The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 380 Scriptures

This is Section W of a multi-part instruction. Holy Spirit was first introduced in the book of Genesis as the Third Person of the Godhead, Elohim. Throughout the Old Testament, you can see the empowerment of Holy Spirit demonstrated. This fixes our focus, not on our own power or might, but by the Spirit of the Lord Most High. Holy Spirit fills us to overflowing so we can expect Him to come in like a flood to make miraculous changes in the world through us.

Holy Spirit supervened Mary's womb by impregnating her with Jesus. Our Heavenly Father, Abba anointed Jesus with Holy Spirit and dunamis power. Then Abba accompanied Jesus as He went about doing good, and healing all who were oppressed of the devil during His earthly ministry. Jesus baptizing you with Holy Spirit and the fire of God grants you an unfair advantage to fulfill your destiny on earth.

Jesus introduced Holy Spirit as the One to lead God's succession plan on earth after His ascension. Jesus commissioned the Body of Christ to do the same works He performed on earth giving us our invitation to inherit and inhabit His anointing. Jesus also promised the Body of Christ that greater works will even be performed because of the presence and power of Holy Spirit upon us so we are filled with the fullness of God. You are a habitation of God through Holy Spirit where Jesus Christ lives in your heart by faith. That's how the Tsunami Blessing, Inside and Out will become a heaven-born reality.

JESUS' MINISTRY THROUGH HOLY SPIRIT PROPHESIED

Isaiah 61:1-3, The Voice

The Spirit of the Lord, the Eternal, is on me. *The Lord has appointed me for a special purpose*. He has anointed me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent me to repair broken hearts, And to declare to those who are held captive and bound in prison, "Be free *from your imprisonment!"* ² *He has sent me* to announce the year *of jubilee, the season* of the Eternal's favor: *for our enemies* it will be a day of God's wrath; For those who mourn it will be *a time of* comfort. ^[a] ³ As for those who grieve over Zion, *God has sent me* to give them a *beautiful* crown in exchange for ashes, To anoint them

with gladness instead of sorrow, to wrap them in *victory*, *joy*, *and* praise instead of depression and sadness. People will call them *magnificent*, *like great towering* trees standing for what is right. They stand to the glory of the Eternal who planted them.

JESUS' MINISTRY THROUGH HOLY SPIRIT FULFILLED

Luke 4:16-30, The Voice

¹⁶ He eventually came to His hometown, Nazareth, and did there what He had done elsewhere *in Galilee*—entered the synagogue and stood up to read *from the Hebrew Scriptures*. ¹⁷ The *synagogue attendant* gave Him the scroll of the prophet Isaiah, and Jesus unrolled it to the place where Isaiah had written these words: ¹⁸ The Spirit of the Lord the Eternal One is on Me. *Why?* Because the Eternal designated Me to be His representative to the poor, to preach good news to them.

Luke's audience doesn't divide the world into sacred vs. secular or religious vs. political. For them, life is integrated. And for them, these "religious" words from Isaiah have a powerful and "political" meaning: because they see themselves as oppressed by the Roman occupation, Jesus' words suggest that His "good news" describes a powerful change about to come—a change that will rescue the people from their oppression. His fellow Jews have long been waiting for a savior to free them from Roman oppression. Jesus tells them their hopes are about to be fulfilled. But then, just as people speak well of Jesus, He lets them know their expectations aren't in line with God's plans. He tells them not to expect God to fit into their boxes and suggests the unthinkable: that God cares for the Gentiles, the very people who are oppressing them! They aren't too pleased by this.

He sent Me to tell those who are held captive that they can now be set free, and to tell the blind that they can now see. He sent Me to liberate those held down by oppression. ¹⁹ In short, the Spirit is upon Me to proclaim that now is the time; this is the jubilee season of the Eternal One's grace. ^[a] ²⁰ Jesus rolled up the scroll and returned it to the synagogue attendant. Then He sat down, as a teacher would do, and all in the synagogue focused their attention on Jesus, waiting for Him to speak. ²¹ He told them that these words from the Hebrew Scriptures were being fulfilled then and there, in their hearing. ²² At first everyone was deeply impressed with the gracious

words that poured from Jesus' lips. Everyone spoke well of Him and was amazed that He could say these things.

Everyone: Wait. This is only the son of Joseph, right?

Jesus: ²³ You're about to quote the old proverb to Me, "Doctor, heal yourself!" Then you're going to ask Me to prove Myself to you by doing the same miracles I did in Capernaum. ²⁴ But face the truth: hometowns always reject their homegrown prophets. ²⁵ Think back to the prophet Elijah. There were many needy Jewish widows in *his homeland*, Israel, when a terrible famine persisted there for three and a half years. ²⁶ Yet the only widow God sent Elijah to help was *an outsider* from Zarephath in Sidon. ^[b] ²⁷ It was the same with the prophet Elisha. There were many Jewish lepers in his homeland, but the only one he healed—Naaman—*was an outsider* from Syria. ^[c] ²⁸ The people in the synagogue became furious when He said these things. ²⁹ They seized Jesus, took Him to the edge of town, and pushed Him right to the edge of the cliff on which the city was built. They would have pushed Him off and killed Him, ³⁰ but He passed through the crowd and went on His way.

JESUS PROPHESIED WE ARE ANOINTED AND APPOINTED TO FULFILL HIS MINISTRY THROUGH HOLY SPIRIT

John 14:16-18, (KJV)

¹⁴ For this reason [[a]] seeing the greatness of this plan by which you are built together in Christ], I bow my knees before the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, ¹⁵ For Whom every family in heaven and on earth is named [that Father from Whom all fatherhood takes its title and derives its name]. ¹⁶ May He grant you out of the rich treasury of His glory to be strengthened and reinforced with mighty power in the inner man by the [Holy] Spirit [Himself indwelling your innermost being and personality]. ¹⁷ May Christ through your faith [actually] dwell (settle down, abide, make His permanent home) in your hearts! May you be rooted deep in love and founded securely on love, ¹⁸ That you may have the power and be strong to apprehend and grasp with

all the saints [God's devoted people, the experience of that love] what is the breadth and length and height and depth [of it]; ¹⁹ [That you may really come] to know [practically, ^[b]through experience for yourselves] the love of Christ, which far surpasses ^[c]mere knowledge [without experience]; that you may be filled [through all your being] ^[d]unto all the fullness of God [may have the richest measure of the divine Presence, and ^[e]become a body wholly filled and flooded with God Himself]! ²⁰ Now to Him Who, by (in consequence of) the [action of His] power that is at work within us, is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly, far over *and* above all that we [dare] ask or think [infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes, or dreams]— ²¹ To Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations forever and ever. Amen (so be it).

DOCUMENTED SIGNS AND WONDERS THROUGH THE PRESENCE AND THE POWER OF HOLY SPIRIT

The following personal testimonies illustrate how the presence and power of God can live voluptuously in your midst. In each situation, I witnessed the grace of God and the glory of God or was informed by the receiver of the sign and word that was present.

The Touch of Heaven Felt

Here is the first example: After singing my original song, *Shalom*, which is interpreted as peace in Hebrew, a member of the audience told me she felt the peace of God rest upon her.

This is the second example: At times, I may select a sermon or the Word of God repeatedly playing in the adjacent room while I sleep. The computer's auto-play is turned off to ensure I know what is entering me and my home. On this particular Christmas Eve, it was no different.

However, when I awakened a sermon in the middle of the night I desperately needed to hear was already playing, although I had never heard it before that time. When I checked the computer settings, the auto-play was still turned off. That one inspiration was enough to deliver me from bondage to deliver me to freedom. There

is no natural explanation of what happened. Nevertheless, that supernatural intervention changed my life. Holy Spirit's download was indeed a divine touchdown.

God's Thumbprint

Throughout the Scriptures, there are countless references regarding the hand of God. His hand upholds you to prevent you from falling. His hand holds your hand as a sign of His eternal love. His outstretched hand is against your enemy.

I believe the optimal display of His right hand is when God raised it to take His eternal vow to enter into His everlasting covenant with you. It indicates the impossibility of God to lie and His immutability by granting you His strong consolation at all times. Because of that, God confirmed that we can always depend on Him to be the very present, active force in our lives as receiving-believers. That includes you!

I have experienced God's tangible touch in another way. This has only occurred a few times where His touch gave me the impression that it was His thumb lightly pushing down on the top of my head. Please know the pressure never hurt at all. It just remained steadfast until I completed the unsettling assignment He gave me to do. However, His unmistakable signal ensured me that not only was His time correct but also His timing was critical.

In one instance, I recall Holy Spirit prompting me in that way without uttering even a single word. I intuitively knew whom I should address as well as the subject matter at hand. It involved that person denouncing the sin of witchcraft and covering the transgression with the blood of the Lamb.

To say the least, the situation was quite uncomfortable because I did not think the message would be received from me specifically. When the matter first surfaced, I as well as some of the others in the same setting warned the party not to get involved with that material spontaneously that was almost simultaneously.

Your obedience to Holy Spirit is never dependent on whether the message will be received or not. From God's point of view, you are only responsible for the delivery when you know He has chosen you for the assignment.

This is how I recall my divine assignment as it happened. I was on my afternoon break at work around 3:00 p.m. when Holy Spirit's thumb visited me. Although I was sure of what I was to do, I had no desire at all to do it. I did not get off work until 4:30 p.m. so did not arrive home until 5:30 p.m.

The first thing I did once coming into the house was to telephone that party. The person listened quietly and never really made any comment at all. As soon as I hung up the phone, the Lord lifted His thumb immediately from the top of my head. My task was complete. I firmly believe that the Lord was supernaturally intervening to prevent satan from wreaking havoc.

Because the breach remained open, misfortune began to prevail. It did not directly begin with that person, but with the offspring. 2 Thessalonians 2:7 cites the "mystery of iniquity." It worked passed this individual to operate against all three of the children until they all divorced within a short timeframe. It was a back-to-back breach within a brief period indicating that there was not any repentance before God. Therefore the lack of resolution to heal, hedge, and hush the breach remained nonexistent.

The Scene of Heaven Observed

Countless times as I am reading my Bible, a scripture will seem to pop off the page. In that one moment in time, it has shown just what Holy Spirit desired for me to receive.

This is the one example: I recall one of my first memories of seeing into the spirit realm. I was riding on the rapid transit to work and had a vision that our office door had been locked. Habitually, that door was always closed, but never locked. After arriving to work, I confirmed the locked door.

Now, I believe Holy Spirit was ushering me into having x-ray vision. He transitioned me from what I already knew to be always true in the natural realm so that I could preview the change in the spiritual realm beforehand. In this case, He engaged my imagination with His picture from the heavenly realm.

The next story Holy Spirit answered my appeal through skywriting. Having returned to work with mobility restrictions from my doctor, the employer desired to assign the entire staff to make visitations throughout the program's neighborhood. Although they were fully aware of my authentically documented limitations, they persisted with their plans to move ahead without any regard.

I appealed to the Lord and He granted me a literal sign and wonder. I do not recall the reason but later on that day I just happened to go and look out of the front office window from the second floor. In the midst of the blue sky, an oversized letter "X" had already been formed out of white clouds. This was so real, not fabricated by my own imagination! The God whom I serve has the final say-so and He said NO! After His divinely inspired visual verdict, the employer called off that detail and never even attempted to try it ever again. God's NO really means NO!

The LORD Is Our King ¹⁷ With your own eyes you will see the glorious King; you will see his kingdom reaching far and wide.

The Sounds of Heaven Heard

You can hear just one word, even a phrase. It can even be a two-way conversation with heaven. Within my heart, I heard the phrase, "Be ripe for the harvest." It perfectly recalled what I previously heard some years before. But this time, Holy Spirit led me to a 2014 PowerPoint presentation that I created five years later. It had the exact wording. Then I could see it in the proper context. It was just how God saw where He planned to take me at that one moment in time.

¹⁴ For God speaketh once [I hear Holy Spirit the very first time], yea twice, yet man perceiveth it not. ¹⁵ In a dream, in a vision of the night, when deep

sleep falleth upon men, in slumberings upon the bed; ¹⁶ Then he openeth the ears of men, and sealeth their instruction, ¹⁷ That he may withdraw man from his purpose, and hide pride from man. ¹⁸ He keepeth back his soul from the pit, and his life from perishing by the sword.

⁴The Lord God hath given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to him that is weary: he wakeneth morning by morning, he wakeneth mine ear to hear as the learned. ⁵The Lord God hath opened mine ear, and I was not rebellious, neither turned away back.

The Scent of Heaven Sensed

I received another testimony when I sang *Shalom* on the foresaid occasion. Another attendee told me she could smell the scent of lilac. I discovered an online source that named two reasons you cannot smell lilac: 1) the presence of non-aromatic species; and 2) air temperature. I believe the atmosphere hosted Holy Spirit's presence perfectly. He had the liberty to abide in the atmosphere because it was like Heaven to Him. There was nothing present that could cause His presence and power to fade away. There was nothing that vexed, grieved, or quenched Him.

The Taste of Heaven Savored

While taste is known as palpable, it can also be metaphoric in its relation to consuming the enemy as prey. God devoured the adversary for you, so you can experience the sweet taste of victory He has already given to you because of Jesus' finished works.

That is like the prepared table the Lord set in the presence of your enemy. The noticeable distinction is that satan is never invited to be a partaker, but only serves as the spoils of war. This confirms that it remains impossible for the foe to do what he thought he could do in the first place.

Throughout the Bible, sometimes it was those opposed who only saw the theophany. That was the same for the following testimony. I did not see what Holy Spirit was doing. However, I was certain I was supernaturally safeguarded. A past prophecy informed me that two angels would accompany me as I ministered.

This is what occurred as I was representing someone else in the magistrate's chambers. Immediately siding with the other party, he verbally attacked me which continued throughout the initial proceeding.

Left alone, I approached him to appeal on behalf of the party. Suddenly, he dropped face down with both arms stretched out on his desk as if he were paying homage. He laid both quietly and statically. I knew he wasn't honoring me, but the Lord of hosts who never leaves me or forsakes me.

The individual who accompanied me, but remained on the outside of the chambers said Holy Spirit alerted her to pray for me. Whenever I had to appear before the magistrate after that day, he would always glance all around me to see if I was alone. Practice the presence of God. Consciously invite the Lord along wherever you go. You will discover a noticeable difference, not just signs of improvement.

⁴ For it is impossible to ·bring back again to a changed life [Lrenew again to repentance] those who were once ·in God's light [enlightened], and ·enjoyed [experienced; Ltasted] ·heaven's gift [or the heavenly gift; Cperhaps the gift of salvation], and ·shared in [partook of] the Holy Spirit. They ·found out [Ltasted] how good God's word is, and ·they received [Ltasted] the ·powers [miracles] of ·his new world [the coming age/world]. If they have ·fallen away [committed apostasy], it is impossible to ·bring them back to a changed life again [Lrenew them again to repentance], because they are nailing the Son of God to a cross again and are ·shaming him in front of others [making a public disgrace/exhibition of him].

Your five physical senses, i.e., what you see, hear, touch, taste, and smell can be transformed to effectively and efficiently operate within the supernatural realm. Say aloud, "In the name of Jesus, I am the greatest receiver and releaser of revelation knowledge within the kingdom of God. Holy Spirit is ever disposed to give to me and I am in a position for Him to clothe, complete, and cram the void in every situation. Thank you, Jesus!"
