The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 388 Scriptures

This is Section AE of a multi-part instruction. Holy Spirit was first introduced in the book of Genesis as the Third Person of the Godhead, Elohim. Throughout the Old Testament, you can see the empowerment of Holy Spirit demonstrated. This fixes our focus, not on our own power or might, but by the Spirit of the Lord Most High. Holy Spirit fills us to overflowing so we can expect Him to come in like a flood to make miraculous changes in the world through us.

Holy Spirit supervened Mary's womb by impregnating her with Jesus. Our Heavenly Father, Abba anointed Jesus with Holy Spirit and dunamis power. Then Abba accompanied Jesus as He went about doing good, and healing all who were oppressed of the devil during His earthly ministry. Jesus baptizing you with Holy Spirit and the fire of God grants you an unfair advantage to fulfill your destiny on earth.

Jesus introduced Holy Spirit as the One to lead God's succession plan on earth after His ascension. Jesus commissioned the Body of Christ to do the same works He performed on earth giving us our invitation to inherit and inhabit His anointing. Jesus also promised the Body of Christ that greater works will even be performed because of the presence and power of Holy Spirit upon us so we are filled with the fullness of God. You are a habitation of God through Holy Spirit where Jesus Christ lives in your heart by faith. That's how the Tsunami Blessing, Inside and Out will become a heaven-born reality.

JESUS IS THE COVENANTED NAME OF GOD

Salvation benefits are complete in every way, embracing everything all the time. Psalm 67:1-2 (KJV) proves God's finishing touch when He employs the phrase, "saving health." The New Birth ignites our eternal covenant with the Lord. He covers every weakness with His miraculous strength.

Holy Spirit led me to The Jubilee Bible (2000) which publishes that same stirring phrase on 130 different occasions throughout the Old and New Testaments. To date, this is my latest discovery of the significance of saving health.

"Saving" and "health" carry identical meanings. That is like the double portion of our inheritance because of what Jesus Christ

shared with us. The Strong's Concordance defines God's all-inclusive provision for you. You can access six diverse advantages on the earth now: 1) aid; 2) prosperity; 3) welfare; 4) help; 5) victory; and 6) deliverance.

Since you a joint heir with Christ who is the first-born that always receives the double portion, that your inheritance also. In effect that is 1) double aid; 2) double prosperity; 3) double welfare; 4) double help; 5) double victory; and 6) double deliverance.

Taking you beyond that description, the Hebrew translation for the phrase, "saving health" is *Yeshuah*. It shows Jesus our Everlasting Father and our Heavenly Father "Abba" interpreted as "Daddy" in the Greek language joined together "AS ONE." Therefore, *Yeshuah* is not misspelled when you see the "h" at the end of His name. In this context, it carries the greatest influence.

Hebrew4Christians website indicates that when two *Hei* appear together, it represents the Divine Name "Yeshua" and "H." During Creation the website connects *Heh* (Hei) to the Presence of God as well as the Power of God. Even as I began to pen the latest discovery of the letter h in Hebrew, the overwhelming presence and power of God immediately flooded me. I am so delighted that Holy Spirit authorized this entry that confirms its accuracy.

This is how I received revelation knowledge about Psalm 67:2. While I believed "Yeshuah" was not a misprint, I desired clarity. Holy Spirit helped me to stay ready to receive the answer many years later. I was listening to a religious broadcast but had fallen asleep. Holy Spirit awakened me at the exact time the minister was discussing the letter "H" and then turned to his Academy's professor to confirm it as Abba's Hebrew name indeed.

While Yeshuah authentically brands Jesus' identity in this case, it also designates God's seal of endorsement and reinforcement upon Jesus. It indicates God's own name rests satisfied in Jesus alone. Further research revealed the last "h" in Yeshuah is the fifth letter of the Hebrew alphabet Heh (Hei). Also positioned as the fifth letter, it portrays the grace of God. It is often used to represent the name of God; it sounds like the English letter "h" and is pronounced as "hey."

Now, you can see the reality of the alphabet "H" as the name of God even in Genesis. It is through Abram's impotency in Genesis 17:5 as well as Sarai's barrenness in Genesis 17:15. Only after God added His name to Abram and Sarai could they reproduce the promised heir. It was the letter "H" that certified Abraham and Sarah's name change to birth Isaac.

Those two aforementioned scriptures confirmed God's eternal covenant with them for supernatural transformation, i.e., bring heaven to earth. It is similar to them authorizing God's signature to complete His part of the transaction, i.e., His vowed promise to them.

That confirms God's presence and power behind every reproduction of any heaven-born reality rests inseparably in the name of Yeshuah. This specific generational blessing magnified God's succession plan when He sent Jesus into the world as our Savior.

Jesus as our Everlasting Father birthed the family of God through His perfect sacrifice. Then Jesus granted God full adoption rights to be our Heavenly Father and then was repositioned as the firstborn of many brothers and sisters. Being re-born, you are now in Jesus' bloodline.

⁵ To symbolize your foundational role in this covenant, I hereby change your name. You will no longer go by the name "Abram." Your new name will be "Abraham," which means "father of a great multitude of nations," because that is exactly what I will make of you. [a]

Genesis 17:15, The Voice

15 (continuing to Abraham) As for Sarai, your wife, the covenant applies to her as well. No longer will she be known as Sarai; her new name will be Sarah.

2 Samuel 23:1-7, The Message

¹ These are David's last words: The voice of the son of Jesse, the voice of the man God took to the top, Whom the God of Jacob made king, and Israel's most popular singer! ²⁻⁷ God's Spirit spoke through me, his words took shape on my tongue. The God of Israel spoke to me, Israel's Rock-Mountain said, "Whoever governs fairly and well, who rules in the Fear-of-God, Is like first light at daybreak without a cloud in the sky, Like green grass carpeting earth, glistening under fresh rain." And this is just how my regime has been, for God guaranteed his covenant with me, spelled it out plainly and kept every promised word— My entire salvation, my every desire. But the devil's henchmen are like thorns culled and piled as trash; Better not try to touch them; keep your distance with a rake or hoe. They'll make a glorious bonfire!

By the time Psalm 67 was written by King David, God had already placed His name upon Israel in His blessing pronounced in Numbers 6:24-27 (KJV). Now God's name that's upon Jesus is also upon the Body of Christ, the Church. Therefore, the blessing has also been conferred upon us to inherit and inhabit God's promises. "The LORD bless thee, and keep thee: The LORD make His face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee: The LORD lift up His countenance upon thee, and give thee peace. And they shall put My name upon the children of Israel, and I will bless them."

Dissolving all doubts, the entire Psalm 67 is an integral part of God's covert operations even in the Old Testament. Unbeknownst to enemy forces, King David's faith ushered Jesus Christ's identity as God's Son into the earth well before His arrival date. That served God's purpose as one of His ingenious ways to introduce Jesus' name along with publishing our salvation's benefits.

God's divine plan of sending His own Son from heaven to earth was never once detected or expected by satan. That shows just how far God will go to bring your divine inheritance to you without any interruption. God is the all-season expert in hiding His treasure inside His inaccessible vault. The same protection and preservation

plan He exhibited through Jesus Christ, He also has for you, the treasure of His heart. That is a breakthrough!

JESUS KEPT US IN ABBA'S NAME

THE PERFECT BED, RESTING PLACE

Before Jesus departed heaven, He was perfectly convinced He was the only begotten Son of God. He was prepared for the work He was to finish on earth even from the foundation of the world. He knew His perfect sacrifice unto God was required to save the entire world from sin.

¹⁴ For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

¹⁵ For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. ¹⁶ The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:

¹⁷ And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.

Destined to be our Redeemer, His broken body and spilled blood would pay the total price to reconcile us back to Abba. Jesus' finished work would give Abba the desire of His heart. That was to not just have one Son alone but to embrace an entire family, which includes you.

In heaven, Jesus absolutely knew He was God's only begotten Son. Born into the world, the Spirit of God and the Word of God perfectly relayed to Jesus everything required for Him to have perfect recall. From that vantage point, Jesus was absolutely sure Abba was His Heavenly Father at twelve years old, which is just one year shy of being considered an adult as observed in the Jewish culture.

There was not one detail that could have taken Jesus by surprise. Being reacquainted with His Heavenly Father, Jesus remained passionate about the vision that resonated in His heart. He never allowed anyone or anything to talk Him out of His calling and election. He knew without a shadow of a doubt, who was He to God indeed. Therefore, Jesus had, hosted, and held on to the mind of Christ, the very intellect as given to Him by Abba.

Jesus was even bold enough to perfectly express it to His earthly parents, Joseph and Mary. Why? Jesus' uninterrupted fellowship with His Heavenly Father caused Him to know as He was known by the love of God. He knew it was the absolute truth He could absolutely trust because of His intimacy with His Heavenly Father, Abba even on earth.

Now let's ponder on the events that occurred with Jesus' transition into the earth. Jesus was procreated as the seed of His Heavenly Father into Mary's womb by Holy Spirit. Growing up Jesus had to become familiar with Abba but this time as a spirit with a soul in a body. Jesus' entry into the world was exactly like every human being, except for Him being initially downloaded from heaven by faith without the natural sperm of a mortal man.

Abba's incorruptible seed impregnated Mary's womb through the dunamis power of Holy Spirit through the logos Word of God and the rhéma Word of God. As a baby, Jesus knew nothing about His divine pedigree. Every bit of wisdom, knowledge, understanding, and revelation Jesus was once proficient in practicing perfectly, was now hidden within His DNA.

Jesus had to reconnect to God as His Abba Father to retrieve His earthly assignment and agenda. Jesus accurately downloaded His calling and election through the leadership of the Spirit of God and the lens of the *logos* Word of God and the *rhéma* Word of God.

Consider the following as Jesus' scenario: Although as the eternal Son of God who resided in heaven, He temporarily served as the Son of man on earth. Jesus' perfect union with Abba was restored to hear and listen to and for the voice of God perfectly. That is how Jesus downloaded revealed truth.

Jesus' perfect union with Abba Father was renewed and revived so He recognized and realized the voice of God perfectly. One online research disclosed when a baby fetus starts to hear. "Around eighteen weeks of pregnancy i.e., 4½ months, your little one hears their very first sounds. By twenty-four weeks i.e., 6 months, those little ears are rapidly developing. Your baby's sensitivity to sound will improve even more as the weeks pass."

Can you imagine our Heavenly Father already knowing that since Elohim created every human being on earth? Likewise, can you envision our Heavenly Father having the unfair advantage to ensure Jesus even in Mary's womb heard His tender, loving voice before anyone else? Ever so softly, Abba whispers to Jesus, "Yeshuah, Yeshuah, this is Abba, your Heavenly Father!!!"

Even now, I can hear Abba wooing me with His soft voice, "Kathryn Joy *Yeshuah*, this is *Abba*, your Heavenly Father!!!"

Now, can you visualize our Heavenly Father having pursued you in your mother's womb and even now to unfold your destiny that is in your DNA? Webster's 1828 edition defines destiny "invincible necessity." In other words, the only way your destiny cannot happen is if you are a no-show. Stay fixed to the end so you can see just who God recreated you to be, His masterpiece, neither just a piece of work.

You may remember that when God pronounced His blessing over Israel that He concluded it with "And they shall put My name upon the children of Israel, and I will bless them," Numbers 6:27, (KJV). The word "put" in Hebrew from the aforementioned verse is "sum or sim" which is literally defined as "to put, place, set. Figuratively, put means to set, ordain, establish, found, appoint, constitute, make, determine, fix."

Jesus was ever so proud to wear His Heavenly Father's name on His, Yeshuah, i.e., Yeshua and Hei. Acknowledged in the book of Revelation, the third chapter records the One who has the key of David. It is Jesus who reveals the truth behind the newness of life in heaven to the Apostle John in verse 12.

Jesus will write God's name on each overcomer and the name of the city of God, the New Jerusalem. But Jesus didn't stop there. Jesus also disclosed that He would write His new name too. That helps us all to better understand that Jesus is our Heavenly Father's name indeed because Abba is never mentioned as receiving a new name.

Otherwise, why Jesus would need to have a new name at all? That verifies God put His own name on Jesus, *Yeshuah*. Scripturally certified, the name of Jesus is forever sovereign in heaven, in earth, and under the earth. Thus, Abba ordained Jesus to wear His surname in all three spheres of influence. That is why when we decree or declare, we are authorized to use the name of Jesus.

Revelation 3:12, New American Standard Bible 1995

¹² He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will not go out from it anymore; and I will write on him the name of My God, and the name of the city of My God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God, and My new name.

From Joseph and Mary's initial response to Jesus announcing God as His Heavenly Father, they never mentioned anything to Jesus about His divine pedigree. That is your confirmation of the absolute truth you can absolutely trust as well. Now Holy Spirit is your source, supply, and surplus who will give you perfect recall of God's design for your destiny on earth. What is written in your book in heaven's chronicles, Holy Spirit will teach you just as He coached Jesus to acclimate to Abba, His Father in heaven.

Beforehand, Jesus even knew He would give His unquestionable testimony for the Apostle John to author the book of Revelation. His Resurrection conquered His Crucifixion indeed. "I am He that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death," Revelation 1:18.

Jesus realized in heaven He was "...the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world" as Revelation 13:8 quotes. Moreover, He relied on Holy Spirit to remind Him of His destiny to be fulfilled on earth. Holy Spirit revealed to Jesus that He was the only begotten Son of God in heaven. Also, that Jesus came to earth to give His life as the Savior for the whole world.

At the close of His earthly life and ministry, Jesus sacrificially paved the way for Abba, Father to have the family He always desired. Jesus served as our Everlasting Father on earth who gave our Heavenly Father the right of adoption. That is when Jesus became the firstborn among many brothers and sisters. God has chosen you as His adopted son or His adopted daughter from the foundation of the world as well. Therefore, you were never an afterthought in the heart of Abba, Father. That is your confirmation of the absolute truth you can absolutely trust too.

Holding the express honor as the Son of God, Jesus humbled Himself to fulfill His divine purpose, plan, and path as the Son of man. In essence, Jesus stripped Himself of all the glory and majesty God adorned Him with as the only begotten Son of God to accomplish God's divine assignment on earth as the Son of man.

Jesus, the Mastering Son of God became the Ministering Servant for God. Philippians 2:5-11 illustrates just how God honored Jesus' humility. That gives us a bona fide example of how to live honorably in the presence of the Lord in all humility. You are wearing God's name too.

Let Christ be your example of humility

5-11 Let Christ himself be your example as to what your attitude should be. For he, who had always been God by nature, did not cling to his prerogatives as God's equal, but stripped himself of all privilege by consenting to be a slave by nature and being born as mortal man. And, having become man, he humbled himself by living a life of utter obedience, even to the extent of dying, and the death he died was the death of a common criminal. That is why God has now lifted him so high, and has given him the name beyond all names, so that at the name of Jesus "every knee shall bow", whether in

Heaven or earth or under the earth. And that is why, in the end, "every tongue shall confess" that Jesus Christ" is the Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Matthew Henry's Concise Commentary

2:5-11 The example of our Lord Jesus Christ is set before us. We must resemble him in his life, if we would have the benefit of his death. Notice the two natures of Christ; his Divine nature, and human nature. Who being in the form of God, partaking the Divine nature, as the eternal and onlybegotten Son of God, Joh 1:1, had not thought it a robbery to be equal with God, and to receive Divine worship from men. His human nature; herein he became like us in all things except sin. Thus low, of his own will, he stooped from the glory he had with the Father before the world was. Christ's two states, of humiliation and exaltation, are noticed. Christ not only took upon him the likeness and fashion, or form of a man, but of one in a low state; not appearing in splendour. His whole life was a life of poverty and suffering. But the lowest step was his dying the death of the cross, the death of a malefactor and a slave; exposed to public hatred and scorn. The exaltation was of Christ's human nature, in union with the Divine. At the name of Jesus, not the mere sound of the word, but the authority of Jesus, all should pay solemn homage. It is to the glory of God the Father, to confess that Jesus Christ is Lord; for it is his will, that all men should honour the Son as they honour the Father, Joh 5:23. Here we see such motives to self-denying love as nothing else can supply. Do we thus love and obey the Son of God?
