## GOD'S DIVINE REMEDY: THE ANOINTING OIL, THE WINE, AND THE BREAD

Psalm 104:14-16, (GNV) distinguishes God as the source, supply, and surplus of agriculture and all-natural provision. Specifically verse 15 mentions three types of produce: wine, oil, and bread. "He causeth grass to grow for the cattle, and herb for the use of <sup>[a]</sup>man, that he may bring forth bread out of the earth, And wine *that* maketh glad the heart of man, *and* oil to make his face to shine, and bread *that* strengtheneth man's heart. The high trees are satisfied, *even* the cedars of Lebanon, which he hath planted." Verse 14 Footnotes: "He describeth God's provident care over man, who doth not only provide necessary things for him, as herbs and other meat: but also things to rejoice and comfort him as wine and oil, or ointments." Now, overlay the kingdom of God's supernatural supply over that scripture text. It manifests Jesus as the Anointed Messiah as you receive the Communion elements. With all limitations removed from just receiving naturally, God releases heaven's surplus. So make room for Him to do the exceeding, abundantly above all you can imagine. Supernatural therapy for your spirit, soul, and body is hand-delivered by the nourishment of the bread from the *logos* Word of God and the *rhéma* Word of God from Jesus, the Bread of Life and the wine and the oil from Holy Spirit, the Breath of Life. By God anointing you with Holy Spirit and the *dunamis* miraculous power, you receive healing from all oppression of any enemy. Holy Spirit pours in the wine to disinfect the wound, cleansing every breach. Spiritual wine causes your inner man to rejoice. Also Holy Spirit pours on the burden-removing, yoke-destroying anointing oil. The oil soothes your countenance so you not only glow but also physically gallop all over the ground satan could not conquer. Jesus makes what Holy Spirit pours in and pours on stable, sustainable, and scalable. Jesus, the Word of God is the same Jesus who strengthens you from the beginning to end of cleansing, healing, hedging, and hushing every wound. Jesus' significance of receiving Communion is eating the Bread and drinking the wine from heaven. By partaking of the bread and wine your youth is strikingly restored to divine health in spirit, soul, and body. God sent Jesus to earth to yield His shredded body and His shed blood for healing and forgiveness of sin of the whole world. In exchange, you receive God's life to the full until it overflows. In Jesus alone, you inherit life, i.e., eternal, resurrection, and abundant as God promised. God's everlasting blood covenant with you is ordered in all things and sure. It is all your salvation and all your desire. It springs forth so you always thrive in life. Coming to Jesus and giving your heart to Him, you won't hunger, nor will you thirst by believing on Him. Live fully alive through Christ in all things, inside and out!

## ALWAYS LEAVE HOME PREPARED TO MINISTER HEALING TO OTHERS

Luke 10:30-37, (AMP) Parable of the Good Samaritan. "Jesus replied, 'A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and he encountered robbers, who stripped him of his clothes [and belongings], beat him, and went their way [unconcerned], leaving him half dead. Now by coincidence a priest was going down that road, and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. Likewise a Levite also came down to the place and saw him, and passed by on the other side [of the road]. But a Samaritan (foreigner), who was traveling, came upon him; and when he saw him, he was deeply moved with compassion [for him], and went to him and bandaged up his wounds, pouring oil and wine on them [to sooth and disinfect the injuries]; and he put him on his own pack-animal, and brought him to an inn and took care of him. On the next day he took out two denarii (two days' wages) and gave them to the innkeeper, and said, 'Take care of him; and whatever more you spend, I will repay you when I return.' Which of these three do you think proved himself a neighbor to the man who encountered the robbers?" He answered, "The one who showed compassion and mercy to him." Then Jesus said to him, "Go and constantly do the same."
