THE SEVEN KEY PLACES OF JESUS’ BLOODSHED FOR THE WHOLE WORLD

1) Garden of Gethsemane: “And being in an agony He prayed more earnestly: and His sweat was as it were great drops of blood falling down to the ground,” Luke 22: 44. 2) Scourged His Back. “Then Pilate therefore took Jesus, and scourged Him,” John 19:1. 3) Crown of Thorns caused blood to flow down His face: “And when they had platted a crown of thorns, they put it upon His head, and a reed in His right hand: and they bowed the knee before Him, and mocked Him, saying, Hail, King of the Jews!” Matt. 27:29. 4) Pierced His Hands: Nails were driven through His hands to fasten Him to the cross: “The other disciples therefore said unto him, We have seen the LORD. But he said unto them, Except I shall see in His hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into His side, I will not believe,” John 20:25. 5) Pierced His Feet: Nails were driven through His feet, which were often nailed together. “For dogs have compassed Me: the assembly of the wicked have inclosed Me: they pierced My hands and My feet.” 6) Pierced His Side: A Roman soldier pierced His side with a spear after His death, bringing out blood and water. “But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced His side, and forthwith came there out blood and water,” John 19:34. 7) Jesus’ Internal Bleeding and overall Bruising from Excessive Beatings: “But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed,” Is. 53:5. Passion with compassion!

GOD’S WORKMANSHIP: RECREATED IN CHRIST’S IMAGE AND LIKENESS

“My old identity has been *co-crucified* with Christ and no longer lives. Now the essence of this new life is no longer mine, for the Anointed One lives His life through me—we live in union as One! This is as sure as my boasting of you and our *co-union* together in the life of our Lord Jesus Christ, who gives me confidence to share my experiences with you,” 1 Cor. 15:31. “For when we pray for the blessing of the communion cup, isn’t this our *co-participation* with the blood of Jesus? And the bread that we distribute, isn’t this the bread of our *co-participation* with the body of Christ?” 1 Cor. 10:16. The Spirit of adoption ushers you into the bloodline of Jesus as one man.

“But when they came to Jesus, they realized that He had already died, so they decided not to break His legs. But one of the soldiers took a spear and pierced Jesus’ side, and blood and water gushed out. (I, John, do testify to the certainty of what took place, and I write the truth so that you might also believe.) For all these things happened to fulfill the prophecies of the Scriptures: “Not one of His bones will be broken,” and, “They will gaze on the one they have pierced!” John 19:33-37, TPT. Longinus, the centurion pierced the side of our Lord Jesus while He was hanging on the Cross. Longinus, who was nearly blind, was healed when some of the blood and water from Jesus’ side fell into his eyes. He then exclaimed, “Indeed, this was the Son of God!” Mark 15:39. Resultant, Longinus was converted and became a Saint. Just one touch from Jesus makes all the difference. The blood of Jesus speaks: “Although My side was pierced to confirm death, My blood lives forever to love you back to life both spiritually and physically. My blood and water wasn’t spit in the eyes.
