Jesus introduced Holy Spirit as the One to lead God's succession plan on earth after His ascension. Jesus commissioned the Body of Christ to do the same works He performed on earth giving us our invitation to inherit and inhabit His anointing. Jesus also promised the Body of Christ that greater works will even be performed because of the presence and power of Holy Spirit upon us so we are filled with the fullness of God. You are a habitation of God through Holy Spirit where Jesus Christ lives in your heart by faith. That's how the Tsunami Blessing, Inside and Out will become a heaven-born reality.

Hidden Treasures for the Treasure of His Heart

Living the breachproof-breakthrough life God designed is proven as you yield the express right of way to Jesus Christ not only as your Savior but also as the Lord of your life. Never forget, that you are the treasure of God's heart. That can be seen in Jesus' illustration to

His audience in John 10:6-11. That is when God introduced Jesus as the Good Shepherd, the Door of the sheep.

When Jesus closed the door for you no one can open it, He also made you breachproof at the same time. Being breachproof settles your bounce-back breakthrough in heaven. Your supernatural disposition cannot be overthrown. No enemy can cross that threshold anymore because Jesus conquered the world and gave it to you as the spoils of war.

When Jesus opened the door for you that no one can close, He also gave you a breakthrough at the same time. Having the breakthrough sets your back-to-back breakthrough in motion on earth. Holding on to this stance, your supernatural disposition cannot be overthrown either. Therefore, you are positioned to repossess all your inheritance from enemy territory as well as completely preserve it from ever being stolen, killed, or destroyed again.

John 10:6-11 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

'Jesus used this parable (illustration) with them, but they did not understand what He was talking about. 'So Jesus said again, I assure you, most solemnly I tell you, that I Myself am the Door 'for the sheep. 'All others who came [as such] before Me are thieves and robbers, but the [true] sheep did not listen to and obey them. 'I am the Door; anyone who enters in through Me will be saved (will live). He will come in and he will go out [freely], and will find pasture. 'The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it 'overflows). I am the Good Shepherd. The Good Shepherd risks and lays down His [own] life for the sheep.

At the moment you receive Jesus as the Lord of the Breakthrough, He is empowered to grant you access as well as deny the right of entry to any enemy. The key of David that Jesus has been entrusted with opens the door for you that no one can shut as well as closes the door that no one can open. That is truly God's guarded safe house where you are to always reside when you purpose to live your life through Jesus Christ.

In Revelation 3:6-8, you can see the reward for your loyal obeisance and obedience to Jesus. As you keep God's Word alive within your heart without blocking Holy Spirit's progress to choose your pathway, you will be ushered into your destiny. That is the ideal place where God has chosen you to reside within the kingdom of God.

You are the preferred recipient of God's grace. His grace is more than enough to raise any barrier obstructing your breakthrough. That is how His *dunamis* power of God is perfectly finished in your weakness. His finishing touch always perfects what concerns you. You rest satisfied in the finished work of Christ without trying to compete with the Lord.

Because the grace of God does the supernatural work of God, you remain strong in the Lord and the power of His might during any test, trial, or temptation. It is the grace of God that reinforces anything that is feeble and/or frail in you with His omnipotent strength that is always miraculous.

In your yearning to yield to the Lord, you will no longer be in His way. When Jesus is your only Way, He can govern everything, including territory, time, technology, treasure, and talent as your Lord of the Breakthrough.

Revelation 3:6-8 King James Version (KJV)

⁶ He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

⁷ And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith He that is holy, He that is true, He that hath the key of David, He that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth; ⁸ I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name.

God's prearranged breakthrough gives you access to the treasures of darkness as well as the hidden riches in secret places as seen in Isaiah 45:1-3. The phrase "right hand" refers to the appointed and anointed one God has conferred the right to rule. Having that kind of influence, you experientially know Jesus in an even more energetic and electrifying way, which precludes you from putting Him in a box marked restriction.

The Lord confirms His hand in conquering nations to provide you with the supernatural transference of wealth. This accumulation is in any category that God deems necessary for you to have and keep the unfair advantage within the kingdom of God on earth. This is the purpose for you being highlighted. You display the brilliant light of Jesus Christ as the King of Glory within your spheres of influence.

God-given streams of wealth can include but are not limited to receiving inheritances, information, intelligence, innovations, and inventions. It includes whatever is essential for you to own and occupy your God-given estate on earth as a joint heir with Christ.

This is your standing promise you have access to fulfill your divinely inspired destiny. Jesus commanded you to own and occupy until He returns. Therefore, God has preordained you to accomplish His good, acceptable, and perfect will in at least one area that has the potential to blossom into all seven. This is what Lance Wallnau brands as the Seven Mountains: 1) family; 2) government; 3) religion; 4) education; 5) business; 6) media; and 7) arts & entertainment.

Isaiah 45:1-3 King James Version (KJV)

¹ Thus saith the LORD to his anointed, to Cyrus, whose right hand I have holden, to subdue nations before him; and I will loose the loins of kings, to open before him the two leaved gates; and the gates shall not be shut; ² I will go before thee, and make the crooked places straight: I will break in pieces the gates of brass, and cut in sunder the bars of iron: ³ And I will give thee the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places, that thou mayest know that I, the LORD, which call thee by thy name, am the God of Israel.

KNOW THE TRUTH AMIDST ALL LIES

Jesus makes His prevailing and compelling distinction between the Good Shepherd and the thief, satan in John 10:9-11. Jesus is the Good Shepherd who opens the door to always give you the clear advantage. On the other hand, satan, the thief only has one motive i.e., to always take advantage of you once you open the door to him.

John 10:9-11 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

⁹ I am the Door; anyone who enters in through Me will be saved (will live). He will come in and he will go out [freely], and will find pasture. ¹⁰ The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows). ¹¹ I am the Good Shepherd. The Good Shepherd risks and lays down His [own] life for the sheep.

The devil looks for access through unguarded areas. Ecclesiastes 10:8 (KJV) confirms his stratagem is to stay focused on biting, not breaching. The enemy lusts for anyone to give him the

breakthrough. "He that diggeth a pit shall fall into it; and whoso breaketh an hedge, a serpent shall bite him."

The very life of God includes the abundant life, the eternal life, and the resurrection life. First, the abundant life Jesus shares repositions us to live through Him on earth successfully when we always allow Holy Spirit to take the lead. Secondly, Jesus' perfect blood sacrifice remains the foundational truth we believe to receive eternal life alongside our New Birth that begins on earth. Thirdly, Holy Spirit indwells us at the onset of our born-again experience whereby we are supernaturally empowered with resurrection life. That is the same time the *dunamis* power resides in us to do the Jesus' miraculous works as well as the greater works He promised through Holy Spirit.

Accepted in the Beloved admits you into the kingdom of God by the blood of the Lamb, Jesus Christ. That is where you have undeniable access to the throne of grace. God's oath authenticates all His promises that are in the New Covenant as the absolute truth, dissolving every doubt. Therefore, you can absolutely trust everything God has ever said.

All of God's vowed promises to you is the assurance you already have what He has already given you, i.e., all things to enjoy richly on earth. The overflowing life that Jesus mirrored is after heaven's model. That is what He coached all His disciples including you to pray to bring to earth. It is drawn from what is commonly known as the Lord's Prayer. "Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven," Matthew 6:10, KJV.

Contrariwise, every deception, lie, and error satan feigns through the deceitfulness of sin is counterfeit. The enemy attempts to blind both the heart and the mind. First, he wants you to think he is not behind the scheme as its perpetrator. Then, satan pitches it in such a way that you believe it as the absolute truth. Anything he conspires is likely to have a trace of truth in it, only to make it seem credible.

Ephesians 1:17-23 give you the petition to make before the Lord to open the eyes of your heart as well as your mind so you can have 20/20 vision and x-ray vision. As you pray these scriptures aloud daily, what you receive from Holy Spirit will be perpetual, i.e. now and forever.

Ephesians 1:17-23, Amplified Bible, Classic Edition

[For I always pray to] the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, that He may grant you a spirit of wisdom and revelation [of insight into mysteries and secrets] in the [deep and intimate] knowledge of Him, ¹⁸ By having the eyes of your heart flooded with light, so that you can know and understand the hope to which He has called you, and how rich is His glorious inheritance in the saints (His set-apart ones), 19 And [so that you can know and understand] what is the immeasurable and unlimited and surpassing greatness of His power in and for us who believe, as demonstrated in the working of His mighty strength, ²⁰ Which He exerted in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His [own] right hand in the heavenly [places], ²¹ Far above all rule and authority and power and dominion and every name that is named [above every title that can be conferred], not only in this age and in this world, but also in the age and the world which are to come. 22 And He has put all things under His feet and has appointed Him the universal and supreme Head of the church [a headship exercised throughout the church], ²³ Which is His body, the fullness of Him Who fills all in all [for in that body lives the full measure of Him Who makes everything complete, and Who fills everything everywhere with Himself].

It is the Word of God in concert with the Spirit of God that liberates your mind and your heart so they can experience 20/20 vision and x-ray version. 2 Corinthians 3:12-18 illustrates how they collectively work in you after you grant them undeniable access on a daily basis.

2 Corinthians 3:12-18, Amplified Bible, Classic Edition 12 Since we have such [glorious] hope (such joyful and confident expectation), we speak very freely and openly and fearlessly. 13 Nor [do we act] like Moses, who put a veil over his face so that the Israelites might not gaze upon the finish of the vanishing [splendor which had been upon it]. ¹⁴ In fact, their minds were grown hard *and* calloused [they had become dull and had lost the power of understanding]; for until this present day, when the Old Testament (the old covenant) is being read, that same veil still lies [on their hearts], not being lifted [to reveal] that in Christ it is made void and done away. 15 Yes, down to this [very] day whenever Moses is read, a veil lies upon their minds and hearts. 16 But whenever a person turns [in repentance] to the Lord, the veil is stripped off and taken away. 17 Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty (emancipation from bondage, freedom). 18 And all of us, as with unveiled face, [because we] continued to behold [in the Word of God] as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are constantly being transfigured into His very own image in ever increasing splendor and from one degree of glory to another; [for this comes] from the Lord [Who is] the Spirit.

Luke 4:18 describes one of Jesus' finished works on Calvary fulfilled as "...recovering the sight to the blind..." For that reason, He has made the way for you to have 20/20 vision and x-ray vision. Because we have inherited the ministry of Jesus, He also sends us not to just open blind eyes physically, but also spiritually, which includes both minds and hearts as well.

Until Paul's conversion, he never saw Jesus, as He really is since he could not see what he needed to correct spiritually. Paul literally thought what he believed was true; therefore he acted on what he believed was absolute to his doctrine, although he was revolting against the absolute truth of God. Paul accused Jesus' disciples while he excused himself.

After Jesus' light blinded Paul's eyes, he saw the absolute truth of his calling and his election. Jesus prophesied Acts 26:18 to Paul as his divine assignment to fulfill, "to open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in Me." Subsequently, Paul faithfully completed God's purpose and plan to unmask satan as the mind-blinder and the heart-blinder.

First, Paul unmasks satan as the mind-blinder: "Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not; But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God. But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them," 2 Corinthians 4:1-4.

Secondly, Paul unmasks satan as the heart-blinder: "This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind, having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart: Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness," Ephesians 4:17-19.

In John 8:44, Jesus identifies satan as the father of lies and a murderer, giving the following two reasons: First, satan is the father of lies and there is absolutely no truth in him at all. Secondly, satan was a murderer, even from the very beginning. You see an assassin targets the mind and the heart.

Never forget that it remains impossible for satan to give you something he cannot even access at all, the Spirit of truth. Therefore, he is looking to have offspring that carries his distorted nature. Conversely, you have the mind of Christ through the indwelling Holy Spirit who is the Spirit of Jesus, the Spirit of Truth. Equally as important, as a member of the Body of Christ, you also have a new heart. And it is God's heart that was supernaturally transplanted during the New Birth.

John 8:44 King James Version (KJV)

^⁴Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

Jesus as your Good Shepherd ensures us that we can rest in God's everlasting love. The entire Psalm 23 uniquely serves as the portrait of our Good Shepherd. Jesus already completely surrendered His life for you, as you. That remains your assurance that God's mercy and His goodness will follow you all the days of your life.

Psalm 23, Complete Jewish Bible

(0) A psalm of David: (1) ADONAI is my shepherd; I lack nothing. ² He has me lie down in grassy pastures, he leads me by quiet water, ³ he restores my inner person. He guides me in right paths for the sake of his own name. ⁴ Even if I pass through death-dark ravines, I will fear no disaster; for you are with me; your rod and staff reassure me. ⁵ You prepare a table for me, even as my enemies watch; you anoint my head with oil from an overflowing cup. ⁶ Goodness and grace will pursue me every day of my life; and I will live in the house of ADONAI for years and years to come.

Not only is satan the accuser of the brethren or "sistern," Daniel 7:25-27 demonstrates the precise plot he endeavors to use even against God. Refuse to allow the enemy to be successful in first, talking to you and secondly, telling you lies against God. Any defamation of God's character is an attempt to war against you,

wear you out, and weaken you. That will only make you believe you cannot absolutely trust God to be the absolute truth for you.

Daniel 7:25-27 The Voice (VOICE)

²⁵ This king will speak out against the Most High and *try to* wear down His holy ones; He will seek to alter the *sacred* times and *special* law *God gave them,* and they will be under his control for time, times, and half a time.

²⁶ After this, the *heavenly* court will sit in judgment his authority will be taken *from him,* and *his supremacy over the earth* will come to a permanent end.

²⁷ Then the great ruling authority of the kingdoms under the heaven Shall be handed over to the *covenant* people the holy ones of the Most High; Their kingdom will last forever, and all the *remaining* kingdoms will worship and serve Him."

The enemy stays on the lookout to find any area of vulnerability in order to extract our dominion from us. The blood of Jesus is your supernatural force field that supernaturally shields you when you continue to sprinkle what Jesus already shed for you.

I heard of an account where someone asked a demon why the blood of Jesus terrified him. The reply was because it is so RED and it is so HOT! Therefore, your transcending command against the defeated foe is to say aloud, "In the name of Jesus, satan, the blood of Jesus stands against you because the blood of Jesus always speaks on my behalf. Therefore, in the name of Jesus, satan withdraw!"

What that does is confirm your acknowledgement of what Jesus has already accomplished on the Cross for you. Follow the lead that is taken from Revelation 12:10-11. You simply agree with the finished works of Jesus: You overcame satan by the blood of the Lamb. And you overcame satan by the word of your testimony.

You declare actually what Jesus as your Advocate with the Father would declare about you. You testify of your innocence that is undisputable documented evidence. That proof of Jesus' blood testified your innocence before the foundations of the world when He was slain for you. Therefore, it validates God's judgment for you as the absolute truth that can be absolutely trusted.

Revelation 12:10-11

¹⁰ And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. ¹¹ And they overcame him [satan] by the blood of the Lamb,

and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.
