SAMSON WAS BENT ON BEING DOUBLE-VISIONED

Judges 16:1-30, King James Version

¹ Then went Samson to Gaza, and saw there an harlot, and went in unto her.

² And it was told the Gazites, saying, Samson is come hither. And they compassed him in, and laid wait for him all night in the gate of the city, and were quiet all the night, saying, In the morning, when it is day, we shall kill him. ³ And Samson lay till midnight, and arose at midnight, and took the doors of the gate of the city, and the two posts, and went away with them, bar and all, and put them upon his shoulders, and carried them up to the top

of an hill that is before Hebron. ⁴ And it came to pass afterward, that he loved a woman in the valley of Sorek, whose name was Delilah. ⁵ And the lords of the Philistines came up unto her, and said unto her, Entice him, and see wherein his great strength lieth, and by what means we may prevail against him, that we may bind him to afflict him; and we will give thee every one of us eleven hundred pieces of silver. ⁶ And Delilah said to Samson, Tell me, I pray thee, wherein thy great strength lieth, and wherewith thou mightest be bound to afflict thee. ⁷ And Samson said unto her, If they bind me with seven green withs that were never dried, then shall I be weak, and be as another man. ⁸ Then the lords of the Philistines brought up to her seven green withs which had not been dried, and she bound him with them. ⁹ Now there were men lying in wait, abiding with her in the chamber. And she said unto him, The Philistines be upon thee, Samson. And he brake the withs, as a thread of tow is broken when it toucheth the fire. So his strength was not known. 10 And Delilah said unto Samson, Behold, thou hast mocked me, and told me lies: now tell me, I pray thee, wherewith thou mightest be bound. 11 And he said unto her, If they bind me fast with new ropes that never were occupied, then shall I be weak, and be as another man. ¹² Delilah therefore took new ropes, and bound him therewith, and said unto him, The Philistines be upon thee, Samson. And there were liers in wait abiding in the chamber. And he brake them from off his arms like a thread. ¹³ And Delilah said unto Samson, Hitherto thou hast mocked me, and told me lies: tell me wherewith thou mightest be bound. And he said unto her, If thou weavest the seven locks of my head with the web. ¹⁴ And she fastened it with the pin, and said unto him, The Philistines be upon thee, Samson. And he awaked out of his sleep, and went away with the pin of the beam, and with the web. 15 And she said unto him, How canst thou say, I love thee, when thine heart is not with me? thou hast mocked me these three times, and hast not told me wherein thy great strength lieth. ¹⁶ And it came to

pass, when she pressed him daily with her words, and urged him, so that his soul was vexed unto death; ¹⁷ That he told her all his heart, and said unto her, There hath not come a razor upon mine head; for I have been a Nazarite unto God from my mother's womb: if I be shaven, then my strength will go from me, and I shall become weak, and be like any other man. ¹⁸ And when Delilah saw that he had told her all his heart, she sent and called for the lords of the Philistines, saying, Come up this once, for he hath shewed me all his heart. Then the lords of the Philistines came up unto her, and brought money in their hand. ¹⁹ And she made him sleep upon her knees; and she called for a man, and she caused him to shave off the seven locks of his head; and she began to afflict him, and his strength went from him. ²⁰ And she said, The Philistines be upon thee, Samson. And he awoke out of his sleep, and said, I will go out as at other times before, and shake myself. And he wist not that the LORD was departed from him. 21 But the Philistines took him, and put out his eyes, and brought him down to Gaza, and bound him with fetters of brass; and he did grind in the prison house. ²² Howbeit the hair of his head began to grow again after he was shaven. ²³ Then the lords of the Philistines gathered them together for to offer a great sacrifice unto Dagon their god, and to rejoice: for they said, Our god hath delivered Samson our enemy into our hand. ²⁴ And when the people saw him, they praised their god: for they said, Our god hath delivered into our hands our enemy, and the destroyer of our country, which slew many of us. ²⁵ And it came to pass, when their hearts were merry, that they said, Call for Samson, that he may make us sport. And they called for Samson out of the prison house; and he made them sport: and they set him between the pillars. ²⁶ And Samson said unto the lad that held him by the hand, Suffer me that I may feel the pillars whereupon the house standeth, that I may lean upon them. ²⁷ Now the house was full of men and women; and all the lords of the Philistines were there; and there were upon the roof about three

thousand men and women, that beheld while Samson made sport. ²⁸ And Samson called unto the LORD, and said, O Lord God, remember me, I pray thee, and strengthen me, I pray thee, only this once, O God, that I may be at once avenged of the Philistines for my two eyes. ²⁹ And Samson took hold of the two middle pillars upon which the house stood, and on which it was borne up, of the one with his right hand, and of the other with his left. ³⁰ And Samson said, Let me die with the Philistines. And he bowed himself with all his might; and the house fell upon the lords, and upon all the people that were therein. So the dead which he slew at his death were more than they which he slew in his life.

ENCOURAGEMENT DOWNLOADED FROM THE LORD REGARDING VISIONS

Any vision expressed on earth either hosts Heaven's provision or hell's division, which instigates double vision. Holy Spirit coupled with the Word of God corrects your lens. With laser-sharp vision, "see" Jesus as He really is and "be" as Jesus is in this world. Refuse to accept satan's blurred image of the abundant life Jesus already decreed. Make it impossible for satan to ensnare you through obscurity. The enemy only pictures you yoked to the blindness of heart and mind. Assassin-proof God's dream!

Declaring the end from the beginning. God always starts with the end in mind. He works systematically and habitually. His divine paradigm is: order, balance, wholeness, fullness, overflow, and excess. Without order, there is chaos. Without balance, juggling occurs rather than carrying the right weight. Without wholeness, there will be breaches. Without fullness, there will be scarcity. Without overflow, there will not be enough to distribute. God displays His designs through you, beginning with each brand new day.

Any revelation is impossible for you to accomplish on your own. He meticulously engineers His purpose, plan, and path into each masterpiece. Then the Lord fixes your heart so it remains non-negotiable with anything else. After that, He fits His words in your mouth so you carve out what He branded for you. It's not a counterfeit operation. It is God's impression on your heart that is your expression to the world.

Thought for Transformation

Within are "internally procreative powers" to be guarded by the whole armor of God's belt of truth. Re-presenting the vision God designed for you, He made you with the capacity to reproduce and to release on earth. He planned their full expression from the foundation of the world. 1) Eighty percent of success is having clarity. 2) Bring closure to anything that needs to end. 3) Give clearance for the path to your new beginning to open. 4) Establish right customs so you prove the good, acceptable and perfect will of God. 5) Holy Spirit will catapult you to new dimensions. 6) Focus on God's plan, purpose, and path to be crystallized in your life at each Kairos.

Destiny: Invincible Necessity

The word destiny means "invincible necessity." Only a no-show cancels that out. "Still, if you set your heart on God and reach out to Him, if you scrub your hands of sin and refuse to entertain evil in your home, you'll be able to face the world unashamed and keep a firm grip on life, guiltless and fearless. You'll forget your troubles; they'll be like old, faded photographs. Your world will be washed in sunshine, every shadow dispersed by dawn. Full of hope, you'll relax, confident again; you'll look around, sit back, and take it easy. Expansive, without a care in the world, you'll be hunted out by many for your blessing. But the wicked will see none of this. They're headed down a dead-end road with nothing to look forward to—nothing," Job 11:15-17,

(MSG).

THE PEN OF A READY WRITER INDELIBLY CARVES OUT GOD'S VISION

At first, Habakkuk was quite apprehensive as to how God would reply to his grievance in Hab. 2:1, (MSG) "What's God going to say to my guestions? I'm braced for the worst. I'll climb to the lookout tower and scan the horizon. I'll wait to see what God says, how He'll answer my complaint." Hab. 2:2-3, (MSG). "And then God answered: "Write this. Write what you see. Write it out in big block letters so that it can be read on the run. This vision-message is a witness pointing to what's coming. It aches for the coming—it can hardly wait! And it doesn't lie. If it seems slow in coming, wait. It's on its way. It will come right on time," Having God's response, he made room for heavenborn realities through his praise. "Now glory be to God, who by His mighty power at work within us is able to do far more than we would ever dare to ask or even dream of—infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, or hopes. May He be given glory forever and ever through endless ages because of His master plan of salvation for the Church through Jesus Christ," Eph. 3:20-21, (TLB). In the end, Habakkuk knew that God favored the upright in heart.

THE PRODUCER AND PROVIDER BEHIND YOUR HEART'S DESIRES IS GOD

The Producer of your Desires: "It is God who produces in you the desires and actions that please Him," Phil. 2:13 (GW). The Provider for your Desires: "Take delight in the LORD, and He will grant you what your heart desires," Ps. 37:4, (NCB). Even if you have calculated what you long for down to the smallest detail, it is still immaterial to the massive volumes God

has already imagined for you to accomplish in every season of life. After all, God began His plan, purpose, and path for you from the foundation of the world at the same time you were chosen in Christ Jesus.

THE INTRINSIC INVENTOR AND INVESTOR IS THE ETERNAL WHO IS IN YOU

- 1) Noah lived life successfully with the Spirit of wisdom: He made good decisions, with simplicity. What put him above the rest is that he allowed God to make the best decisions for him. God was his final authority so each decision was marked by diplomacy, logic, and reasoning. Never confused and nothing was obscure to him so he held the right perspective with God as his resolve. Noah did not miss any of God's deadlines. He walked with God and moved with precision, never deviating from what God commanded him to do in anything. Even when life challenges were presented, he still made wise choices. He experienced smooth transitions because he simply believed God would accompany him to make an accurate assessment. He realized that his times were in God's hands and that his steps were already ordered. "To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven," Eccl. 3:1. Noah allowed God to make everything beautiful in its time. He recognized that it was God's season, so he aligned himself to God's plan by using what was available to him.
- 2) Noah hosted the Spirit of knowledge: "Behold, I will do a new thing, now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it?" Is. 43:19. God inaugurated witty inventions in the earth. Noah had no prior knowledge of those innovations, simply because they never existed before. A number of noted accomplishments were introduced because he had an open heart to receive novel deposits from God. First, God introduced the ark. Then two more innovations: the rain and the flood. Prior to this time, it had never rained on earth. Plants and vegetation were all watered by an underground irrigation,

so it was impossible for the earth to flood. Like most inventions, scoffers may believe that they won't work. If the invention is God's, it is impossible to fail. God always supports all His claims. The knowledge of God births new inventions. "I wisdom dwell with prudence, and find out knowledge of witty inventions," Prov. 8:12. 3) Noah was endowed with the Spirit of understanding as his standard operating procedures: "Except the Lord build [design] the house, they labour in vain that build it...," Ps. 127:1. Noah only used God's approved blueprint to build the ark. He used the recommended building materials. Noah followed the design as proposed. The ark had the ample capacity for the expected guest list. The ark floated and no water seeped in nor did it sink. All three stories of the ark had the loading to accommodate the heavy cargo. God gave clear instructions and he assembled only what the Master ordered. By trade, Noah was not a carpenter. However, he was able to see the tree as an ark. Noah did not allow his own understanding to stand in the way of progress. God gave him quick understanding of how things worked. The Spirit of God is never limited. Noah originally didn't comprehend the underlying operation, but he never thought God didn't either. He remained open to the Spirit of God to conceive the ark. Open up ample space for God to dream through you!

SETTING YOUR SIGHT

If you only see the future, you will never enjoy the present moments. If you only see the present, you will never launch your future. If you only see the past, you will never enjoy the present nor launch your future. You cannot outperform your imagination, the portrait you have of yourself.

The Vision Voiced

Your imagination is for your future. Remember you cannot outperform your imagination, i.e., the portrait you have of yourself. Imagine that you can and

you will. Conceive a vision statement that's bigger, bolder, beyond where you are by carving it out with your voice in the present tense. Vision must be a voice. Work what you see until it speaks. When it speaks, you will see the authority that it carries. Voice is where your authority lies. No longer unseen, but a reality.

The Driver's Seat

Blind spots are what you can't see that could be keeping you from success. Peripheral vision becomes necessary when you are trying to move over into the next lane. Rearview mirror is smaller than front windshield because where you are going to greater than where you have been. Stay out of reverse "Anytime you are fixated, immobilized, absorbed in, or even overly concerned with something that is over—whether it happened this morning or ten years ago—constitutes reverse gear," Richard Carlson, Ph.D.

Vision or Mirage

"Without a vision, the people perish," Proverbs 29:18. Refuse to live blindsided: A person without a vision will roam around aimlessly in the opposite direction, which could eventually lead to self-destruction." Only a mirage when there is no action at all. Here's how you know if you are mirroring a vision or if it is only a mirage. "Vision without execution is hallucination," Thomas Edison.

Spiritual Vision

Led by Holy Spirit, you will: 1) Live outside of your comfort zone. 2) Learn how to maneuver effectively. 3) Lessen other's impact on your progress. 4) Look for evidence that the vision is in sight.

Visioneering

Please consider the tool of visioneering. "The future belongs to those who see possibilities before they become obvious." John Sculley. Employ visionary leadership which has the ability to see what things could be like in the future, rather than as they are.

Your Vision on Heaven's Whiteboard: The Sevenfold Holy Spirit is Heaven's Global Positioning System to lead you by an uninterrupted course that is accurately arranged. Holy Spirit is navigational: East, West, North, South, above, below, and inside, either by inhabitation or cohabitation. Systematically and habitually, He recalculates and/or recalibrates each step of your life's journey. Holy Spirit reveals, i.e., to take off the cover, discloses the divine plan, purpose, and path. That was hidden He now highlights. You download the vision and provision of God, without any division. Then on heaven's white board, you live through Jesus dynamically, never divisively.

Holy Spirit shows you things to come. Holy Spirit guides you into all truth so you can see Jesus as He is. Holy Spirit teaches you all things so you can be as Jesus is in this world, simply because you are looking through heaven's lens. "That is what is meant by the Scriptures which say that no mere man has ever seen, heard, or even imagined what wonderful things God has ready for those who love the Lord. But we know about these things because God has sent His Spirit to tell us, and His Spirit searches out and shows us all of God's deepest secrets," 1 Cor. 2:9-10 (TLB).

"But the spiritual man has insight into everything, and that bothers and baffles the man of the world, who can't understand him at all. How could he? For certainly he has never been one to know the Lord's thoughts, or to discuss them with him, or to move the hands of God by prayer, i.e., who can

advise Him? But, strange as it seems, we Christians actually do have within us a portion of the very thoughts and mind of Christ, 1 Cor. 2:15-16 (TLB). Jesus mind's eye hosts God's vision for you. Live purely, perfectly, and passionately through Jesus.

If you are going to see the reality of Christ, you must first have a revelation of Christ. Both of them are through Holy Spirit!!!
