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GOD'S SUPERNATURAL PARADIGM BIRTHED JESUS INTO MARY'S WOMB

Prior to Gabriel's visitation, the *logos*, the laid forth word of God from Isaiah's prophecy was only in Mary's knowledge bank. "Therefore the Lord Himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call His name Immanuel," Is. 7:14. First, Gabriel highly endorsed the virgin Mary so she could receive her divine upgrade i.e., chosen by God as the anointed carrier of His destiny, i.e., "invincible necessity." Secondly, after Gabriel stills her initial fears, he engages Mary with her assignment from God. He reveals Jesus' name as well as His divine purpose on the earth. Not having any experiential knowledge, Mary's view is limited to only being able to explain a husband's seed conceives offspring naturally. Through her cross-examination of Gabriel, she received revelation knowledge of the preset course of action in the mind of God. Just aware of the biological conception, Mary makes an honest appeal to Gabriel to give her insight into this situation. Then having foresight, she knew just how God planned to crystallize this miraculous exchange. Her faith believed the impossible! Hosting revealed truth, Mary never doubted the validity of this heaven-born reality. What she received from Gabriel prevented her from concocting an idol that God could never bless. She not once lusted after the dream more than maintaining her intimacy with the Dream Maker. Thirdly, Gabriel issued Mary God's step-by-step approach on how to birth the supernatural. Gabriel assured her that God is Jesus' Heavenly Father indeed. Through this miraculous transfer, she would remain a virgin as prophesied. The Spirit of God would impregnate Mary's womb and her espoused Joseph would serve as Jesus' earthly father. Fourthly, Gabriel enlightened Mary on her relative Elizabeth's pregnancy, since Mary had no prior knowledge of it. Barren all of her childbearing years, Elizabeth and Zacharias were now too old. Fifthly, Gabriel prophetically decreed the *rhéma* Word of God to Mary. "For with God no thing [*rhéma*] shall be impossible," Luke 1:37. By faith, Mary enlarged her heart to make sufficient room to be the habitation of God for Holy Spirit to implant Jesus into her womb supernaturally. Mary received the *rhéma* Word from Gabriel as a *rhéma* Word. She vowed to be God's covenant partner on earth. "And Mary said, Behold the handmaid of the Lord; be it unto me according to thy word [*rhéma*]. And the angel departed from her," Luke 1:38.

GOD ENTHRONED MARY'S PRAISE TO COMPLETE THE PERFORMANCE

After Gabriel's departure, Mary hurried to Elizabeth's home. Both pregnancies were validated upon her arrival. Elizabeth confirms her own pregnancy when John leaped inside her womb as well as Mary carrying Jesus, the Savior of the world in her womb. This fuels both of God's heaven-born realities. "And it came to pass, that, when Elisabeth heard the salutation of Mary, the babe leaped in her womb; and Elisabeth was filled with the Holy Ghost: And she spake out with a loud voice, and said, Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb. And whence is this to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me? For, lo, as soon as the voice of thy salutation sounded in mine ears, the babe leaped in my womb for joy. And blessed is she that believed: for there shall be a performance of those things which were told her from the Lord," Luke 1:41-45. "And Mary said, My soul doth magnify the Lord, And my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Saviour. For He hath regarded the low estate of His handmaiden: for, behold, from henceforth all generations shall call me blessed. For He that is mighty hath done to me great things; and holy is His name. And His mercy is on them that fear Him from generation to generation. He hath shewed strength with His arm; He hath scattered the proud in the imagination of their hearts. He hath put down the mighty from their seats, and exalted them of low degree. He hath filled the hungry with good things; and the rich He hath sent empty away. He hath helped His servant Israel, in remembrance of His mercy; As He spake to our fathers, to Abraham, and to His seed for ever. And Mary abode with her about three months, and returned to her own house," Luke 1:45-56. Praise!

ABBA, FATHER HIGHLY ENDORSES AND HEAVILY REINFORCES JESUS

After an angel announced Jesus's birth in Bethlehem to the shepherds, God highly endorsed His Son with heaven's grand chorus in Luke 2:13-14. "And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men." Matthew 2:14 proves God heavily reinforced Jesus. In a dream, an angel warned Joseph that Herod had plans to kill Him so don't return to Israel until he received God's command. "When he arose, he took the young child and his mother by night, and departed into Egypt: And was there until the death of Herod." Recreated in Christ, so you are too!

Thought for Transformation

"Then the angel replied to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you [like a cloud]; for that reason the holy (pure, sinless) Child shall be called the Son of God," Luke 1:35, AMP. In Greek, "come" means "supervene." Holy Spirit supervened Mary's virgin womb to download Jesus; "to happen unexpectedly in a way that interrupts, stops, or greatly changes an existing situation," Britannica Dictionary. I believe God enthroned Mary's Magnificat. Her fervent and fertile worship unto God activated Jesus' birth on earth. Suddenly, Holy Spirit transformed Mary. "But You are holy, O You who are enthroned in [the holy place where] the praises of Israel [are offered]," Psalm 22:3, (AMP).

Incubation to Implantation

The incubation process requires the perfect environment i.e., "the process of maintaining uniform heat and humidity of the developing eggs, usually accomplished by one or both parents sitting on the eggs at all times." It is imperative you stay in the perfect environment to birth the vision God assigned for your womb. Refuse to prematurely abort His seed or prevent His accessibility. With Mary's menstrual cycle suspended, Holy Spirit's fertilization implanted Jesus in just one moment in time. Implantation is divided into four phases: 1) irrevocable application; 2) irresistible connection; 3) irrigating saturation; and 4) impenetrable protection. Keep on praising the Lord until His promise is fulfilled and is on public display.
