

The Tsunami Blessing Inside and Out, Part 428 Scriptures

This is Section B of a multi-part instruction. The Mountain of the Dynasty of the LORD is the highest mountain where you are co-seated in heavenly places in Christ above all Seven Mountains. ¹And at the last days the mountain of the Lord shall be manifest, established on the tops of the mountains, and it shall be exalted above the hills; and the peoples shall hasten to it. ²And many nations shall go, and say, Come, let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, and to the house of the God of Jacob; and they shall shew us His way, and we will walk in His paths: for out of Sion shall go forth a law, and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem,” Micah 4:1-2, Brenton Septuagint Translation.

Jesus authorizes you with God’s authority and power to remove any mountain that is an obstruction to your breakthrough. Through Holy Spirit, speak the Word of God with the voice of Jesus! ²² And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. ²³ For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. ²⁴ Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them,” Mark 11:22-24, King James Version

UNSHAKEN! Don’t be moved if the mountain seems to be a giant. It’s in plain sight so you won’t miss the cue that there is colossal treasure hiding behind it. Change your perception. Only see the mountain as “raised earth” that God already has given its dominion over to you. Stop wasting energy climbing it or walking around it. Its removal is voice-activated when you exercise your faith in God. Focus your unflinching command. Speak to the mountain. Watch God’s supernatural power—as your reinforcement—remove that impossibility for you. That’s mountain-moving faith!

THE FAITH OF GOD HAS EYES TO SEE HIS VISION FOR YOUR LIFE

Pledge Allegiance - Preferred Status - Protocol Established

PLEDGE ALLEGIANCE

Jesus Christ already prepaid for all the kingdom of God benefits we can receive daily. Upon establishing the blood covenant with God, Jesus laid down his life as the collateral needed to secure our rights and privileges. He pledged allegiance to bring us salvation, healing, preservation, deliverance, wholeness, peace, and prosperity.

Romans 8:32 speaks of the completeness of Jesus' sacrifice and salvation's benefits. "He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give up all things?" I once heard one of my mentors paraphrase this verse in this way: "I gave you all heaven had to offer, why would I withhold anything from you on earth?"

The shed blood of Jesus Christ places a demand on your covenant with God to receive all His promises. Jesus Christ's sacrifice serves as full payment for all our debt so we can receive the full covenant benefits. Psalm 119:122, "Be surety for thy servant for good; let not the proud oppress me."

Until you are sure of your covenant relationship with God, you will not be sure of its contents. Psalm 103:2-5 outlines what is covered in the plan of salvation: "Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases; who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with loving kindness and tender mercies, who satisfieth thy mouth with good things, so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's."

Cast all your cares on the Lord so the burden will be removed from you to God. Based on our bond with God through the shed blood of Jesus Christ, exercise faith to place a demand on your covenant promises. So instead of receiving the promise because you need it or want it, refocus your attention on receiving the promise because God wants you to have it.

Please know God wants you to experience all of His promises, more than you really want to receive them. (Read that sentence again out loud.) The burden of proof has already been established by the blood covenant on this wise: "It is God's good pleasure to give you the kingdom," as referenced in Luke 12:32.

No matter how big the mountain seems to be, it is fully covered. No matter how long it has been in the way, it is fully covered. No matter how terrifying it may seem, it is fully covered. No matter how experienced it is, it is covered. No matter how many mountains there are, they are fully covered. The demolition contract was executed by Jesus Christ over 2000 years ago. The contract covers it all, even the wreckage in your life.

Because of the blood covenant, mountains are only temporary. When you begin to understand that you possess the power and authority of the King of kings, your mountain-moving faith will make a highway for our God. Simultaneously, when the mountain is removed, the way is also made for you.

Isaiah 55:1 declares that we come to Him without money and without price because faith is our point of contact with God. Never

underestimate the power of the blood covenant. By faith, everything you need and want is fully covered.

PREFERRED STATUS

“But without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him,” Hebrews 11:6.

First, believe in your heart that God exists. Then believe your God-given faith is an accepted practice to access the provisions of the kingdom of God.

Be resolved that faith in God gives you a preferred status in His kingdom. God is no respecter of persons, however He is a respecter of faith. As you peruse the scriptures, you will find examples where God adamantly responded to faith. As a point of reference, read Hebrews 11th chapter in its entirety.

PROTOCOL ESTABLISHED

“For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.” Romans 10:10. The same principle for your soul to get saved is the same process used to access everything else within the kingdom of God. Your heart believes it, and your mouth says it. It is God’s ordained method to remove every mountain to receive not only salvation, but also deliverance, healing, prosperity, peace, restoration, liberty, improved relationships, and employment.

The protocol God established is the law of faith. God cannot break His own law. Therefore, it is impossible for you and I to break the law of faith and still access the kingdom of God and receive any benefits thereof. Every kingdom-of-God benefit is based on an application of faith. Romans 3:27 establishes faith as the law: "Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? Of works? Nay: but by the law of faith."

Romans 4:15 says "...for where no law is, there is no transgression". On the other hand, where there is a law, this is transgression. When we operate outside of faith, we are acting independently of God. This is an offense to God because its intent is not to acknowledge Him as the source of supply whether knowingly or unknowingly.

Faith is an indelible law operative within the kingdom of God. The law of faith upholds two things: 1) Authority rests with the one that exercises the law of faith. 2) Authority arrests the mountain, making it come under subjection to the law of faith.

In other words, the law of faith serves the one who applies it. So without question, the area targeted also serves you. Faith obeys you so the targeted mountain must obey. In this, the law of faith makes a demand on the mountain of impossibilities to serve you once you are resolved that faith is one law that cannot be overtaken. The law of faith arrests and seizes any mountain of impossibility. The law of faith is unshakable.

Now let's show how the heart and the mouth are linked together. Romans 10:8-9 says, "But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even

in thy mouth and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach, That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved."

You cannot sever the heart-mouth connection. Matthew 12:34 states "...For out of the abundance of the heart, the mouth speaketh." In other words, your mouth serves as the informant for the heart. What we speak emanates from the heart. Listen to what you say for your words serve as the compass that determines your course in life. You and I are where we are today simply because our mouth pulsed our own heart's rhythm. So you must guard the floodgates of your heart as Proverbs 4:23 sanctions us. "Keep thy heart with all diligence for out of it are the issues of life."

However, you can't effectively change your confession until your heart has been changed to agree with God. Develop your heart to fully believe God and to fully receive from Him. Develop your heart to know you are the express image of Jesus Christ. Develop your heart to believe the quality of life God desires you to have in His kingdom.

Then discipline your mouth to agree with your heart. Develop your mouth to utter what you believe and what you desire to receive from Him. Develop your mouth to say you are the express image of Jesus Christ. Develop your mouth to speak of the quality of life God desires you to have in the kingdom.

The responsibility of the mouth is to actively participate in the faith system by calling what you believe to receive from the unseen to the seen. "For verily I say unto you, that whosoever shall say unto this mountain, be thou removed and be cast into the sea, and shall not doubt in his heart but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass: he shall have whatsoever he saith." Mark 11:23.

Jesus activated his way in the earth with his voice. Your voice can successfully activate your way also. You can develop the voice of the Lord so when you speak even to an impossible situation, it will humbly submit under your authority. Your way will then become voice-activated, calling those things that be not as though they were.

Proverbs 18:21 also confirms where our authority rests, "Death and life are in the power of the tongue." The power in your voice must reflect the potency of God's voice. Then, and only then, will the mountain of impossibilities be removed. Why? The mountain will not be able to distinguish your voice from the Lord's. To the mountain, the two voice patterns are exactly the same. The mountain will bow and acknowledge that Jesus is Lord and a way will be made for you.

Psalm 29:3-11 references how the voice of the Lord influences, enforces, and effects. "The voice of the Lord is upon the waters: The God of glory thundereth; the Lord is upon many waters. The voice of the Lord is powerful; the voice of the Lord is full of majesty. The voice of the Lord breaketh the cedars; yea, the Lord breaketh the cedars of Lebanon. He maketh them also to skip like a calf; Lebanon and Sirion like a young unicorn. The voice of the Lord divideth the

flames of fire. The voice of the Lord shaketh the wilderness; the Lord shaketh the wilderness of Kadesh. The voice of the Lord maketh the hinds to calve, and discoverth the forests; and in his temple doth everyone speak of his glory. The Lord sitteth upon the flood; yea, the Lord sitteth King forever. The Lord will give strength unto his people; the Lord will bless his people with peace."
