GOD'S PRICELESS TREASURE GIVEN TO ACQUIRE ALL THE TREASURES

Jesus tells a story about a man who found valuable things in the ground. “I can tell you again what the kingdom of heaven is like,” Jesus said. “The kingdom of heaven is like some valuable things that a man buried in a field. Another man found it, but then he covered it over again with dirt. The second man was very happy and he went away. He sold everything that he had. Then he went and bought the field with the valuable things in it.” *“At that time, people usually hid their valuable things in the ground. The kingdom of God is very valuable. A person should give everything to have God rule in his life,”* Matt. 13:44, (Easy). Priceless Treasure: “God loved the people in the world so much that He gave His one and only Son to save them. As a result, everyone who believes in the Son will not die. Instead, they will live forever with God,” John 3:16, (Easy). Acquired treasure: “Then God will be kind to that person. God will say, ‘Save that person, so that he does not go to his grave. I have found someone to pay the price for his life, [Jesus!] So keep him alive,” Job 33:24, (Easy).

JOHN 15TH GARDEN OF THE LORD: THE FARMER, VINE, BRANCH, FRUIT

“I am the Real Vine and My Father is the Farmer. *Trims branch:* He cuts off every branch of Me that doesn't bear grapes. *More fruit:* And every branch that is grape-bearing He prunes back so it will bear even more. You are already pruned back by the message [word] *logos* I have spoken. Live in Me. Make your home in Me just as I do in you. *No fruit:* In the same way that a branch can't bear grapes by itself but only by being joined to the vine, you can't bear fruit unless you are joined with Me. I am the Vine, you are the branches. *Much fruit:* When you're joined with Me and I with you, the relation intimate and organic, the harvest is sure to be abundant. *Barren:* Separated, you can't produce a thing. Anyone who separates from Me is deadwood, gathered up and thrown on the bonfire. But if you make yourselves at home with Me and My words *rhema* are at home in you, you can be sure that whatever you ask will be listened to and acted upon. This is how My Father shows who He is—when you produce grapes, when you mature as My disciples.” Isaiah 11:1 shows Jesus as The Branch; through Him, you are the branch living in the Vine. Holy Spirit's washing bears fruit: “But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared, not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; Which He shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour; that being justified by His grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life,” Tit. 3:4-7. “But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: against such there is no law,” Gal. 5:22-23.

GOD'S WORKMANSHIP WAS ALL ABOUT HIS ACQUISITION OF TREASURE

Psalm 111 (KJV) begins and ends with praising the Lord. In between, verses 2-9 describe both His workmanship and His acquisition of treasure. “The works *maaseh* i.e., ‘His workmanship’ of the Lord are great, sought out of all them that have pleasure therein. His work *poal* i.e., ‘His acquisition of treasure’ is honourable and glorious: and His righteousness endureth forever. He hath made His wonderful works *maaseh* to be remembered: the Lord is gracious and full of compassion. He hath given meat unto them that fear Him: He will ever be mindful of His covenant. He hath shewed His people the power of His works *maaseh*, that He may give them the heritage of the heathen. The works *maaseh* of His hands are verity and judgment; all His commandments are sure. They stand fast for ever and ever, and are done in truth and uprightness. He sent redemption unto His people: He hath commanded His covenant forever: holy and reverend is His name.” His heart is with His treasure. You!!!

COOPERATE WITH JESUS TO BRING HEAVEN TO EARTH IN YOUR LIFE

During Jesus' ministry on earth, He partnered with heaven: “How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, i.e., “philanthropy” and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with Him,” Acts 10:38, (KJV). Since Jesus' ascension to Heaven, He partners with us on earth: “So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, He was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. And they went forth, and preached everywhere, the Lord working, i.e., “in cooperation with them,” and confirming the word with signs i.e., “miracles” following. Amen,” Mark 16:19-20, (KJV). “We are assured *and* know that [God being a partner in their labor] all things work together, i.e. “in cooperation with them” *and* are [fitting into a plan] for good to *and* for those who love God and are called according to [His] design *and* purpose. Footnotes: Some scriptures read, “God works all things with them.” Rom. 8:28, (AMPC). Join forces!

Thought for Transformation

The word work, ergazo-mai in John 5:17 is acquire by labor. “But Jesus answered them, My Father worketh hitherto, and I work. But the word work, ergon in John 14:10-12 is employment. “Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? the words [rhema] that I speak unto you I speak not of Myself: but the Father that dwelleth in Me, He doeth the works. Believe Me that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me: or else believe Me for the very works' sake. Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.” Holy Spirit indwelling you, the greater works are manifested.

Working with Elohim on Earth

Every work Jesus created, formed, or shaped on earth was always of God, never of the world, flesh, or devil. “For with God nothing is ever impossible and no word from God shall be without power or impossible of fulfillment,” Luke 1:37. Clarity: “If I can? Jesus asked, Anything is possible is you have faith,” Mark 9:23. The Climax: “These accounts are recorded so that you, too, might believe that Jesus is the Anointed, the Liberating King, the Son of God, because believing grants you the life He came to share,” John 20:31, (Voice). An unbelieving-unbeliever believes not even God can do the impossible. A receiving-believer always believes his partnership with God reproduces the days of heaven upon the earth via the indwelling presence and power of Holy Spirit.
