

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 422 Scriptures

This is Section AAM of a multi-part instruction. Holy Spirit was first introduced in the book of Genesis as the Third Person of the Godhead, Elohim. Throughout the Old Testament, you can see the empowerment of Holy Spirit demonstrated. This fixes our focus, not on our own power or might, but by the Spirit of the Lord Most High. Holy Spirit fills us to overflowing so we can expect Him to come in like a flood to make miraculous changes in the world through us.

Holy Spirit supervened Mary's womb by impregnating her with Jesus. Our Heavenly Father, Abba anointed Jesus with Holy Spirit and dunamis power. Then Abba accompanied Jesus as He went about doing good, and healing all who were oppressed of the devil during His earthly ministry. Jesus baptizing you with Holy Spirit and the fire of God grants you an unfair advantage to fulfill your destiny on earth.

Jesus introduced Holy Spirit as the One to lead God's succession plan on earth after His ascension. Jesus commissioned the Body of Christ to do the same works He performed on earth giving us our invitation to inherit and inhabit His anointing. Jesus also promised the Body of Christ that greater works will even be performed because of the presence and power of Holy Spirit upon us so we are filled with the fullness of God. You are a habitation of God through Holy Spirit where Jesus Christ lives in your heart by faith. That's how the Tsunami Blessing, Inside and Out will become a heaven-born reality.

In this session you learn how God desires you to know as you are known by His love. Jesus is now tasked to work with you in the earth with signs following. Holy Spirit is either with you or in you so you can possess the mind of Christ, the very intellect of Jesus. With the same mind, you can do the same thing. Even greater things as Jesus promised because of the presence and the power of Holy Spirit.

**HOLY SPIRIT COUPLED WITH THE WORD OF GOD WORK
DYNAMICALLY, NEVER DIVISIVELY**

**Fixed Knowledge, Familiar Knowledge, or Full Knowledge
God's predetermined purpose is for you to surpass what you
currently possess in your knowledge bank, no matter how great or**

small. The Lord's desire is always for you to know as you are known by the love of God. There is so much more for you to personally know as the absolute truth you can absolutely trust.

With that in the forefront of your mind, Jesus' succession plan introduced Holy Spirit as the Spirit of Truth. God desired for all the followers of Jesus Christ to know that they could always absolutely trust the absolute truth they received from Holy Spirit without any lie, error, deception, and/or fabricated evidence appearing real.

Jesus introduced Holy Spirit to His disciples by His job description. With the comprehensive details Jesus conveyed to them, they would know what to expect from Holy Spirit.

Just like Jesus, they would be intimately acquainted with the presence of God as well as the power of God. They would be empowered to do the miracles Jesus performed and even greater works because of the indwelling Holy Spirit.

Now we can host the presence and power of Holy Spirit in our daily lives as well as have the Holy Bible that testifies to the advantages that God has already given to us. Because the Holy Bible is the *logos* Word of God that is written, i.e., laid forth, stimulates the *rhéma* Word of God that is spoken, i.e., poured forth.

You see, the disciples probably imagined Jesus ruling as King only in the earthly region, not through them as He sat on the right hand of Abba Father. Because of that, they conveniently left their warped logic undisclosed. They could not envision living without the physical presence of Jesus, since it had only been three years.

Eventually, they learned to lean and yielded to yearn to the presence of God and the power of God perfectly through Holy Spirit. The Holy Bible documents their stellar contribution to Jesus' succession plan. Now our calling and election are greatly influenced as we learn more about the kingdom of God.

Each disciple's life and ministry through Holy Spirit was fully loaded and totally equipped with the presence of God and the power of God. And that can happen to you too. The initial dwelling Holy Spirit cohabits with you because He is living with you in a shared space. Succeeding dwelling of Holy Spirit, He inhabits you along with your increased intimacy.

JESUS INTRODUCED HOLY SPIRIT'S ROLE IN SUPPLYING KNOWLEDGE FOR YOU TO POSSESS THE MIND OF CHRIST

To maintain the cohesive chain of command, Jesus' instructions also help you to understand what to expect from the presence and power of the Spirit of God fully operating in your life. The mind of Christ emanates from Holy Spirit alone. Once again, the mind of Christ is the very intellect of Jesus Christ. As a result, Holy Spirit already knows you as you are known by the love of God.

As your heart remains open to God, you will recognize that Holy Spirit tangibly lives in you forever as Jesus confirmed in John 14:17. Before the indwelling experience of the Spirit of God, He only accompanied the disciples, externally.

The word "with" in Greek is G3844 *para* which means, "from beside, by the side of, by, beside." That is where Holy Spirit was stationed before Jesus' Crucifixion amongst the original disciples' inborn spirits. Holy Spirit was "closely alongside."

On the other hand, the Greek word *en* G1722 for "in" is defined as "in, on, at, by, with." That is where Holy Spirit was repositioned after Jesus' Resurrection in all of the original disciples' reborn spirits. When you receive the New Birth, you are instantly included in the family of God. Therefore, Holy Spirit is "*en*" you too.

¹⁷ Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.

With each disciple having that advantage, Holy Spirit served as their Comforter. The Spirit of God will prove every Word of God Jesus ever declared as John 15:26 promises. The Body of Christ too can live as credible witnesses for the kingdom of God. Holy Spirit will do that for you too.

John 14:26 records that Holy Spirit will teach you all things as well as also remind you of what Jesus has already said. Because the

Spirit of God taught the disciples all things and gave them perfect recall, Holy Spirit can do that for you too.

²⁶ But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

Holy Spirit will also guide you into all truth and show God's hope and future for you as seen in John 16:13. Through the Spirit of God's leadership, He guided the disciples to know the truth. Then they recognized and realized the perspective and prospective purpose, plan, and path of God. Holy Spirit can do that for you as well.

THIS SECTION: FIXED KNOWLEDGE AND FAMILIAR KNOWLEDGE

There are at least three degrees of recognition and/or realization to take into account. They are: 1) fixed knowledge; 2) familiar knowledge; and 3) full knowledge. Someone can be functional or dysfunctional in one or even all of them. That stance can also be visible to the naked eye or even masked to that individual. That can apply to just one region or the entire spectrum of life.

First, fixed knowledge is someone who remains unteachable. Whether the reason is known or unknown, he/she has not been able to experience any progress with that state of mind yet. If you think you already know, you may not even make inquiries to change your level of proficiency. You may tend to automatically shut down your knowledge bank from receiving more instruction altogether.

No matter where you may be right now, Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Truth is empowered to teach you all things. All things mean all things, i.e., anything and everything. Please know that fixed knowledge does not exist in the realm of the kingdom of God. Moreover, fixing your mind to stay affixed to Jesus is the preferred posture to have, hold, and host the mind of Christ.

Even as limited as the natural realm may seem to be, the knowledge age still pursues advancement if someone is stuck. Please do not feel condemned if you are wallowing in the mud right now. Yearn and yield for Holy Spirit's leadership. In your honor and humility before the Lord, He will help you to discern your current state so you have, hold, and host the mind of Christ, the very intellect of Jesus.

With your personal acknowledgment of any drawback of living unteachable, you can live totally free from that bondage. Holy Spirit is also your Liberator. Continue to reach for Holy Spirit until you are fully released from all chains of captivity.

Secondly, familiar knowledge is considered what someone has learned by rote or note, either by someone else or self-taught. Both formal and informal education imparted can lead to knowing the truth or even a lie, error, deception, and/or fabricated evidence appearing real.

Still, Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Truth is empowered to teach you all things. All things mean all things, i.e., anything and everything. As you host the mind of Christ, you will know for yourself that it is impossible for God to ever lie to you because He remains immutable at all times. Therefore, Holy Spirit validates His Word knowing God's unquestionable veracity, i.e., He is trustworthy and trustworthy. God is the absolute truth you can absolutely trust.

FULL KNOWLEDGE IS DOWNLOADED BY HOLY SPIRIT

And last, but not least, full knowledge is what Holy Spirit desires to download to each person as shown in 1 Corinthians 2:12-14. Revealed truth in its purest sense can only be imparted by the Spirit of God and the Word of God. Revealed truth is not only recognized in advance when you receive the revelation but also realized afterward when you receive the manifestation. Throughout Jesus' life and ministry, He hosted revealed truth, not just revelation knowledge of the truth.

1 Corinthians 2:12-14 Amplified Bible (AMP)

¹² Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the [Holy] Spirit who is from God, so that we may know *and* understand the [wonderful] things freely given to us by God. ¹³ We also speak of these things, not in

words taught *or* supplied by human wisdom, but in those taught by the Spirit, combining *and* interpreting spiritual *thoughts* with spiritual *words* [for those being guided by the Holy Spirit]. ¹⁴ But the natural [unbelieving] man does not accept the things [the teachings and revelations] of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness [absurd and illogical] to him; and he is incapable of understanding them, because they are spiritually discerned *and* appreciated, [and he is unqualified to judge spiritual matters].

Still, Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Truth is empowered to teach you all things. All things really mean all things, i.e., anything and everything. Holy Spirit schools you how to discern and develop spiritual things that are both truthful and trustful. Then you can accurately and joyfully commune with Jesus Christ being joined together at the utmost level. Spiritual things always outclass all natural things.

Holy Spirit's capacity and capability is ever present to help you in all things, at all times. He remains present whether the knowledge required is "experientially" 1097 *ginóskō* or "by revelation" 1492 *eídō*.

HELPS Word-studies

1097 *ginóskō* – properly, *to know*, especially through *personal experience* (*first-hand* acquaintance). **1097 /*ginóskō*** ("experientially know") is used for example in Lk 1:34, "And Mary [a virgin] said to the angel, 'How will this be since I do not *know* (**1097 /*ginóskō*** = sexual intimacy) a man?'"

HELPS Word-studies

1492 *eidō* (*oida*) – properly, to see with *physical eyes* (cf. Ro 1:11), as it naturally bridges to the *metaphorical* sense: *perceiving* ("mentally seeing"). This is akin to the expressions: "I see what You mean"; "I see what you are saying."

[1492](#) /*eidō* ("seeing that becomes knowing") then is a *gateway* to grasp spiritual truth (reality) from a physical plane. [1492](#) (*eidō*) then is physical seeing (sight) which should be the constant bridge to mental and spiritual seeing (*comprehension*).

withdrew] that it might be plain that they all are not of us. ²⁰ But you have been anointed by [you hold a sacred appointment from, you have been given an unction from] the Holy One, and you all know [the Truth] *or you know all things*. ²¹ I write to you not because you are ignorant *and* do not perceive *and* know the Truth, but because you do perceive *and* know it, and [know positively] that nothing false (no deception, no lie) is of the Truth.

²⁶ I write this to you with reference to those who would deceive you [seduce and lead you astray]. ²⁷ But as for you, the anointing (the sacred appointment, the unction) which you received from Him abides [^[a]permanently] in you; [so] then you have no need that anyone should instruct you. But just as His anointing teaches you concerning everything and is true and is no falsehood, so you must abide in (live in, never depart from) Him [being ^[b]rooted in Him, knit to Him], just as [His anointing] has taught you [to do]. ²⁸ And now, little children, abide (live, remain ^[c]permanently) in Him, so that when He is made visible, we may have *and* enjoy perfect confidence (boldness, assurance) and not be ashamed *and* shrink from Him at His coming.

APOSTLE PAUL'S WRITING ABOUT THE EXPERIMENTAL KNOWLEDGE AND THE REVELATION KNOWLEDGE. IN THE END, KNOWING YOU HAVE THE MIND OF CHRIST

1 Corinthians 2, The Voice

2 My brothers and sisters, I did not pose *as an expert with all the answers*. I did not pretend to explain the mystery of God with eloquent speech and *human* wisdom. **2** I claimed to **know 1492** nothing *with certainty* other than *the reality that* Jesus is the Anointed One, *the Liberating King*, who was crucified on our behalf. **3** I was moved to utter despair during my time with you. I would find myself trembling in *dread and fear*. **4** The sermons I preached were not delivered with *the kind of* persuasive elegance *some have come to expect*, but they were effective because I relied on God's Spirit to demonstrate God's power. **5** If this were not so, your faith would be based on human wisdom and not the **power 1411** of God.

Christianity is not merely a set of ideas and propositions. One can agree with all the truths in the Bible and still miss the power of God. Paul knows the brothers and sisters in Corinth might attempt to reduce Christianity to a new philosophy based on human understanding, but the power of God cannot be fully grasped by our eight-pound brains. We must approach God humbly as creations, not as those aspiring to fully explain the Creator of the universe.

6 However, in the presence of mature believers, we do impart *true* wisdom—not the *phony* wisdom typical of this *rebellious* age or of the *hostile* powers who rule this age. *Despite what you may think*, these ruling spirits are losing their grip on this world. **7** But we do impart God's mysterious and hidden wisdom. Before the ages began, God graciously decided to use His wisdom for our glory. **8** This wisdom has not been grasped by the ruling powers of this age; if they had understood, they would not have crucified the Lord of Glory. **9** But as the Scriptures say, No eye has ever seen and no ear has ever heard and it has never occurred to the human heart all the things God prepared for those who love Him.^[a] **10** God has shown us these *profound and*

startling realities 601 disclosed through His Spirit. The Spirit searches all things, even the deep mysteries of God. ¹¹ Who can see into a man's heart and **know 1492** his thoughts? Only the spirit that dwells within the man. In the same way, the thoughts of God are **known 1097** only by His Spirit. ¹² *You must know 1492* that we have not received the spirit of this *rebellious and broken* world but the Spirit that comes from God, so that we may experience and comprehend the gifts that come from God. ¹³ We do not speak of these *gifts of God* in words shaped by human wisdom; we speak in **words logos** crafted by the Spirit because our collective judgment on spiritual matters is accessible to those who have the Spirit. ¹⁴ But a person who denies spiritual realities will not accept the things that come through the Spirit of God; they all sound like foolishness to him. He is incapable of grasping them **1097** because they are *disseminated, discerned, and valued* by the Spirit. ¹⁵ A person who walks by the Spirit examines everything, *sizing it up and seeking out truth*. But no one is able to examine or size up that *kind of* spiritual person, ¹⁶ for *the Scripture asks*, "Does anyone **know 1097** the mind of the Lord well enough to become His advisor?"^[b] But we do possess the mind of the Anointed One.
