered [completely] away to its roots. And Peter remembered and said to Him, Master, look! The fig tree which You doomed has withered away! And Jesus, replying, said to them, Have faith in God [constantly]. Truly I tell you, whoever says to this mountain, Be lifted up and thrown into the sea! and does not doubt at all in his heart but believes that what he says will take place, it will be done for him," Mk. 11:20-23, AMPC. The fig's noise roared rebellion instead of praise. Your faith in God muzzles infertility bringing heaven to earth!

## **Thought for Transformation**

*Supernatural time redemption is told when Jesus transcendentally escapes from the mob that only had murder on their mind. Jesus came to earth to give His life for the world. He refused to die before 33 years, devoting His 3 last years to God's succession plan.
