### **Inference for the Revealed Truth**

<sup>30</sup>I am able to do nothing from Myself [independently, of My own accord—but only as I am taught by God and as I get His orders]. Even as I hear, I judge [I decide as I am bidden to decide. As the voice comes to Me, so I give a decision], and My judgment is right (just, righteous), because I do not seek *or* consult My own will [I have no desire to do what is pleasing to Myself, My own aim, My own purpose] but only the will *and* pleasure of the Father Who sent Me.

**John 14:30-31 illustrates how Jesus commanded the battle that was sanctioned against Him. From that point, all the way to Calvary, God's planned silence for Jesus removed any potential temptation that could have engaged Him in an unauthorized battle. More importantly, He stood ready to listen for and listen to God to receive up-to-the-minute updates from heaven's treasures.**

**By this time, Jesus' role had changed. Now, it was essential for Him to transition from being the Lion from the tribe of Judah to serving as the Lamb of God to complete His earthly ministry. Jesus' unbroken communion with His Heavenly Father silenced the**

**adversary because satan did not have anything to work with against Jesus' matchless, glorious perfection.**

**That made it impossible for satan to rob not only Jesus but also God in any way shape or form. Ultimately, it was Jesus' quietness that secured your complete reconciliation with Abba Father as well as restoration into the family of God seamlessly. Jesus lived the breakthrough life.**

**Jesus' sacrificial blood testifies the better things on your behalf which secures your innocence before Abba Father. His blood still speaks mercy for you today. Never forget that you overcame satan by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of your testimony in your mouth that proclaims, "I plead the blood that Jesus Christ shed for me! Jesus already fulfilled the righteous requirements of the law on my behalf. Therefore, in the name of Jesus, I am innocent! Thank you, Jesus!" That is how you sprinkle the blood of Jesus over you and everything in your life.**

**Once you are certain that none of the earth's inhabitants possess what you require to have, you will stop depending on the creation and go straight into the presence of God, the Creator of the universe. From that approach, silence will be your best position too. When you have set your heart to listen instead of talking, the rewards are even greater. Your other senses are heightened to capture the moment more accurately as you become an active listener.**

**Several times, I have been in situations where I felt in my heart to just listen and to limit my speaking. Holy Spirit allowed me to intuitively pick up the commotion that was brewing in the atmosphere, although actual words were left unsaid even by others. There was not even any body language on public display. He enabled me to read between the lines accurately. From those experiences, I knew Holy Spirit's decision had been set before me to keep moving forward.**

**God has created everyone to be a history-maker, including you. Your assignment is to live in union with Jesus Christ through Holy Spirit. **After all, you were uniquely recreated in Christ to operate within God's sphere of influence on earth. That is what makes it much easier to expect to receive just what the Lord desires you to be, do, and have without ever cramping His style with any human or demonic imposed limitations. Your full collaboration with God grants not only you but the Lord breachproof breakthroughs on the earth.**

**Your obeisance and obedience before God will allow Holy Spirit the freedom to take you from one level of His faith to the next level of His faith, without experiencing any unbelief; one level of His strength to the next of His strength, without experiencing exhaustion; and one level of His glory to the next level of His glory, without experiencing any shame.**

**In the end, any revelation knowledge God desires to share with you will never be out of your reach. The Lord desires you to know as you are known by the love of God.**

**The carnal nature is so unrestrained that 2 Corinthians 10:5 exposes its true motive. The enemy uses someone's imagination as an obstruction to "exalt itself against the knowledge of God." This knowledge is *gnosis* in Greek is described as "working knowledge gleaned from first-hand experience."**

**The reason why satan lusts after the knowledge of God is to gain access to the absolute truth that you can absolutely trust. The enemy's insatiable appetite for revelation knowledge is something he is banned from receiving from God altogether.**

**Since it remains impossible for satan to even penetrate revelation knowledge that can only originate from God alone, he attempts to contrive a polar opposite. Although it remains impossible for satan to breach any lines of divine communications at all, he still doesn't want you to gain and retain any knowledge of God's secrets either.**

**If you divulge classified information before its time and timing and it is not coated by the blood of Jesus Christ, satan will attempt to use it against you to stymie the purpose, plan, and path of God. That is why you need to enquire of Holy Spirit to receive His perfect time and timing for intelligence to be released, if at all. You have a unique role in God's undercover operation.**

**God has already judged satan. God has already condemned and punished satan. God has already sentenced the devil to hell and eternal damnation for just coming up with the plot along with inciting one-third of the angels to join forces with his intended insurrection. In reality, satan couldn't do what he thought he could do. The devil believed the lie he told to himself and the fallen angels who are now demons as if it were the absolute truth they could absolutely trust.**

**One thing is absolutely undisputable: it remains impossible for the devil to wiretap the realm of revelation knowledge. It was impossible for satan—even as Lucifer in heaven—to breach revelation knowledge. It was still impossible for the enemy to breach revelation knowledge even after he and his demons were cast out from heaven onto the earth.**

**Even though Adam committed high treason that made satan the god of this world, it was still impossible for the adversary to break into the revelation knowledge realm. Now, all the mystery that was concealed from the foundation of the earth, released throughout the Old and New Testaments and still being revealed during our times prophesies God's covert operation. It communicates Jesus Christ as God's plan of redemption for the whole world, which was and still remains impossible for satan to breach the secret code.**

**Never forget that the enemy can only operate outside of the kingdom of God's communications range. Therefore, it remains impossible for satan to make any connections between heaven to earth and vice versa. Again, the enemy's only point of access to revelation knowledge is if we reveal heaven-born secrets prematurely without God's authorization. Then the enemy will attempt to pollute and/or purge what we make known to satan. Refuse to give satan the heads-up. In the name of Jesus, resist satan and retain him under your feet.**
