

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 424 Scriptures

This is Section AAO of a multi-part instruction. Holy Spirit was first introduced in the book of Genesis as the Third Person of the Godhead, Elohim. Throughout the Old Testament, you can see the empowerment of Holy Spirit demonstrated. This fixes our focus, not on our own power or might, but by the Spirit of the Lord Most High. Holy Spirit fills us to overflowing so we can expect Him to come in like a flood to make miraculous changes in the world through us.

Holy Spirit supervened Mary's womb by impregnating her with Jesus. Our Heavenly Father, Abba anointed Jesus with Holy Spirit and dunamis power. Then Abba accompanied Jesus as He went about doing good, and healing all who were oppressed of the devil during His earthly ministry. Jesus baptizing you with Holy Spirit and the fire of God grants you an unfair advantage to fulfill your destiny on earth.

Jesus introduced Holy Spirit as the One to lead God's succession plan on earth after His ascension. Jesus commissioned the Body of Christ to do the same works He performed on earth giving us our invitation to inherit and inhabit His anointing. Jesus also promised the Body of Christ that greater works will even be performed because of the presence and power of Holy Spirit upon us so we are filled with the fullness of God. You are a habitation of God through Holy Spirit where Jesus Christ lives in your heart by faith. That's how the Tsunami Blessing, Inside and Out will become a heaven-born reality.

A carnal mind courts the world, the flesh, and the devil, disregarding God, our Heavenly Father, Jesus, and Holy Spirit. Today's lesson, we will unpack scripture references so you live as a friend of God and never His enemy.

Carnally-mindedness drives you far away from ever being influenced by God. It lusts to express its independence. Therefore, it always depends on what it can contrive without the help of God. Without any reverence for or even reference to God, carnality is steeped into always moving toward the choice of premature death, never everlasting life.

Even if preexisting facts show the potential of both fortune and fame but it is a concoction from the world's system, it still will be short-lived. You can never live an abundant life on earth without having

personal knowledge of and intimacy with Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior. I encourage you to abide in Christ alone at all times.

Another Greek word embedded in the word "carnal" is *sarkikos* which is used in I Corinthians 3:1-4. Vine's Dictionary provides the following meaning: "flesh, signifies having the nature of flesh, i.e., sensual, controlled by animal appetites, governed by human nature, instead of by the Spirit of God."

In other words, it is cannibalistic i.e., flesh-eating flesh. Always displaying a predatory temperament, it lusts after its prey to completely consume it upon its own lusts. Undetected in public the party may be dressed for success, but the inner man exposes the true nature of his twisted heart to devour human flesh.

¹ And I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, even as unto babes in Christ. ² I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able to bear it, neither yet now are ye able.

³ For ye are yet carnal: for whereas there is among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men? ⁴ For while one saith, I am of Paul; and another, I am of Apollos; are ye not carnal?

The Strong's Concordance also portrays *sarkikos* as "bodily, temporal, animalistic, and unregenerate." 1828 Webster dictionary provides the following definition for unregenerate. "It is not renewed in heart; remaining at enmity with God."

That clearly describes the term "reprobate" as found in 2 Timothy 3:8. Some definitions show it can be someone who is "abandoned in sin; lost to virtue or grace." That can also be defined as "an abandonment of what one has professed; a total desertion, or departure from one's faith or religion."

If any of those characteristics apply, you can repent and return to God even right now. God always offers you a rejection-free zone. Afterward, daily renew your mind with the Word of God through the Spirit of God so you can be reunited and reconnected to the mind of Christ, the intellect of Jesus.

2 Corinthians 10:3-6 reveal satan's only motive is to steal, kill, and destroy. All the time, satan focuses on infiltrating the knowledge of God. The enemy craves for you never to recognize and to realize the absolute truth you can absolutely trust at all times. Then you will not be able to exercise your God-given authority and power in Christ against the devil to keep him conquered.

The enemy knows that if he can lure you into believing his deception, error, lie, or fabricated evidence appearing real, he has

defeated you. If you do not have absolute truth you can absolutely trust to stand on against his vain imagination, you will instead be an obstruction against your breakthrough.

Therefore, remain resistless in battle against the forces of evil at the onset. Relentlessly obtain and retain the knowledge of God in your mind and heart. Then it will come out of your mouth with the God-kind of faith. The word "knowledge" used in this scriptural reference in Greek is *gnosis* which means "a knowing, knowledge" and it is customarily used as knowledge, doctrine, and wisdom.

³ For though we walk (live) in the flesh, we are not carrying on our warfare according to the flesh *and* using mere human weapons. ⁴ For the weapons of our warfare are not physical [weapons of flesh and blood], but they are mighty before God for the overthrow *and* destruction of strong holds, ⁵ [Inasmuch as we] refute arguments *and* theories *and* reasonings and every proud *and* lofty thing that sets itself up against the [true] knowledge of God; and we lead every thought *and* purpose away captive into the obedience of Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed One), ⁶ Being in readiness to punish every [insubordinate for his] disobedience, when your own submission *and* obedience [as a church] are fully secured *and* complete.
