

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 392 Scriptures

Jesus also promised the Body of Christ that greater works will even be performed because of the presence and power of Holy Spirit upon us so we are filled with the fullness of God. You are a habitation of God through Holy Spirit where Jesus Christ lives in your heart by faith. That's how the Tsunami Blessing, Inside and Out will become a heaven-born reality.

JESUS HAS GIVEN YOU THE DOUBLE PORTION OF HOLY SPIRIT

John 14:12, (NIV)

¹² Very truly I tell you, whoever believes in me will do the works I have been doing, and they will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father.

John 14:23-27, (NIV)

²³ Jesus replied, "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them.

²⁴ Anyone who does not love me will not obey my teaching. These words you

hear are not my own; they belong to the Father who sent me. ²⁵ “All this I have spoken while still with you. ²⁶ But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. ²⁷ Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.

John 15:26-27, (NIV)

The Work of the Holy Spirit

²⁶ “When the Advocate comes, whom I will send to you from the Father—the Spirit of truth who goes out from the Father—he will testify about me. ²⁷ And you also must testify, for you have been with me from the beginning.

²³ Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks.

On Denying the Incarnation

¹ Dear friends, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, because many false prophets have gone out into the world. ² This is how you can recognize the Spirit of God: Every spirit that acknowledges that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God, ³ but every spirit that does not acknowledge Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you have heard is coming and even now is already in the world. ⁴ You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world. ⁵ They are from the world and therefore speak from the viewpoint of the world, and the world listens to them. ⁶ We are from God, and whoever knows God listens to us; but whoever is not from God does not listen to us. This is how we recognize the Spirit^[a] of truth and the spirit of falsehood.

⁷ Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God.

BATHED WITH THE DOUBLE PORTION OF HOLY SPIRIT

2 Kings 2:9-14, (NIV)

⁹ When they had crossed, Elijah said to Elisha, "Tell me, what can I do for you before I am taken from you?" "Let me inherit a double portion of your spirit," Elisha replied. ¹⁰ "You have asked a difficult thing," Elijah said, "yet if you see me when I am taken from you, it will be yours—otherwise, it will not." ¹¹ As they were walking along and talking together, suddenly a chariot of fire and horses of fire appeared and separated the two of them, and Elijah went up to heaven in a whirlwind. ¹² Elisha saw this and cried out, "My father! My father! The chariots and horsemen of Israel!" And Elisha saw him

no more. Then he took hold of his garment and tore it in two. ¹³ Elisha then picked up Elijah's cloak that had fallen from him and went back and stood on the bank of the Jordan. ¹⁴ He took the cloak that had fallen from Elijah and struck the water with it. "Where now is the LORD, the God of Elijah?" he asked. When he struck the water, it divided to the right and to the left, and he crossed over.

BARRED FROM RECEIVING THE DOUBLE PORTION OF HOLY SPIRIT

2 Kings 5:20-27, (NIV)

²⁰ Gehazi, the servant of Elisha the man of God, said to himself, "My master was too easy on Naaman, this Aramean, by not accepting from him what he brought. As surely as the LORD lives, I will run after him and get something from him." ²¹ So Gehazi hurried after Naaman. When Naaman saw him running toward him, he got down from the chariot to meet him. "Is everything all right?" he asked. ²² "Everything is all right," Gehazi answered. "My master sent me to say, 'Two young men from the company of the prophets have just come to me from the hill country of Ephraim. Please give them a talent^[a] of silver and two sets of clothing.'" ²³ "By all means, take two talents," said Naaman. He urged Gehazi to accept them, and then tied up the two talents of silver in two bags, with two sets of clothing. He gave them to two of his servants, and they carried them ahead of Gehazi. ²⁴ When Gehazi came to the hill, he took the things from the servants and put them away in the house. He sent the men away and they left. ²⁵ When he went in and stood before his master, Elisha asked him, "Where have you been, Gehazi?" "Your servant didn't go anywhere," Gehazi answered. ²⁶ But Elisha said to him, "Was not my spirit with you when the man got down from his chariot to meet you? Is this the time to take money or to accept clothes—or olive groves and vineyards, or flocks and herds, or male and female slaves? ²⁷ Naaman's leprosy will cling to you and to your descendants forever." Then

Gehazi went from Elisha's presence and his skin was leprous—it had become as white as snow.

EXPLANATION OF DOUBLE-MINDEDNESS

This prayer can be adapted and personalized to reflect individual needs and desires for spiritual growth and empowerment.

A prayer against a "double spirit," often associated with double-mindedness or deception, typically focuses on seeking clarity, stability, and freedom from deceptive influences. It often involves asking for God's guidance, discernment, and protection from negative spiritual forces.

Here's a sample prayer incorporating these elements:

Prayer Against the Spirit of Double-Mindedness

"Heavenly Father, I come before you in the name of Jesus, recognizing my need for your truth and guidance. I confess that I have struggled with double-mindedness, feeling pulled in different directions and struggling to discern your will. I ask for your Holy Spirit to fill me and guide me, to give me a sound mind and a clear understanding of your path for my life.

I pray against any spirit of deception that tries to cloud my judgment or lead me away from your truth. I bind every influence that tries to distract me from your purpose and I declare that I will not be swayed by the opinions of others or the lies of the enemy.

I ask for the grace to be steadfast and unwavering in my faith, to be rooted and grounded in your word. Help me to discern truth from falsehood and to walk in your light. I receive your peace that surpasses all understanding and I choose to be filled with your Holy Spirit, i.e., the double portion.

I stand against all attacks of the enemy, and I declare that I will not be a victim of deception, but a victor through your power. I thank you for your protection, your guidance, and for the freedom that comes through your truth. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Key Elements in the Prayer:

- **Confession:** Acknowledging the struggle with double-mindedness or deception.
- **Petition for Guidance:** Asking for God's wisdom and discernment to see the truth.
- **Rejection of Deceptive Influences:** Binding and rebuking any negative spiritual forces.
- **Declaration of Stability:** Affirming a desire for a sound mind and steadfastness in faith.
- **Claiming Victory:** Declaring freedom from the influence of deception through God's power.

EXPLANATION OF THE DOUBLE PORTION OF HOLY SPIRIT

This prayer can be adapted to specific situations and needs, focusing on areas where one feels most vulnerable to deception or instability. Remember to pray with sincerity and faith, believing that God hears and answers prayers.

Understanding the Concepts:

Double-mindedness often refers to a negative spiritual influence, a duality or a deceptive spirit that can lead to confusion or division.

The double portion in the story of Elisha and Elijah (2 Kings 2:9), symbolizes a desire for a greater measure of spiritual power, anointing, and authority. It is a literal doubling of God's Spirit and His influence in one's life.

Seeking God's Power:

The prayer emphasizes a desire for spiritual growth, for the love and wisdom of the Spirit to be manifested in one's life, and for the power to serve God effectively.

Key Points:

- **Renouncing Negative Influences:**
The prayer begins with a declaration against any negative spiritual forces.
- **Seeking God's Fullness:**
It expresses a desire for a deeper filling of the Holy Spirit, not just a partial measure, i.e., at least the double portion.

- **Desiring Spiritual Authority:**

The prayer asks for a double portion of spiritual power to serve God and impact the world.

GUARDING YOUR MIND AND HEART WITH THE PEACE OF GOD

Philippians 4:6-7 are excellent choices in your counterattack. Specifically, verse six qualifies the peace of God as guarding you from anxiety while keeping you thankful in the presence of God, instead of complaining.

Attaining and retaining the peace of God not only in prayer but at all times provides both reclamation and preservation benefits within the kingdom of God. Once you deploy the peace of God then direct all efforts toward sustaining that position perpetually.

Verse seven classifies the peace of God equivalent to a garrison around the heart and the mind. One definition for garrison is a “permanently established military posts that have troops assigned.” Why is that so vitally important?

Specifically, both the heart and the mind have been identified as the two essential areas requiring maximum security 24/7/365 days or in a leap year, 366 days. Strategically, those same two vital organs are targeted by assassins, whether by corpse or character. Learn to live in the guarded safe house that God built, His secret place.

Philippians 4:6-7 Weymouth New Testament (WNT)

⁶ Do not be over-anxious about anything, but by prayer and earnest pleading, together with thanksgiving, let your request be unreservedly made known in the presence of God. ⁷ And then the peace of God, which transcends all our powers of thought, will be a garrison to guard your hearts and minds in union with Christ Jesus.

Now you have resolute confidence that the peace of God you host is fully loaded and totally equipped to supply *shalom* in every area of your life all the time. Employ the peace of God over your mind and heart by voice-activating Philippians 4:6-7 along with every piece of the armor of God that is recorded in Ephesians 6:10-18. Exercise the

name of Jesus to destroy any weapon that is formed against you, seen or unseen, known or unknown at its roots.

Ephesians 6:10-18, (KJV)

¹⁰ Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.

¹¹ Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. ¹² For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against

principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. ¹³ Wherefore take unto

you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. ¹⁴ Stand therefore, having your loins girt

about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; ¹⁵ And

your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; ¹⁶ Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery

darts of the wicked. ¹⁷ And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of

the Spirit, which is the word of God: ¹⁸ Praying always with all prayer and

supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

Now you can activate the following prayer for deliverance from strongholds for yourself as well as others.

“In the name of Jesus Christ, I cast down every reasoning i.e., debate, dispute, and discussion that I will never recover from hopelessness, that failure is final, that I will always be stuck, that I will never fulfill God’s dream that is in my heart. I cast down every root, fruit, seed, and weed that constructed a barrier contradicting the knowledge of God that is in my mind and my heart. I have the mind of Christ, the very intellect of Jesus that gives me the hope of embracing, expecting, experiencing, and enjoying the glory of God. Thank you, Jesus!”

“In the name of Jesus, I bind every negative word, image, thought, feeling, and belief of despair, pessimism, and indifference to be enslaved as a prisoner of war. Every perception in my mind and my heart that is causing fear, sadness, and anger be loosed from my

spirit, soul, body, bloodline, and ancestry back to Adam. In the name of Jesus, I command you to go now and never return. The blood of Jesus is against you. All double-mindedness from the spirit of this world be permanently separated from me. I give you no place to work in me. Every deception, error, lie, or fabricated evidence appearing real I have believed is abolished forever. Thank you, Jesus!"

"I am united with Holy Spirit and the Word of God therefore I declare the decree: I have the mind of Christ, the very intellect of Jesus. Holy Spirit, replete me with the wisdom, love, and power of God. I proclaim what God has promised me as His prophecy fulfilled to me. I have all nine fruit of the Spirit. Specifically, I deploy love, joy, and peace against any unrest in me. God's love for me and in me conquers all because it never fails and casts out all fear. God's joy for me and in me makes me triumphant over every trial, temptation, and test because I am more than a conqueror through Christ who loved me. God's peace for me and in me is employed as a garrison around my heart and mind to preserve me in complete union with Christ Jesus at all times. My expectations, confidence, and trust rest in You alone. Jesus, You are my Source, Supply, and Surplus. Clothe, complete, and cram me with the hope of glory! My hope, optimism, and passion are restored right now! In the name of Jesus, I am resilient! I am relentless! I am resistless in battle! Thank you, Jesus!"

"In the name of Jesus, as a good soldier, I stand ready to revenge all rebellion so that my total submission to God is perfectly finished in Christ. I plead the blood of Jesus against all rebellion that would attempt to incite a riot. That includes any root, fruit, seed, and weed that revolts against the absolute truth of God I can absolutely trust at all times. I live totally sanctified unto God and totally separated from the world, the flesh, and the devil. In the name of Jesus Christ, I believe I have, host, and hold on to my winning position as more than a conqueror therefore I receive, because I agree with God. Amen! Thank you, Jesus!

Our loving Heavenly Father already made the impassable garrison that guards and governs our minds and our hearts. His provision to safeguard His vision is in Hebrews 8:9-11. Under the Old Covenant, God's commandments to our forefathers were received only on the surface. Under the New Covenant, God embeds our minds and hearts with His laws by way of the New Birth experience. Under the Old

Covenant, the Lord was with them, but under the New Covenant, He is inside us.

Hebrews 8:9-11, Amplified Bible

⁹ Not like the covenant that I made with their fathers on the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; For they did not abide in My covenant, and so I withdrew My favor *and* disregarded them, says the Lord. ¹⁰ “For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will imprint My laws upon their minds [even upon their innermost thoughts and understanding], and engrave them upon their hearts [effecting their regeneration]. And I will be their God, and they shall be My people. ¹¹ “And it will not be [necessary] for each one to teach his fellow citizen, or each one his brother, saying, ‘Know [by experience, have knowledge of] the Lord,’ for all will know [Me by experience and have knowledge of] Me, from the least to the greatest of them.

MOVING FROM DOUBLE-MINDEDNESS TO DOUBLE PORTION OF HOLY SPIRIT

Because of our spiritual and supernatural transformation, we become a habitation of God through Holy Spirit where Jesus Christ lives in our hearts by faith. Through Holy Spirit, the abiding anointing empowers you by teaching you to learn the absolute truth you can absolutely trust at all times, as noted in 1 John 2:27.

1 John 2:27, (KJV)

²⁷ But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.

Note: The effectiveness of any prayer lies in the sincerity and faith of the one praying. This prayer is a guide and can be adapted to personal circumstances and needs.

A prayer against a "double spirit" and for the "double portion of the Holy Spirit" can be a powerful way to seek spiritual growth and a deeper connection with God. This prayer acknowledges the potential for negative influences (the "double spirit") and requests a greater measure of God's Spirit, specifically a "double portion," signifying abundance and spiritual authority.

Here's a prayer example:

"Father God, I come before you in the name of Jesus, acknowledging your sovereignty and power. I recognize the presence of negative influences and spiritual battles in my life and I ask for your protection. I renounce and rebuke the "double spirit" or any other negative spiritual force that may be working against me. I ask that you fill me with your Holy Spirit, and not just with a measure, but with a double portion of your Spirit, as you gave to Elisha that was on Elijah. Jesus promised that I can do the same works He did as well as greater works because of Holy Spirit and that is at least the double portion of Holy Spirit.

Lord, I desire to be a vessel for your work, to be filled with your love, joy, peace, longsuffering, meekness, goodness, faith, gentleness, and temperance. Also fill me with your wisdom, understanding, knowledge, faithfulness, reverence, righteousness, counsel, might, and glory. Also fill me with tongues, interpretation of tongues, word of wisdom, word of knowledge, gift of faith, discerning of spirits, prophecies, healing, and miracles. I ask for a double portion of your anointing, your love, your wisdom, and your power to be upon me, so that I may be a beacon of your light in this world and a powerful witness to your grace and mercy. I ask for a double portion of your Holy Spirit to empower me to do your will, to overcome temptation, and to live a life that is pleasing to you.

I thank you, Father, for hearing my prayer and for your faithfulness to answer. In Jesus' name, Amen."
