The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 390 Scriptures

John 1:31-33, Amplified Bible

- c. <u>John 1:32</u> The descent of the Holy Spirit identified Jesus in His humanity for His ministry as the Messiah.
- d. John 1:33 The Greek here can be translated in, with or by.

After the resurrection of Jesus, He appeared to His disciples. After Jesus validated He was alive indeed, He breathed on them in order to re-create them through Holy Spirit. Now Holy Spirit was inside of them. It is the initiation of the New Birth experience. John 20:22 confirms the term "breathed" in Greek is identical to the Hebrew word "breathed" in Genesis 2:7. The Passion Translation research shows the word "breathed" only appears once in the New Testament in Greek.

John 20:22 The Passion Translation

²² Then, taking a deep breath, he blew^[a] on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit.^[b]

- a. <u>20:22</u> The Greek word used here does not appear elsewhere in the New Testament; however, it is the same word found in the Septuagint for when God "breathed" into Adam's nostrils the breath of life (<u>Gen. 2:7</u>). The beginning of new creation life came from the breath of Jesus. The mighty wind of <u>Acts 2</u> was for power, the breath Jesus breathed into his disciples in this verse was for life.
- b. 20:22 Or "accept the Sacred Breath."

Acts 2:2-4 is evidence of the one hundred twenty disciples who stayed in the place Jesus assigned them. Having ever-living expectations, they waited unto they were all baptized with Holy Spirit and with fire.

Please know, that it was not just the various languages that were displayed before the unbelievers. Those who received the promise of the Father were all carriers of the manifest presence of God as well as the miraculous power of God. Holy Spirit and the fire brought about a supernatural turnaround in their lives that even transformed their character.

a. 2:16 That is, we believers possess the Holy Spirit, who reveals the thoughts and purposes of Christ. The revelation of the kingdom of God that Jesus preached was not understood by the intellect of men but by those who welcomed his truth. Humanly speaking, no one can understand the mysteries of God without the Holy Spirit. Those who have the Holy Spirit now possess the perceptions of Christ's mind and can implement his purposes on the earth.

CARNAL KNOWLEDGE

The most contemptible level of knowledge is carnal knowledge. It not only contrasts the mind of Christ i.e., the very intellect of Jesus, but remains an avid challenger. It is satan's device to corrupt the culture of learning through his deception, errors, lies, and fabricated evidence appearing real.

The enemy attempts to use this diabolical method of operation to pervert both sense knowledge and intellectual knowledge. It embodies what the enemy lusts for you to think, feel, and choose so you will always work alongside satan against God.

Romans 8:1-8 illustrates the carnal mind as the unregenerate mentality of human nature. It is permanently bent on setting itself against living spiritually minded. So you can see it opposes the mind of Christ, i.e., the very intellect of Jesus.

Since the mind of the Spirit is forever unrivaled, carnal knowledge is satan's warped weapon to unravel the mindset instead. That scam and sham only covets to lead someone astray from feasting on the Word of God and from following the Spirit of God. Then that party will think in harmony with the world, the flesh, and the devil.

Romans 8:1-8 (KJV)

There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. ²For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death. ³For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh: ⁴That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. ⁵For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit. ⁶For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. ⁷Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. ⁸So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

The carnal nature is so unrestrained that 2 Corinthians 10:5 exposes its true motive. The enemy uses someone's imagination as an obstruction to "exalt itself against the knowledge of God." This knowledge is *gnosis* in Greek is described as "working knowledge gleaned from first-hand experience."

The reason why satan lusts after the knowledge of God is to gain access to the absolute truth that you can absolutely trust. The enemy's insatiable appetite for revelation knowledge is something he is banned from receiving from God altogether.

Since it remains impossible for satan to even penetrate revelation knowledge that can only originate from God alone, he attempts to contrive a polar opposite. Although it remains impossible for satan to breach any lines of divine communications at all, he still doesn't want you to gain and retain any knowledge of God's secrets either.

If you divulge classified information before its time and timing and it is not coated by the blood of Jesus Christ, satan will attempt to use it against you to stymie the purpose, plan, and path of God. That is why you need to enquire of Holy Spirit to receive His perfect time and timing for intelligence to be released, if at all. You have a unique role in God's undercover operation.

God has already judged satan. God has already condemned and punished satan. God has already sentenced the devil to hell and eternal damnation for just coming up with the plot along with inciting one-third of the angels to join forces with his intended insurrection. In reality, satan couldn't do what he thought he could do. The devil believed the lie he told to himself and the fallen angels who are now demons as if it were the absolute truth they could absolutely trust.

One thing is absolutely undisputable: it remains impossible for the devil to wiretap the realm of revelation knowledge. It was impossible for satan—even as lucifer in heaven—to breach revelation knowledge. It was still impossible for the enemy to breach revelation knowledge even after he and his demons were cast out from heaven onto the earth.

Even though Adam committed high treason that made satan the god of this world, it was still impossible for the adversary to break into the revelation knowledge realm. Now, all the mystery that was concealed from the foundation of the earth, released throughout the Old and New Testaments and still being revealed during our times prophesies God's covert operation. It communicates Jesus Christ as God's plan of redemption for the whole world, which was and still remains impossible for satan to breach the secret code.

Never forget that the enemy can only operate outside of the kingdom of God's communications range. Therefore, it remains impossible for satan to make any connections between heaven to earth and vice versa. Again, the enemy's only point of access to revelation knowledge is if we reveal heaven-born secrets prematurely without God's authorization. Then the enemy will

attempt to pollute and/or purge what we make known to satan. Refuse to give satan the heads-up. In the name of Jesus, resist satan and retain him under your feet.

God has created everyone to be a history-maker, including you. Your assignment is to live in union with Jesus Christ through Holy Spirit. Then you align or realign yourself to work closely with Jesus because He joined you together with Him to function on His level. Jesus lives in you and now you live through Him.

After all, you were uniquely recreated in Christ to operate within God's sphere of influence on earth. That is what makes it much easier to expect to receive just what the Lord desires you to be, do, and have without ever cramping His style with any human or demonic imposed limitations. Your full collaboration with God grants not only you but the Lord breachproof breakthroughs on the earth.

Your obeisance and obedience before God will allow Holy Spirit the freedom to take you from one level of His faith to the next level of His faith, without experiencing any unbelief; one level of His strength to the next of His strength, without experiencing exhaustion; and one level of His glory to the next level of His glory, without experiencing any shame.

In the end, any revelation knowledge God desires to share with you will never be out of your reach. The Lord desires you to know as you are known by the love of God.

Knowing the motive behind the flesh, David is determined to keep it under the control of first, his renewed spirit that is secondly, served by his restored soul. He penned both Psalm 16:8-9 and Psalm 63:1-2 to cut back the flesh from ever taking the lead.

Prayer against the double spirit and replacement with a double portion of the Holy Spirit

Now, Lord, we pray for a double portion of Your Holy Spirit to be poured out upon us. Just as Elisha desired to carry on the work of Elijah with increased power, we long for a greater measure of Your anointing in our lives. Fill us afresh with Your Spirit, we pray, that we may be clothed with power from on high. Empower us to be Your witnesses in every area of our lives, to speak Your word with boldness, and to demonstrate Your love and truth to a world that desperately needs You. May our hearts be filled with a new desire to magnify You in worship and a powerful disposition to obey You in everyday life. We ask for the gifts and fruits of the Spirit to be manifest in us more than ever before. We ask all this, believing in the power of Your Holy Spirit and trusting in Your abundant grace.
