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PROMISES THAT MOVE YOU FROM THE UNSEEN REALM TO BE SEEN

"Since we consider *and* look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen; for the things that are visible are temporal (brief and fleeting), but the things that are invisible are deathless *and* everlasting," 2 Cor. 4:18, (AMPC). "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. For by it the elders obtained a good report. Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the *rhema* word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear," Heb. 11:1-3. "(As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before Him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were," Rom. 4:17. "Then Avraham put out his hand and took the knife to kill his son. But the Angel of *ADONAI* called to him out of heaven: "Avraham? Avraham!" He answered, "Here I am." He said, "Don't lay your hand on the boy! Don't do anything to him! For now I know that you are a man who fears God, because you have not withheld your son, your only son, from Me." Avraham raised his eyes and looked, and there behind him was a ram caught in the bushes by its horns. Avraham went and took the ram and offered it up as a burnt offering in place of his son. Avraham called the place *ADONAI* Yir'eh [*ADONAI* will see (to it), *ADONAI* provides] — as it is said to this day, "On the mountain *ADONAI* is seen." The Angel of *ADONAI* called to Avraham a second time out of heaven. He said, "I have sworn by Myself — says *ADONAI* — that because you have done this, because you haven't withheld your son, your only son, I will most certainly bless you; and I will most certainly increase your descendants to as many as there are stars in the sky or grains of sand on the seashore. Your descendants will possess the cities of their enemies, and by your descendants all the nations of the earth will be blessed — because you obeyed My order," Gen. 22:10-18, (CJB). "By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac, and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten *son*, of whom it was said, That in Isaac shall thy seed be called, accounting that God *was* able to raise *him* up, even from the dead; from whence he also received him in a figure," Heb. 11:17-19, (JUB). "[God] who did not spare [even] His own Son, but gave Him up for us all, how will He not also, along with Him, graciously give us all things?" Rom. 8:32, (AMP). Jesus was clearly seen on earth! Now, with eyes of faith, see Jesus completing the vision He started in you.

VISIONARIES' FAITH ADVANCES AND ARRIVES WITH MANIFESTATIONS

Jesus is seen physically and/or spiritually discerned. "Visibility must remain limitless so God will not be missed when He chooses to appear," Hebrew Honey. Faith is believing what you cannot see physically: "...Believe that Jesus is the Anointed, *the Liberating King*, the Son of God, because believing grants you the life He came to share," John 20:31, (Voice). Faith is expecting to see the unseen: "looking away to the Initiator and Completer of that trusting, Yeshua — who, in exchange for obtaining the joy set before Him, endured execution on a stake as a criminal, scorning the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Yes, think about Him who endured such hostility against Himself from sinners, so that you won't grow tired or become despondent," Heb. 12:2-3 (CJB). Faith exhibits endurance by staying the course and never giving up: "So don't lose your bold, courageous faith, for you are destined for a great reward! You need the strength of endurance to reveal the poetry of God's will and then you receive the promise in full," Heb. 10:35-37 (TPT).

THE SPIRIT OF GOD AND THE RHEMA WORD OF GOD ACTIVATE FAITH

From Genesis to Revelation, the Spirit and the *rhema* Word always agree. Together, they join your faith as co-partners in creation. Faith lies dormant until your dominion makes it dynamic: Great faith mixes the *rhema* with the God-kind of faith in you by mastering your relationship with Holy Spirit so the presence of God is mirrored in you while the power of God is manifested through you. Eph. 6:17, (AMPC) gives you the model: "And take ... and the sword that the Spirit wields, which is the *rhema* Word of God." Footnotes: Thus here the Spirit is the subject or agent of the verbal action. The Spirit of God: "We having the same Spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed and, therefore, I have spoken; we also believe and, therefore, speak; knowing that He who raised up the Lord Jesus shall raise us up also by Jesus and shall present *us* with you," 2 Cor. 4:13-14, (JUB). The *rhema* Word: "But what saith it? The *rhema* word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the *rhema* word of faith, which we preach; That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved," Rom. 10:8-9, (KJV). In anyone or anything, at any time.

Thought for Transformation

God's prototype for every creation commences with the culmination in mind. "Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all My pleasure: calling a ravenous bird from the east, the man that executeth My counsel from a far country: yea, I have spoken it, I will also bring it to pass; I have purposed it, I will also do it," Isaiah 46:10-11, (KJV) As His partners in creation, we do the same. "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God," Rom. 10:17, (KJV). "Come" in Greek means to "advance and arrive." Rhema, the poured forth word of God commands the point of destination, never the point of origination.

Receive or Reject the Rhema

While mourning and fasting, Daniel felt powerless. On the 24th day, he had a vision of Jesus who said "...O man greatly beloved, fear not: peace be unto thee, be strong, yea, be strong. And when He had spoken unto me, I was strengthened, and said, Let my Lord speak; for Thou hast strengthened me," Dan. 10:19, (KJV). Live with a readiness to receive the rhema word. First, Holy Spirit recharges your heart to lay hold on to what has been released. Repositioned, your mouth relishes the rhema, refusing to refute the poured forth word of God received.

From Vision to Provision

If God can get His vision in you from the unseen realm, then He will get His provision to you in the seen realm. With all division removed, you will connect seamlessly.
