The Most Important Command: “One of the teachers of the law [scribes] came and heard Jesus arguing with the Sadducees. Seeing that Jesus gave good answers to their questions, he asked Jesus, “Which of the commands is most important?” Jesus answered, “The most important command is this: ‘Listen, people of Israel [^T Hear, O Israel]! The Lord our God is the only Lord [one Lord]. Love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength’ [Deut. 6:4–5]; ^C these are the opening words of the *Shema*, the prayer said by pious Jews twice a day]. The second command is this: ‘Love your neighbor as you love yourself’ [Lev. 19:18]. There are no commands more important [greater] than these,” Mark 12:28–31, (EXB). “Here is a breakdown of what this all-encompassing love means for your daily life. 1) **Heart:** Loving God with your desires, affections, and will. It means making Him your supreme treasure above all else. 2) **Soul:** Surrendering your entire life force, identity, and inner essence to Him. 3) **Mind:** Engaging your thoughts, reasoning, and intellect. It means renewing your mind with His truth and seeking His wisdom. 4) **Strength:** Using your physical energy, resources, talents, and time to serve Him and love others.” With intimacy with God, there is no breach of loyalty.

Jesus unveils God’s limitless love: “If you love only those who love you, what credit is that to you? Even sinners love those who love them! No, you are to love your enemies and do good and lend without hope of return. Your reward will be wonderful and you will be sons of the Most High. “Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also. The term appears in the teaching of Jesus alone and is always set in antithesis to the true sovereignty of the Lord.” God seeks those who are after His own heart,” 1 Sam. 13:14. “God seeth not as man seeth; for man look on outward appearance but the Lord looks on the heart,” 1 Sam. 16:7. May your heart always seek God’s face.

I have told them about Your nature; and I will continue to speak of Your name in order that Your love, which was poured out on Me, will be in them. And I will also be in them,” John 17:20–26, (Voice).
