The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 398 Scriptures

This is Section AO of a multi-part instruction. Holy Spirit was first introduced in the book of Genesis as the Third Person of the Godhead, Elohim. Throughout the Old Testament, you can see the empowerment of Holy Spirit demonstrated. This fixes our focus, not on our own power or might, but by the Spirit of the Lord Most High. Holy Spirit fills us to overflowing so we can expect Him to come in like a flood to make miraculous changes in the world through us.

Holy Spirit supervened Mary's womb by impregnating her with Jesus. Our Heavenly Father, Abba anointed Jesus with Holy Spirit and dunamis power. Then Abba accompanied Jesus as He went about doing good, and healing all who were oppressed of the devil during His earthly ministry. Jesus baptizing you with Holy Spirit and the fire of God grants you an unfair advantage to fulfill your destiny on earth.

Jesus introduced Holy Spirit as the One to lead God's succession plan on earth after His ascension. Jesus commissioned the Body of Christ to do the same works He performed on earth giving us our invitation to inherit and inhabit His anointing. Jesus also promised the Body of Christ that greater works will even be performed because of the presence and power of Holy Spirit upon us so we are filled with the fullness of God. You are a habitation of God through Holy Spirit where Jesus Christ lives in your heart by faith. That's how the Tsunami Blessing, Inside and Out will become a heaven-born reality.

GOD IS SPIRIT, JESUS IS THAT SPIRIT, AND HOLY SPIRIT IS THE SPIRIT OF TRUTH, AND YOU ARE A SPIRIT

Elohim, the Godhead, created man in His image and after His likeness which is confirmed in Genesis 1:26-27. Every human who ever existed, that is past, present, and prospective is created in God's image, i.e., resemblance and likeness, i.e., similitude.

First, you are a spirit. Secondly, you have a soul. And thirdly, your spirit and soul are within your body. Although you are shaped to be a harmonious triad, each portion has a distinct function. None of them can ever perform or outperform the original function of any of the

others. You can put something in its place, but you cannot replace it. As God designed, each portion is irreplaceable.

The Spirit of God, i.e., Holy Spirit, and the inborn spirit of man share identical connotations. The word *ruach* in Hebrew in Genesis 1:2 is used to also describe Holy Spirit. The Spirit of God always remains the same and His character never changes.

The spirit i.e., the *ruach* of man has the potential to remain identical to God's original design. Both Adam and Eve exhibited that image and likeness before the fall of man. The consistency to live the breachproof breakthrough life is innate. The truth that Holy Spirit has His role in the creation of man is confirmed by Elihu in Job 33:3-4.

³ "My words will express the uprightness of my heart, And my lips will speak what they know with utter sincerity. ⁴ "The Spirit [ruach] of God has made me, And the breath [neshamah] of [a] the Almighty [Shaddai] gives me life [chayah to live, to be alive, to revive, restore to life] [which inspires me].

In Genesis 2:7, you see the composition of Adam, i.e., the spirit, the soul, and the body. In order of magnitude, your spirit is sovereign. Your soul is assigned to be a servant to your spirit. And your body is subservient to both your spirit and soul as a slave. Therefore, your body known as the flesh should never be given the expressway to govern any of your decisions, not even just one.

⁵ He saved us, not because of any works of righteousness that we had done, but because of His own pity *and* mercy, by [the] cleansing [bath] of the new birth (regeneration) and renewing of the Holy Spirit, ⁶ Which He poured out [so] richly upon us through Jesus Christ our Savior. ⁷ [And He did it in order] that we might be justified by His grace (by His favor, wholly undeserved), [that we might be acknowledged and counted as conformed to the divine will in purpose, thought, and action], and that we might become heirs of eternal life according to [our] hope.

Holy Spirit clothes the human spirit, i.e., the inner man. That is similar to a hand in a glove so you can move syncopated and

synchronized with Him. First, Holy Spirit is present in you as a well of water springing up into everlasting life. However, toxicity stops well water from flowing clean. The presence of any poison makes it persistently dead. Jesus taught the woman at the well in John 4:13-14 that Holy Spirit clears the path of anything contaminated that could prevent the water from springing up as her pure source and supply of everlasting water.

Jesus Christ is the Way, God's channel for all mankind. Holy Spirit ushers you into the born-again experience. Jesus desires you to experience His life to the full until it overflows with the fullness of the blessing. That is with nothing missing, nothing lacking, and nothing broken. To accomplish that, God is the only one who can realized as your Source and Supply.

Secondly, Holy Spirit is present to flow out of you like rivers of living waters as Jesus spoke of the promise of the Father in John 7:38-39. Your acceptance of Jesus as your personal Savior and Lord repositions you to live heaven-drenched.

That takes your born-again experience to succeeding levels of the divine presence and divine power of God. That is where you abide and anticipate more out of your intimacy with Jesus.

In that place, you will incessantly and increasingly stream with the very life of God at all times. Jesus desires you to experience His life to the full until it overflows into the lives of others. To accomplish that, God is your Surplus.

In Romans 8:11, the Apostle Paul gives a word picture of the indwelling Holy Spirit after the New Birth experience.

YOUR RECREATION IN CHRIST

After the resurrection of Jesus, He appeared to His disciples. After Jesus validated He was alive indeed, He breathed on them in order to re-create them through Holy Spirit. Now Holy Spirit was inside of them. It is the initiation of the New Birth experience. John 20:22 confirms the term "breathed" in Greek is identical to the Hebrew word "breathed" in Genesis 2:7. The Passion Translation research shows the word "breathed" only appears once in the New Testament in Greek.

- a. <u>20:22</u> The Greek word used here does not appear elsewhere in the New Testament; however, it is the same word found in the Septuagint for when God "breathed" into Adam's nostrils the breath of life (<u>Gen. 2:7</u>). The beginning of new creation life came from the breath of Jesus. The mighty wind of <u>Acts 2</u> was for power, the breath Jesus breathed into his disciples in this verse was for life.
