

## **The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 332 Scriptures**

**This is Section A of a multi-part instruction. Dominion grants you the authority and power over satan and his entire kingdom. It is where everything is under your feet, never over your head. Don't permit the enemy to talk you out of your God-ordained reign. Always deny the defeated foe the right to rule over you and your territory.**

**Heaven is God's throne and earth is His footstool. Jesus, the Great Shepherd prepares the table before you in the presence of your captured enemies. Although the enemy may be near, not even once can he dine with Jesus and you. Since God already judged satan i.e., condemned and punished, he is forced to serve as your footstool.**

**Live relentlessly about treading down the wicked. Wearing Abba's boots of peace, God crushes satan into irreconcilable pieces under your feet in the name of Jesus. Under no circumstances give the devil any wiggle room. Keep your feet on the neck of the enemy at all times. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, our Conqueror ignites you to arise as more than a conqueror through Him who loves you.**

**Yielding to the wrong voice will seize your dominion, either little by little or all at once**

Genesis 3:1-7, Amplified Bible

### **The Fall of Man**

<sup>1</sup> Now the serpent was more crafty (subtle, skilled in deceit) than any living creature of the field which the LORD God had made. And <sup>[a]</sup>the serpent (satan) said to the woman, "Can it really be that God has said, "You shall not eat from <sup>[b]</sup>any tree of the garden?" <sup>2</sup> And the woman said to the serpent, "We may eat fruit from the trees of the garden, <sup>3</sup> except the fruit from the tree which is in the middle of the garden. God said, 'You shall not eat from it nor touch it, otherwise you will die.'" <sup>4</sup> But the serpent said to the woman, "You certainly will not die! <sup>5</sup> For God knows that on the day you eat from it your eyes will be opened [that is, you will have greater awareness], and you will be like God, knowing [the difference between] good and evil." <sup>6</sup> And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was

delightful to look at, and a tree to be desired in order to make one wise *and* insightful, she took some of its fruit and ate it; and she also gave some to her husband <sup>[c]</sup>with her, and he ate. <sup>7</sup> Then the eyes of the two of them were opened [that is, their awareness increased], and they knew that they were naked; and they fastened fig leaves together and made themselves coverings.

### Footnotes

- a. Genesis 3:1 The relationship between satan and the serpent is not made clear, but satan is identified with the serpent later in Rev 12:9, 14, 15, and 20:2. It seems difficult to believe that Eve would not have been suspicious of a talking creature, but at this point in time Eve probably knew next to nothing about animals; and in any case, the serpent, as it existed before the curse (v 14), was a very different creature from the reptile that is familiar to us today.
- b. Genesis 3:1 Or *every*.
- c. Genesis 3:6 This may have been sometime later. Jewish tradition said that Adam was absent at the time of Eve's conversation with the serpent (according to the Talmud).

## **Your God-ordained dominion grants you His authority and power in the name of Jesus. It is fivefold: be fruitful, multiply, replenish the earth, subdue it and have dominion**

Dominion

Genesis 1:26-28, (KJV)

<sup>26</sup> And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. <sup>27</sup> So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

<sup>28</sup> And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of

the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.

Psalm 72:1-9, (KJV)

<sup>1</sup> Give the king thy judgments, O God, and thy righteousness unto the king's son. <sup>2</sup> He shall judge thy people with righteousness, and thy poor with judgment. <sup>3</sup> The mountains shall bring peace to the people, and the little hills, by righteousness. <sup>4</sup> He shall judge the poor of the people, he shall save the children of the needy, and shall break in pieces the oppressor. <sup>5</sup> They shall fear thee as long as the sun and moon endure, throughout all generations. <sup>6</sup> He shall come down like rain upon the mown grass: as showers that water the earth. <sup>7</sup> In his days shall the righteous flourish; and abundance of peace so long as the moon endureth. <sup>8</sup> He shall have dominion also from sea to sea, and from the river unto the ends of the earth. <sup>9</sup> They that dwell in the wilderness shall bow before him; and his enemies shall lick the dust.

### **Unpack the Fall of Man and how your Ascension in Christ makes you reign in life**

Deception

Revelation 12:8-11, (KJV)

<sup>8</sup> And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven. <sup>9</sup> And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the devil, and satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him. <sup>10</sup> And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. <sup>11</sup> And they overcame

him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

Desire

Luke 10:27, (KJV)

<sup>27</sup> And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.

Exodus 20:1-6, Living Bible

<sup>1</sup> Then God issued this edict: <sup>2</sup> "I am Jehovah your God who liberated you from your slavery in Egypt. <sup>3</sup> "You may worship no other god than me.

<sup>4</sup> "You shall not make yourselves any idols: no images of animals, birds, or fish. <sup>5</sup> You must never bow or worship it in any way; for I, the Lord your

God, am very possessive. I will not share your affection with any other god!

"And when I punish people for their sins, the punishment continues upon the children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren of those who hate me; <sup>6</sup> but

I lavish my love upon thousands of those who love me and obey my commandments.

1 John 2:15-17, (KJV)

<sup>15</sup> Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. <sup>16</sup> For all that is in the

world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. <sup>17</sup> And the world passeth away, and

the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.

**After the loss of dominion, shame becomes a felt-need, because it makes you to run away from God instead of running to Him. It**

**causes to hide, to fear, and to escape reality by accusing someone else rather than to face it.**

Genesis 3:8-16, Amplified Bible

<sup>8</sup> And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool [afternoon breeze] of the day, so the man and his wife hid *and* kept themselves hidden from the <sup>[d]</sup>presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden. <sup>9</sup> But the LORD God called to Adam, and said to him, "Where are you?" <sup>10</sup> He said, "I heard the sound of You [walking] in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; so I hid myself." <sup>11</sup> God said, "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten [fruit] from the tree of which I commanded you not to eat?" <sup>12</sup> And the man said, "The woman whom You gave to be with me—she gave me [fruit] from the tree, and I ate it." <sup>13</sup> Then the LORD God said to the woman, "What is this that you have done?" And the woman said, "The serpent beguiled *and* deceived me, and I ate [from the forbidden tree]." <sup>14</sup> The LORD God said to the serpent, "Because you have done this, you are cursed more than all the cattle, And more than any animal of the field; On your belly you shall go, And dust you shall eat all the days of your life. <sup>15</sup> "And I will put enmity (open hostility) between you and the woman, and between your seed (offspring) and her <sup>[e]</sup>Seed; He shall [fatally] bruise your head, and you shall [only] bruise His heel." <sup>16</sup> To the woman He said, "I will greatly multiply Your pain in childbirth; In pain you will give birth to children; Yet your desire *and* longing will be for your husband, And he will rule [with authority] over you *and* be responsible for you."

- e. [Genesis 3:15](#) Many consider this verse the *protevangelium*, the first announcement of the gospel. This is the first prophecy about the Messiah (Christ), who through His death on the cross and resurrection would ultimately defeat satan, the power behind

the serpent, with a death blow. See Is 9:6; Matt 1:23; Luke 1:31; Rom 16:20; Gal 4:4; Rev 12:17.

<sup>19</sup> Behold, I give unto you power [*exousia*] to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power [*dunamis*] of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Hebrews 2:14-15, (KJV)

<sup>14</sup> Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; <sup>15</sup> And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

1 John 3:7-9, (KJV)

<sup>7</sup> Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous. <sup>8</sup> He that committeth sin is of the devil;

for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil. <sup>9</sup> Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

Psalms 91, (KJV)

<sup>1</sup> He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. <sup>2</sup> I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust. <sup>3</sup> Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence. <sup>4</sup> He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler. <sup>5</sup> Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day; <sup>6</sup> Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday. <sup>7</sup> A thousand



shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee. <sup>8</sup> Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked. <sup>9</sup> Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation; <sup>10</sup> There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. <sup>11</sup> For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways. <sup>12</sup> They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone. <sup>13</sup> Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet. <sup>14</sup> Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name. <sup>15</sup> He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him. <sup>16</sup> With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.
