

## **The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 427 Scriptures**

**This is Section A of a multi-part instruction. The Mountain of the Dynasty of the LORD is the highest mountain where you are co-seated in heavenly places in Christ above all Seven Mountains. <sup>1</sup>And at the last days the mountain of the Lord shall be manifest, established on the tops of the mountains, and it shall be exalted above the hills; and the peoples shall hasten to it. <sup>2</sup>And many nations shall go, and say, Come, let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, and to the house of the God of Jacob; and they shall shew us His way, and we will walk in His paths: for out of Sion shall go forth a law, and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem,” Micah 4:1-2, Brenton Septuagint Translation.**

**Jesus authorizes you with God’s authority and power to remove any mountain that is an obstruction to your breakthrough. Through Holy Spirit, speak the Word of God with the voice of Jesus! <sup>22</sup> And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. <sup>23</sup> For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. <sup>24</sup> Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them,” Mark 11:22-24, King James Version**

**UNSHAKEN! Don’t be moved if the mountain seems to be a giant. It’s in plain sight so you won’t miss the cue that there is colossal treasure hiding behind it. Change your perception. Only see the mountain as “raised earth” that God already has given its dominion over to you. Stop wasting energy climbing it or walking around it. Its removal is voice-activated when you exercise your faith in God. Focus your unflinching command. Speak to the mountain. Watch God’s supernatural power—as your reinforcement—remove that impossibility for you. That’s mountain-moving faith!**

## **PRESS TOWARD THE MARK, MOUNTAIN-MOVING FAITH**

### **FOREWORD**

**The foundation of our total relationship with God and receiving the benefits of His kingdom is faith. To operate successfully within the kingdom of God, learn and follow helpful guidelines so that you will better understand the entire faith process.**

**Once enlightened by the truth of the glorious gospel that lies ahead within the following pages, I believe you will be challenged to demonstrate the God-kind of faith to a greater degree in any given circumstance. The more you rely on God's system of operations, the better results you will receive in every area of your life.**

**Mountain-moving faith is based on what God can do through you, and not what you think you can accomplish alone. It is not your own faith you release to move mountains. It is the faith God deposits in you that resolves the impossible. Your God-given faith has been designed to defeat every obstacle you face. It therefore helps you to have greater expectations for your life. Press toward the mark!**

### **PASSIONATE FAITH**

**The key to mountain-moving faith is to fervently exhibit unwavering confidence in God. The demonstration of that kind of faith must absolutely rest in God alone. To achieve excellence in faith, all other possible props are therefore removed.**

**The passion of mountain-moving faith is pure. Through scientific testing, the mustard seed has been proven to be a seed that is a purebred. Therefore, it cannot be mixed with other seeds or man-made props. The passion of mountain-moving faith is also sure. Your faith does not have to be big to tackle the impossible, but it must trust our great and mighty God to deliver what he promised.**

**For your faith to exhibit passion to remove mountains, it must be both pure in nature and sure of God. Jesus again uses the mustard seed to serve as an example to his disciples. "...For verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place: and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you," St. Matthew 17:20.**

**Where then is yonder place? Yonder place is where you are still able to see the mountain, but it is not in the way of you moving forward. In this case, the removed mountain serves as a memorial of your victory that helps you get through followed up attacks designed by the enemy. The passion of faith moves the mountain out of your way instead of just limiting God to help you climb it.**

**Although the mustard seed is the smallest of all seeds, it towers over all the rest reaching a maximum of 15 feet. The most significant feature is the acceleration of its growth. In fact, it only takes weeks to reach its full stature. The mustard seed's passion exhibits a speedy maturation process, not delays as often expected.**

**St. Matthew 13:31-32 supports this in this manner, "...The kingdom of heaven is like to a grain of mustard seed, which a man took, and**

**sowed in the field: which indeed is the least of all seeds: but when it is grown, it is the greatest among herbs, and becometh a tree, so that the birds of the air come and lodge in the branches thereof.”**

### **POTENTIAL REACHED**

**Ecclesiastes 9:11, “I returned, and saw under the sun, that the race is not to the swift, nor the battle to the strong, neither yet bread to the wise, nor yet riches to men of understanding, nor yet favor to men of skill; but time and chance happeneth to them all.”**

**The Lord has given us both time and opportunity to exercise our God-given faith. Do not be deceived. It doesn't matter how much time you may think you have left, mountain-moving faith can provide a way of escape. With pure and sure faith, you can effectively reach your God designed potential here and now.**

**Statistics reveal that most people only use 5% of their potential during their entire life span. That is quite alarming. Be determined that you won't be among that number. The difference between success and failure depends on how your time is redeemed. If you want to succeed you will develop your God-kind of faith and use every opportunity presented to exercise faith in God. If you begin to raise your standard of belief, everything that was driving you to destruction can be turned around to lead you into an abundant life.**

**We often find that many get trapped with what seems impossible to them. Then they start wishing for something to change or just hoping for something to happen. Eventually, they end up**

**surrendering without a fight, that is, the “good fight of faith” as the scripture defines it.**

**Because of that approach to impossibilities, countless millions never realize they have, and can, access what they need to win. They never really think victory can be obtained from that seemingly hard, dry, and hopeless place. They never clearly understand they were created in God’s image and likeness to overcome any and every overwhelming, diabolical, decaying, tormenting, demonic obstacle in life.**

### **PRECIOUS MOMENTS, PRECIOUS MEMORIES**

**The precious moments you use to develop your faith can be transformed into precious memories when exercised. You will find that faith is one of the most valuable assets in the kingdom of God. You can virtually begin with little or nothing and end up with the blessing of the Lord overtaking you to the point that there won’t be enough room to receive it all.**

**Without a shadow of doubt, exercising faith in God will add great value to your life. When worth is attached to something, success will be in hot pursuit to associate with it. In other words you won’t have to go looking for success, it will find you. If you want to have success in life, have faith in God.**

**I Peter 1:6-9 declares, “In this ye greatly rejoice, though now for a season, if need be, ye are in heaviness through manifold temptations: that the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be**

**found unto praise and honor and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ: Whom, having not seen, ye love; in whom, though now ye see him not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory: receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls."**

**Having tried-out faith in God stores up treasure more valuable than the finest of gold. For example, when you use gold in exchange to purchase goods, you will find out very quickly that it is temporary, because it can be exhausted with one transaction. What you purchased may depreciate quickly and the amount remaining is therefore depleted because of the exchange.**

**On the other hand, when faith is exercised to acquire something of equal value, you will always have the same amount after the transaction. You can then go from one level of faith to the next level of faith in the applied area. With a firm foundation, you can advance to the next level. Therefore, faith in God will always bring you increase.**

#### **PREEMINENCE OF MOTIVE**

**God has given "the measure of faith" to all mankind. However, not all mankind has given God credit for all the accomplishments and the accolades he receives from it.**

**In fact, some only believe in themselves or other natural resources to accomplish everything. This limits them to only what they can see or possess. Self-sufficiency will eventually deplete your own resources because there will always be limitations. If you choose to**

**be “god” in your own life, there will be nothing left in your reserve to draw from when all the energy is spent.**

**You can rely on this truth. God is the self-existing One. If our sufficiency is of God, we will be hooked up to an endless power supply. Jesus tells his disciples to look beyond themselves and other people to find their ultimate source of help. “And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.” St. Mark 11:22.**

**God is the rewarder of your faith and not men, so apply His accepted and proven standards to see His goodness in your life. “Hast thou faith? Have it to thyself before God.” Romans 14:22. Having faith in God will drastically improve the results you receive because the Lord links you to His resources.**

**Your quality of life in any area will ultimately be determined by the standards you establish for yourself. Raise your standard of belief if you want to raise your standard of what you receive. Remove all the props you are leaning on and establish only pure and sure faith in God.**
