

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 335 Scriptures

This is Section D of a multi-part instruction. Dominion grants you the authority and power over satan and his entire kingdom. It is where everything is under your feet, never over your head. Don't permit the enemy to talk you out of your God-ordained reign. Always deny the defeated foe the right to rule over you and your territory.

Heaven is God's throne and earth is His footstool. Jesus, the Great Shepherd prepares the table before you in the presence of your captured enemies. Although the enemy may be near, not even once can he dine with Jesus and you. Since God already judged satan i.e., condemned and punished, he is forced to serve as your footstool.

Live relentlessly about treading down the wicked. Wearing Abba's boots of peace, God crushes satan into irreconcilable pieces under your feet in the name of Jesus. Under no circumstances give the devil any wiggle room. Keep your feet on the neck of the enemy at all times. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, our Conqueror ignites you to arise as more than a conqueror through Him who loves you.

SEIZE THE SERPENT

Even a baby's praise conquers serpents. Glorious celebration unto the Lord makes them cease and desist all destructive maneuvers. Afterward, serpents only have taste for dust. Live unappetizing to the enemy. "A baby will be able to play near a cobra's hole. A child will be able to put his hand into the nest of a poisonous snake," Isaiah 11:8, (ICB). The God of peace bruised satan under your feet. Ambush the snake! The grace of Lord Jesus Christ leads you to take new ground with bold courage and confidence. No deadly snakes run loose around heaven, so shall it be on earth also!

God's Authority and Power

Exousia grants you God's authority to bring order while dunamis grants you God's power for dominion! Exousia is shown in Ex. 4:2-4, KJV. "And the LORD said unto [Moses], What is that in thine hand? And he said, A rod. And He said, Cast it on the ground. And he cast it on the ground, and it became a serpent; and Moses fled from before it. And the LORD said unto Moses, Put

forth thine hand, and take it by the tail. And he put forth his hand, and caught it, and it became a rod in his hand.” Dunamis is shown in Acts 28:3-5 KJV. “And when Paul had gathered a bundle of sticks, and laid them on the fire, there came a viper out of the heat, and fastened on his hand. And when the barbarians saw the venomous beast hang on his hand, they said among themselves, No doubt this man is a murderer, whom, though he hath escaped the sea, yet vengeance suffereth not to live. And he shook off the beast into the fire, and felt no harm.” Next is Jesus’ command to all of His disciples, including you in Luke 10:19 (KJV). “Behold, I give unto you power [exousia] to tread on serpents and scorpions, and power [dunamis] over all of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.”

CONQUER! DON'T CUDDLE

While transcribing what the Lord was downloading to me, Holy Spirit gave me perfect recall about the nature of snakes as well as several stories I heard previously. First, there is type of snake that attacks from the back. Secondly, there is one that attacks from the front. Thirdly, there is another one that will cuddle around the neck; every time that one inhales, it moves undetected by that party until it has him in a chokehold, i.e., “restraining hold on neck.” It did not have to struggle to strangle him to death. The next command He gave was, “Conquer! Don’t cuddle!” He followed on, with an account of a lady who found a snake and brought it home with her because she was so smitten by it. When it stopped eating, she decided to put its lifeless body in bed with her. When she awakened, instead of being coiled up in a circle, it had stretched itself out until it measured her height. Still concerned, she took it to the vet. When she told the him the symptoms, he informed her that it stopped eating to accommodate space to consume her. Then Holy Spirit reminded me of what a young man told me about his father who breeds snakes. He said snakes feed on live things. “There is a way that

seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death," Proverbs 16:25. Refuse to make decisions by your five physical senses: what you see, hear, touch, taste, or smell. Ask God for spiritual perception. Pray to God about everything to make it impossible to be prey for the enemy in anything.

*"They shall **take up*** serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover."*

THE NAME OF JESUS KEEPS THE SERPENT SEIZED, SHUT UP, AND SEALED

Holy Spirit led me to search "seize the serpent" online to discover scriptures confirming His *rhema* word. I was pleasantly surprised to find Revelation 20:2. Most of the biblical translations use that identical phrase. The Passion Translation zeroed right on the will of God for the Church at large. It confirmed our present authority and power to seize the serpent. "Binding satan. Then I saw a *mighty* angel descending from the heavenly realm, holding a heavy chain and a key—the key of the deep. He seized the dragon, that ancient serpent known as the devil and satan, and bound him for a thousand years. The mighty angel threw him into the pit, locked it, and sealed it so that he could no longer deceive the nations until the thousand years were over. (After that he must be loosed for a brief time.) Footnotes: "satan has been bound since the death and resurrection of Jesus. We now enforce the judgment that took place on Calvary. The thousand years is an obvious metaphor of the time in which we live. We are given the authority to overpower the mighty man and tie him up and plunder his goods," Revelation 20:1-3 (TPT). Seize the serpent, satan!

Thought for Transformation

Live breachproof! Activate God's command. "Seize the serpent! The command is in your hand!" Eccl. 10:8 forewarns "...and whoso breaketh an hedge, a serpent shall bite him."

THE STRENGTH OF YOUR COVENANT PARTNER COVERS YOUR WEAKNESS

Your Intercession: "O True God, how much longer will the enemy mock us? Will this insult continue against You forever? Why do You stand by and do nothing? Unleash Your power and finish them off! Even so, the True God is my King from long ago, bringing salvation *to His people* throughout the land. You have divided the sea with Your power; You shattered the skulls of the creatures of the sea; You smashed the heads of Leviathan and fed his remains to the people of the desert. You broke open *the earth* and springs burst forth and streams filled *the crevices*; You dried up the great rivers. The day and the night are both Yours—You fashioned the sun, moon, *and all the lights that pierce the darkness*. You have arranged the earth, set all its boundaries; You are the Architect of *the seasons*: summer and winter. Eternal One, do not forget that the enemy has taunted You and a company of fools has rejected Your name. We are Your *precious* turtledoves; don't surrender our souls to the wild beasts. Do not forget the lives of Your *poor, afflicted, and brokenhearted ones* forever. Be mindful of Your covenant *with us*, for the dark corners of the land are filled with pockets of violence. Do not allow the persecuted to return without honor; may the *poor, wounded, and needy* sing praises *to You; may they bring glory* to Your name! O True God, rise up and defend Your cause; remember how the foolish man insults You every hour of the day. Do not forget the voices of Your enemies, the commotion and chaos of Your foes, which continually grow," Ps. 74:10-23 (VOICE). God's Intervention: "In that day [the Lord will deliver Israel from her enemies and also from the rebel powers of evil and

darkness] His sharp *and* unrelenting, great, and strong sword will visit *and* punish Leviathan the swiftly fleeing serpent, Leviathan the twisting *and* winding serpent; and He will slay the monster that is in the sea. In that day [it will be said of the redeemed nation of Israel], A vineyard beloved *and* lovely; sing a responsive song to it *and* about it! I, the Lord, am its Keeper; I water it every moment; lest anyone harm it, I guard *and* keep it night and day," Is. 27:1-3(AMPC). Covenant partnership always brings heaven to earth.

Examples of Moses, Paul and David dealing with serpents

Exodus 7:1-14, (KJV)

¹ And the LORD said unto Moses, See, I have made thee a god to Pharaoh: and Aaron thy brother shall be thy prophet. ² Thou shalt speak all that I command thee: and Aaron thy brother shall speak unto Pharaoh, that he send the children of Israel out of his land. ³ And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and multiply my signs and my wonders in the land of Egypt. ⁴ But Pharaoh shall not hearken unto you, that I may lay my hand upon Egypt, and bring forth mine armies, and my people the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great judgments. ⁵ And the Egyptians shall know that I am the LORD, when I stretch forth mine hand upon Egypt, and bring out the children of Israel from among them. ⁶ And Moses and Aaron did as the LORD commanded them, so did they. ⁷ And Moses was fourscore years old, and Aaron fourscore and three years old, when they spake unto Pharaoh. ⁸ And the LORD spake unto Moses and unto Aaron, saying, ⁹ When Pharaoh shall speak unto you, saying, Shew a miracle for you: then thou shalt say unto Aaron, Take thy rod, and cast it before Pharaoh, and it shall become a serpent. ¹⁰ And Moses and Aaron went in unto Pharaoh, and

they did so as the LORD had commanded: and Aaron cast down his rod before Pharaoh, and before his servants, and it became a serpent.

¹¹ Then Pharaoh also called the wise men and the sorcerers: now the magicians of Egypt, they also did in like manner with their enchantments.

¹² For they cast down every man his rod, and they became serpents: but Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods. ¹³ And he hardened Pharaoh's heart, that he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said. ¹⁴ And the LORD said unto Moses, Pharaoh's heart is hardened, he refuseth to let the people go.

Acts 28:1-6, (KJV)

¹ And when they were escaped, then they knew that the island was called Melita. ² And the barbarous people shewed us no little kindness: for they kindled a fire, and received us every one, because of the present rain, and because of the cold. ³ And when Paul had gathered a bundle of sticks, and laid them on the fire, there came a viper out of the heat, and fastened on his hand. ⁴ And when the barbarians saw the venomous beast hang on his hand, they said among themselves, No doubt this man is a murderer, whom, though he hath escaped the sea, yet vengeance suffereth not to live. ⁵ And he shook off the beast into the fire, and felt no harm. ⁶ Howbeit they looked when he should have swollen, or fallen down dead suddenly: but after they had looked a great while, and saw no harm come to him, they changed their minds, and said that he was a god.

1 Samuel 30:1-2, (KJV)

¹ And it came to pass, when David and his men were come to Ziklag on the third day, that the Amalekites had invaded the south, and Ziklag, and smitten Ziklag, and burned i.e., *sârâph* (fig. poisonous fiery serpent) it with fire; ² And had taken the women captives, that were therein: they slew not any, either great or small, but carried them away, and went on their way.

I have authority to tread upon serpents (Luke 10:19).

I am a believer, and I pick up serpents (Mark 16:18).

Let the fire of God drive out every serpent from my life (Acts 28:3).

I cast out every viper that would operate in my life in the name of Jesus.
